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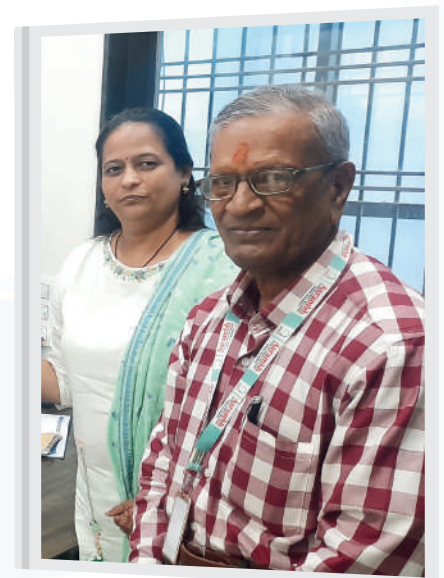


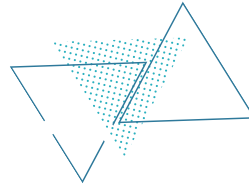
VISION

MISSION

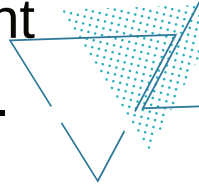

The year 2022-23 our special educators, therapist caregivers, and Board of Directors continued to demonstrate strength and resilience as we moved through this last special education year.

We continued to provide services where ever was possible and returned to in-person service when it was required and safe. Our teams have continued to be creative with providing services to make them as accessible, interactive and supportive as possible.

We are happy to communication that our residential school project is in progress. We have received NA from AMRDA. The site is fenced with barbed wire, the power connection is in place, and water rescores is available. Our architect for the project is finalized. Construction plan for the project is finalized. The construction plan is submitted to the authority and will get approval very soon.

We plan Hostel for 40 girls and 60 adults at New building, this will be first of its kind of residential school in Maharashtra for autistic boys and girls

We would like to express our sincere gratitude to our donors, financial supporters, and community partners, without their support the work this year would not have been possible. We are hopeful that we will be able to create world, where we will continue to work towards establishing secure but flexible practices to help autistic children, adults, and their families.

FOCUS AREA

EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM

Early Intervention program provides multidisciplinary therapy for children aged up to 7 years. The program operates with an experienced clinical team. The aim of the program is to maximize child development and inclusion in mainstream settings.



THE SCHOOL SERVICE

The School Service provides a comprehensive range of intervention, therapy, and support to school aged children between 6 and 18 years of age. Our service is child and family centered, and works collaboratively with schools, other community services and the family to maximize the educational and social progress of each child.



THERAPY SUPPORT

This service assists adults to develop their skills, maximize their independence, and participate in the community. Our multidisciplinary team draws on the strengths of a range of therapists from different professional backgrounds to create a service that is tailored to each individual's needs and aspirations.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM

Our vocational training program service focusing on securing and maintaining employment for people with Autism. we support to individuals to find jobs that are matched to their goals, skills, and abilities. Aarambh trying to give Employment and entrepreneurship opportunities to autistic adults for their self-respect and safe future.




FAMILY SUPPORT

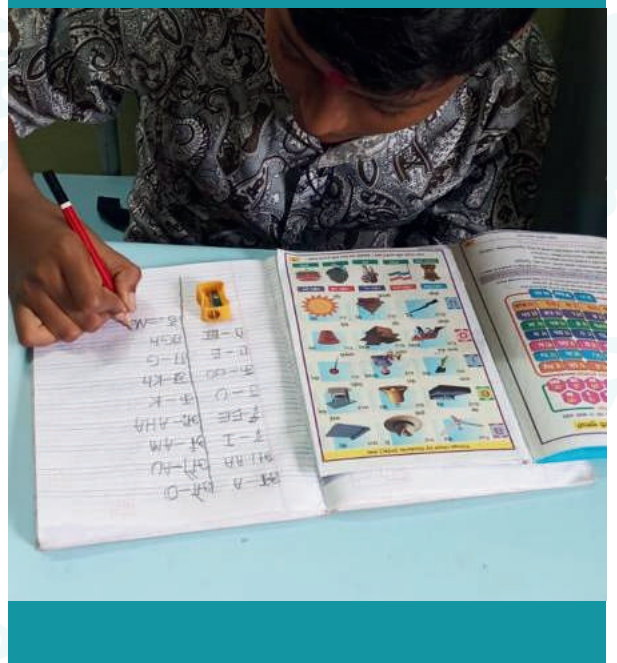
SPECIAL EDUCATION

Every student at Aarambh has an Individual Plan (IP). The IP is developed in collaboration with each student and their family. It incorporates a student's strengths, interests, goals and aspirations. Students, parents and teachers work as a team to achieve the goals.



ACADEMIC EDUCATION THROUGH NIOS

Aarambh successfully enrolled 3 students for NIOS. classes of this students started From June 2022. This students will appear exam in April 2024 .



FAMILY SUPPORT

Ensuring families have the support they need is an important part of what we do. Providing families with access to resources, information, workshops, webinars and consultancy is an essential support, as is the opportunity to create connections with other parents with similar experiences. This year we formed group for fathers. This group is run by parent of a child with Autism. Our Dads Autism Connect Group continued to expand with fathers and father-figures of young children with Autism. The group provide a relaxed, casual atmosphere in which fathers can come together to chat, share and support each other through the online connect group and social events.

UNDERSTATING AUTISM CAMPAIGN



This year, we launched the Understanding Autism Campaign to create Autism awareness in the community by sharing individuals' stories on what Autism means to them. The aim of this campaign was to facilitate greater inclusion and acceptance by taking the time to listen, to learn and to understand.

Through this campaign we encouraged the community to show how important it is to accept, support and celebrate the unique strengths and achievements of each person in our community.

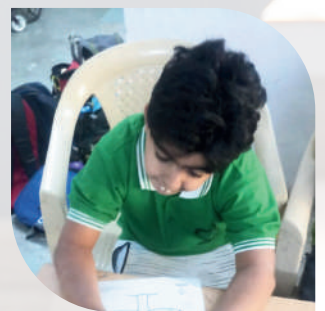
