## School at a glance

Sahrudaya Special school for mentally challenged is an institution which has been functioning in Ramankary Grama Panchayat ward III in Kuttanadu Taluk, Alappuzha District Since October 15,2001. The adoration sisters lead the organization which operates under Pavithra Social Service Society. The institute had imparted educational & vocational training to persons of different ages from 4 to 50 from various panchayats of Kuttanad. 31 children who have the disabilities of MR (23), CP (3), Autism (5) are divided into 8 groups on the basis of age & ability.

## **School Functioning And Teaching Style**

Classes begin with the Assembly every day at 9:30 AM. Teachers here play an important role in school activities. There are 23 teachers here. Educational and vocational training is being imparted to the children of eight classes under the guidance of specially trained teachers. Also teaches dance music, drawing, yoga, sports, speech therapy, physiotherapy and sensory integration therapy.

The School Resource Group works to evaluate and plan learning activities. Special attention is paid to the consecration of the Sacred Heart on the first Fridays and the worship of rosaries every Friday to develop the children spiritually, awakening and awareness of God.

## **Providing Therapies & Opportunities**

We provide sensory integration therapy & sensory motor stimulation for children with Autism. We also provide speech therapy for MR students and occupational & physiotherapy for CP students. Institution set a barrier free environment and adaptations for CP students. A team of doctors and palliative care workers from the palliative unit at Velianad Block Health Centre visited the school on 21/11/2019.

# **Screening & Asscessment**

After the current level assessment done by our screening team, set goals & strategies for 3 months and evaluate the termly achievements. School Resource Group (SRG) made a class wise plan for each students related to the needed therapies and learning activities. Thus we give a quality education.

# **Vocational Training**

Recognizing the importance of job training in personality development, various vocational training is being imparted to children above 18 years of age with the objective of self-sufficiency. The training program also includes bead making, cotton waste making, vegetable cultivation, computer training, sewing, craft work, paper cover making.

## **Awareness Programme**

The PTA members are working with the school management under the leadership of PTA president Smt.SudharmmaSathyan for the smooth running of all the activities of ofthe school. PTA meetings are held every three months and classes are conducted for the best activities in each class.

#### **Celebrations**

Nationally&educationally significant celebrations such as Onam celebration, Teachers day, Children's day, Christmas are being celebrated beautifully in our school as well.

## **Entrance Ceremony**

June 6, the 2019-2020 academic year, was observed as a day of protest instead of an entrance ceremony. Principal Sr. TessyKayithara welcomed everyone to the meeting, which was held against the government's neglect of special schools.Ramankary Church Vicar Rev.Fr. Mathewchethipuzha presided over the function and Ramangary Panchayat President Smt. D. Manju inaugurated the function. On that day, the petition was prepared by the parents and management and submitted to the Grama Panchayat President, Smt.D. Manju. Then Smt.Susheela Teacher, All Kerala Special School Association chairperson conducted an awareness class for parents on the various benefits available to children with disabilities. PTA representative Smt. SudharmaSathyan thanked the press conference and addressed the gathering.

# Onam & Teacher's Day
