

Annual Report 2024-25

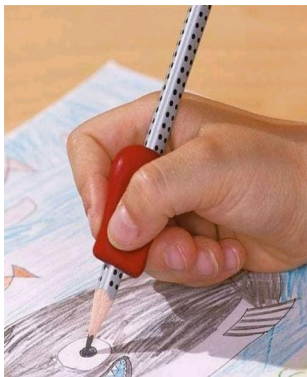
Mother's Care Special School, Narela Delhi 110040
