Special Teaching and Training for Children and Parents

Disha-cum-Vikas Day Care Center, run by Jeevandeep Health Education and Charitable Trust, Kodinar, has been providing comprehensive services on a daily basis to children with special needs such as intellectual disabilities, cerebral palsy, autism, and multiple disabilities. These services include special education, physiotherapy, speech therapy, pre-vocational and computer training, parent counseling, LPC (Local Project Committee) meetings, and regular parent meetings. These initiatives have significantly contributed to the holistic development and empowerment of the children.

Regular Local Project Committee (LPC) Meetings



Conducting regular monthly Local Project Committee (LPC) meetings at the Disha-cum-Vikas Day Care Centre, Gir-Somnath. In addition to the appointed LPC members, several parents of the beneficiaries also participate in these meetings. During the meetings, members are provided with detailed updates on the ongoing activities at the Centre. These include Physiotherapy, Special Education, Counseling, Daily Living Activities, Pre-vocational and Vocational Training. Comprehensive information is shared on each child's progress, services rendered, and overall financial aspects of the program. The platform also allows all members to share their feedback and suggestions for further improvement of the services and the development of children with special needs. These meetings play a vital role in participatory planning and transparency in program execution.

Mid-Day Meal Program for Children with Disabilities:



As part of the welfare and health initiative, Jeevandeep Health Education and Charitable Trust, Kodinar, provides a nutritious mid-day meal to all children with disabilities attending the centre on a daily basis. The meals are planned to meet the dietary needs of the children, promoting their physical development, overall well-being, and improved participation in daily educational and therapeutic activities.

The initiative not only ensures food security for children from underprivileged backgrounds but also plays a crucial role in supporting their growth and concentration. The program is implemented with proper hygiene and care, contributing to a healthy learning environment.

1. Voter Awareness Program

ICTC Counselor Mr. Arvindbhai Makwana and STI Counselor Mr. Suraj Parmar Hazar attended the event. The entire TI team contributed actively to making the program a success.



5. Independence Day Program

on the occasion of Independence Day, a special awareness program on HIV prevention and safety was organized for the students of the Pioneer Classes. The event commenced with the national anthem and flag salute, instilling patriotic spirit. Following this, the students were informed about the activities carried out by Jeevandeep Trust, along with guidance on HIV awareness, prevention, and personal safety.

During the event, women were provided with awareness about HIV and were educated about women's rights and related laws. Employees from Tata Motors also participated, distributed gifts to women, and shared motivational insights on women empowerment.

Regularly organizes Demand Generation Meetings and Peer Educator Meetings. These sessions aim to discuss preventive measures for HIV/AIDS and to guide both peer educators and beneficiaries through awareness and updated knowledge. Such meetings play a key role in enhancing understanding and ensuring that the community remains informed and protected.

1. Strengthening HIV Prevention through Effective HSS
