ANNUAL REPORT OF SAHAYIKA SISHU NIRDESHAN KENDRA, GUWAHATI FROM APRIL 2024 TO MARCH 2025

APRIL, 2024:

The school re-opened on 1st April 2024 and normal classes which include behaviour modification, activities of daily living (ADL), occupational therapy, brain gym activities, speech therapy, yoga, dance, music, keyboard playing etc along with academics of primary level and vocational training were resumed.

Pre Rongali Bihu was celebrated with a cultural program on 12.04.2024. Benevolent individuals who contribute to our mission were invited for the celebrations. Our students performed by reciting poems on Rongali bihu followed by dance and music performances with full participation of the students.

Students attending the skills development project were handed over their honorarium for their contribution in creating products which were sold in the previous exhibitions after keeping aside some raw material expenses under our sheltered workshop. This is an endeavor by Sahayika to give an opportunity to adults with intellectual disabilities and autism, a chance at earning a livelihood.

An inclusive art competition was held among school children and students with disabilities on 1.04.2024 with the theme 'Spring Festivals' in our Tezpur unit of Sahayika. 120 students from nursery to class XII participated in the competition. Smti. Kabita K. Konwar, Assistant Deputy Commissioner, Govt of Assam, graced the occasion along with faculty from Loknath Gopinath Bordoloi Institute of Mental Health. We have plans of continuing with this art competition every year after the overwhelming success of this one. It is worth mentioning that this kind of inclusive art competition is held for the first time in Tezpur.

It was made out of inputs given by us and trials were held for 6 months. The final demonstration after modifications were exhibited by students on 31.05.2024.
