1) Early identification and Intervention and Therapy Service for children with disabilities in Bagalkot.

From July-24 onwards BIRDS, Bagalkot in collaboration with Azim Premji Foundation, Bengaluru started to work with 0 to 8 years age group of children with Delay developmental (DD), global developmental delays (GDD) and children with disabilities. Whereas one main EI center at Bagalkot and two sub centers are running in Shirur and Tulsigeri locations respectively.

Once in three month reassessments will be done to check the child milestones achievement and to set new goals. This will help the team and parents to understand child development with milestones.

Additionally in 14 villages, 38 children received home-based services, while 3 children received follow-up services through Anganwadi Centers. The services provided were tailored to the children's goals and focused on activities such as motor development, fine motor activities, sensory stimulation, positioning, communication, play, special education and sharing information on Govt. schemes

Nutrition support:

The key area of early intervention programme is focusing on nutritional food; awareness on importance of nutrition food created during the parents training by avoiding packaged food instead served cereals' biscuits and raagi malt to feed the children. The EI team continuously

focuses on child nutritional food which is leading good and healthy development in children. Bagalkot- 69, Tulsigeri-26, Shirur-35 , **Total 130** children were getting continuous support of nutrition food either Anganwadi centers or main stream school.

Veeresh M. Hampiholimath, aged 3.2 years, was enrolled in the Early Intervention Program in April 2024. At the time of joining, he had behavioral issues, sensory difficulties, and developmental delays. He could not sit still, hold objects, or interact socially. Crawling and walking milestones were not achieved—he moved by scooting. He also had a jaw condition that restricted his mouth opening, limiting him to a liquid diet.

EI service and rehabilitation support:

He was identified and referred by Anganwadi workers, who connected the family to the Birds Organization and the District Early Intervention Centre (DEIC). Once enrolled, Veeresh received activity-based services, sensory stimulation, and positioning exercises. His

parents attended training and awareness programs, where they learned about Global Developmental Delay (GDD) and the importance of early support.

Impact of EI service:

Over time, Veeresh showed remarkable progress. He began walking 8–10 steps independently and using a rollator. He now takes part in preschool activities such as sorting, matching, puzzles, and has developed ADL (Activities of Daily Living) skills. He won a prize in a Gokulashtami fancy dress competition, bringing joy to his family. Veeresh now attends Anganwadi regularly, eats meals independently, and visits the therapy center daily. He is using words and expressing himself with actions. His caregivers are happy with his development and are actively sharing their experiences to raise awareness and help other families in similar situations.

5. Egg MDM Programme

Districts Covered: 1. Belgaum 2. Belgaum - Chikkodi 3. Vijayapura 4. Bagalkot

Objectives of the project:

1. To promote continuous learning and intellectual development of school Students by joining hands with the theatre department.
2. To increase the daily class attendance of students enrolled in schools.
3. To improve and develop the overall physical health and growth of students.
4. To eliminate malnutrition and anemia among students.
5. To support the nutrition of students by extending the 2-day supplementary Food provided by the state government to all days of the week and Providing it on additional 4 days a week.
6. To provide other supplementary food with equal multi-nutrient content to Students who do not receive eggs.

❖ Nature of the event:

Azim Premji Foundation for Development will provide supplementary nutritious food to students of classes 1 to 10 of all government and aided primary and high schools and also to pre-primary (LKG, UKG) students enrolled in government schools, starting from the current fiscal year, on all 4 days of the week, i.e. 6 days (excluding 2 days provided by the government). This will enable each student to be provided with supplementary nutritious food on a total of 6 school days in a week. And APF will take steps as per the agreement to provide necessary financial assistance to the students who are not receiving eggs at a daily unit cost of Rs. 6 per student, by purchasing groundnuts or bananas and distributing them as per the daily attendance of the school students. This activity will be carried out by visiting the selected schools and M&E evaluation will be undertaken as per the agreement and the government orders.

❖ M & E Evaluation Process:

- 1) Visiting a school every day.
- 2) Evaluating the implementation of the scheme in the school as per the instructions and Procedures.
- 3) Submitting daily reports.

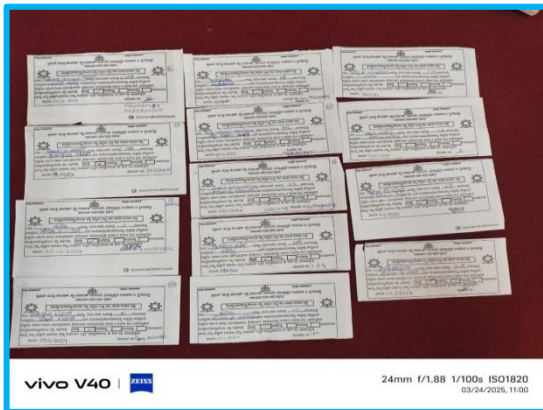
❖ Components of M & E Evaluation:

- Evaluation of registration, acceptance.
- Evaluation of SDMC Committee.

- Evaluation of procurement process.
- Evaluation of intake and attendance.
- Evaluation of quality and quantity

❖ **Registration, consent assessment:**

Ten coordinators of the organization visited the government and non-government schools given for evaluation, reviewed the information entered in the blackboard of the schools, checked the registration book, SAT information and after getting information about the registration with the head teachers, they visited the school



rooms and prepared a numerical verification report of the children present from the school attendance books based on the head count of the children. Through this numerical report, the attendance of the hot meal scheme was analysed and the differences and adjustments were observed. It was found that in many schools the attendance and MDM book were adjusted and reported.

❖ **SDMC Committee Evaluation:**

SDMC committees have been formed in the government schools visited. The schools are aided schools and have their own governing bodies. The school is a school of the Minority Department where the head teacher looks after the administration. It has been



observed that many committees are not actively working in the MDM scheme. It has also been observed that everything is entrusted to the head teachers and it is not properly supervised in many schools. In some school committees, the members have not been informed about the procurement process.

Evaluation of the purchasing process:

When visiting schools at present, most of the schools have not made purchases in accordance with the SOP. In all schools, 3 groceries are being purchased in the interest of the teachers. And they purchase every day, every other day, and 2 days a week in cash as per their convenience.



The SOP has not been formulated in the purchase committee. In most of the schools, bills have not even been maintained. And the rational price lists have not been maintained in many schools. Only in a few schools, the rational price lists have been taken and the purchase process has been done.

❖ **Assessment of intake and attendance:**

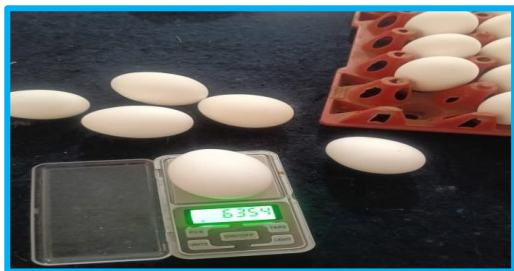
The number of people who eat eggs has been shown to be low and the issues that have been noticed when evaluating this and the points found in the recipes of some schools are: Eggs are a lot of work. It takes a lot of time to bring, beat, peel. On the other hand, since the chakki fruit is simple, the distribution of chakki is high.



Although it is mandatory to distribute eggs every day, it has been observed that many schools are giving priority to chakki. Children are not eating the eggs that come from some institutions because the Eggs are smelly and black in colour and are difficult to eat. Children have said that.

Quality and quantity assessment:

Water tests are being conducted on eggs, eggs are less than 50 grams in some schools. In some schools, 18-25 grams of chickpeas are distributed. In the remaining schools, 35 grams of groundnut chickpeas and 50 grams of eggs are being supplied. Storage facilities are being maintained in the schools.



Opinions of children and parents:

The children's opinion about this program is mostly positive, this program motivates children to come to school every day and helps poor children develop their intelligence by attending government schools.



❖ **Some good points found in the school visit:**

- In some schools, proper and accurate records have been maintained.
- In some schools, eggs are being supplied to children as per the consent of the parents.
- After the start of the egg program, the attendance of children in school is high.
- There has been a positive development in the physical health of children due to the egg Program.
- Teachers' practice in recording children's attendance through the evaluation of the egg Program.
- In some schools, eggs were not supplied from the beginning. After the evaluation visit, Eggs were started to be supplied to children in the school.

❖ **Some points that need improvement found in the school visit.**

- Eggs are not being provided in some schools due to religious and cultural reasons
- Bananas are being provided to the children in the school and it is being mentioned In the Records that eggs have been provided.
- During the assessment, teachers in the school have been taught to tell the children That they do not eat eggs
- Home-based children's attendance is being entered and wrongly stated that eggs Have been provided
- Teachers in the school are providing eggs to guests who come to the school
- The school has not paid the kitchen staff for peeling eggs.
- This activity is not subject to monitoring as per the order from the department.
