The Trust provides **special education, rehabilitation, preventive health care, and health education services** primarily in the rural areas of **Gir Somnath** districts.

In addition to disability-focused services, the Trust also implements various **community health and awareness programs**, including campaigns on **Drug Abuse Prevention, Anti-Illiteracy, General Health Awareness, Beti Bachao, Swachhta Abhiyan, Voter Awareness (Matdata Jagruti Abhiyan), Yoga & Meditation, HIV/AIDS Awareness** and **Mental Health Awareness**. These initiatives aim to provide **preventive, promotive, curative, and rehabilitative health services** for holistic community development.

Special Teaching and Training for Children and Parents

Disha-cum-Vikas Day Care Center, run by Jeevandeep Health Education and Charitable Trust, Kodinar, has been providing comprehensive services on a daily basis to children with special needs such as intellectual disabilities, cerebral palsy, autism, and multiple disabilities. These services include special education, physiotherapy, speech therapy, pre-vocational and computer training, parent counseling, LPC (Local Project Committee) meetings, and regular parent meetings. These initiatives have significantly contributed to the holistic development and empowerment of the children.





Parent counseling & Parents Meeting



Conducting regular monthly meetings parents of the beneficiaries participate in these meetings. During the meetings, members are provided with detailed updates on the ongoing activities at the Centre. These include Physiotherapy, Special Education, Counseling, Daily Living Activities, Pre-vocational and Vocational Training. Comprehensive information is shared on each child's progress, services rendered, and overall financial aspects of the program. The platform also allows all members to share their feedback and suggestions for further improvement of the services and the development of children with special needs. These meetings play a vital role in participatory planning and transparency in program execution.

Mid-Day Meal Program for Children with Disabilities:



As part of the welfare and health initiative, Jeevandeep Health Education and Charitable Trust, Kodinar, provides a nutritious mid-day meal to all children with disabilities attending the centre on a daily basis. The meals are planned to meet the dietary needs of the children, promoting their physical development, overall well-being, and improved participation in daily educational and therapeutic activities.

The initiative not only ensures food security for children from underprivileged backgrounds but also plays a crucial role in supporting their growth and concentration. The program is implemented with proper hygiene and care, contributing to a healthy learning environment.

CAB Meeting Organized under TI Project

PMPSE Training and Field Survey under TI Project



The TI Project, Junagadh, organized PMPSE training for Peer Educators as per GSACS guidelines, covering HIF and client form filling, field coordination with KPs, and practical orientation. Following the training, a PMPSE survey was conducted in Kailash Nagar area with support from the DAPCU team, including on-site monitoring, data collection, and guidance, leading to successful completion of the activity.

Demand Generation Meeting for HIV Testing Awareness and Outreach Expansion



Under the Demand Generation Meeting, discussions were held with project beneficiaries (KPs) regarding HIV and RPR testing, identification of new areas and KPs, and strategies to expand service outreach. The initiative aimed to reach more beneficiaries with essential health services and strengthen prevention efforts against HIV/AIDS.

Observance of Key Days for Awareness under TI Project

Under the TI Project, Junagadh, the annual performance was successfully achieved as per defined indicators. Key indicators included identification and registration of target groups (FSW/MSM), completion of HIF forms, regular HIV and RPR testing, linkage to STI/RTI treatment services, condom distribution, and Behaviour Change Communication (BCC) activities. The project team expanded outreach by identifying new areas and key populations, while strengthening linkages with health services such as ICTC, ART, and TB programs to ensure timely care and support. 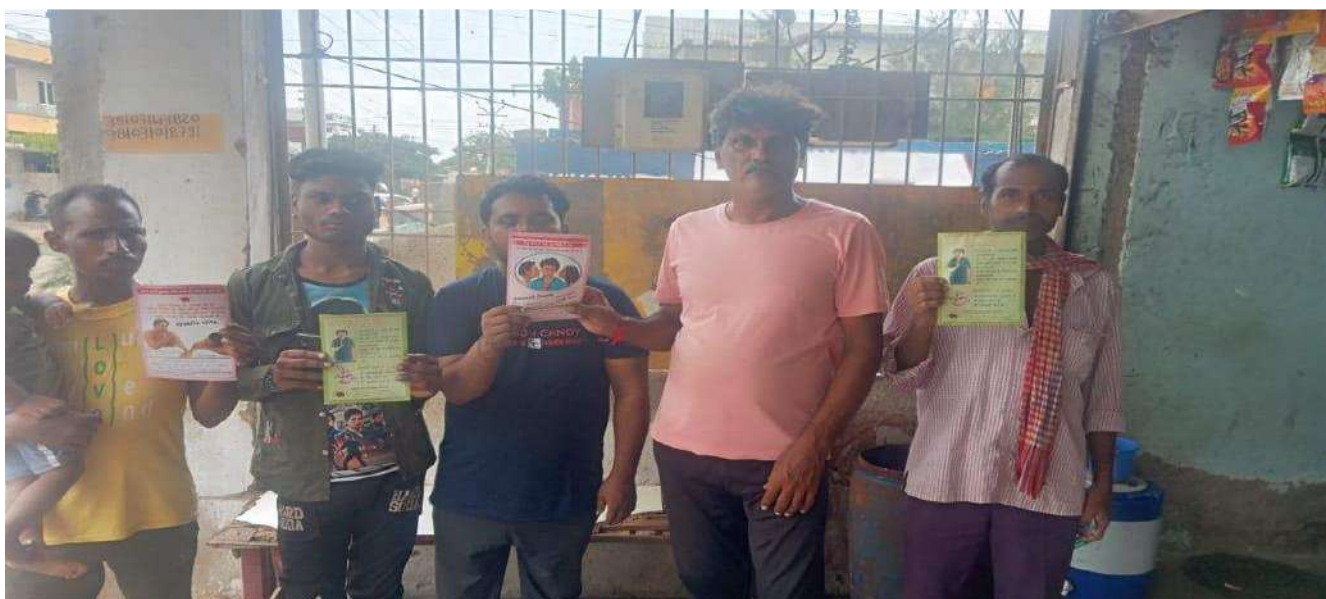
Demand Generation Meeting Conducted

Under the TI Project, Gandhidham, implemented by Jeevandeep Organization with the support of Gujarat State AIDS Control Society, Ahmedabad, demand generation meetings were organized during the year as per project needs and guidelines, wherein awareness was provided on HIV/RPR/HCV/HBV and TB; participants were educated on the major modes of HIV transmission and encouraged for regular testing, discussions were held with SM regarding condom demand highlighting the current shortage of free condoms, and guidance was given to HRGs on condom usage, regular medical check-ups, and available clinic services including PRISM treatment and STI management.



Health Awareness Program under Intensified IEC Campaign

Under the TI Project, Gandhidham, implemented by Jeevandeep Organization in coordination with the District TB-HIV Officer and Disha Unit, an intensified IEC campaign was conducted in Ganesh Nagar and Shivaji Park areas, where ICTC counselors and outreach workers provided detailed awareness on the symptoms, diagnosis, and prevention of TB and HIV, encouraging early testing and treatment; IEC materials such as pamphlets and posters were distributed to sustain awareness, and information was also shared on government health services, health cards, financial assistance during treatment, and other welfare schemes available to the community.



Observance of Key Days and Awareness Activities

Under the TI Project, Gandhidham, implemented by Jeevandeep Organization, various important days were observed throughout the year to promote public awareness; International Yoga Day was celebrated to highlight the importance of yoga and a healthy lifestyle, World Hepatitis Day included awareness programs and health camps at multiple locations to educate people about hepatitis, Independence Day was commemorated with flag hoisting and the national anthem at Rambagh Hospital in the presence of dignitaries and staff, and World AIDS Day was observed in collaboration with Gandhidham Police A Division, Women Police Station, and the community through an awareness program at Adipur Akhada to spread knowledge about HIV/AIDS; these observances collectively contributed to enhancing awareness on health, national values, and social responsibility among the public.



Review Meeting and Training for TI Migrant Link Workers

A review meeting and training session for all TI Migrant Link Workers was organized under the guidance of the DTHO, TB Hospital Bhuj, and Disha Program staff, where project progress related to HIV/RPR/RMC/Clinic/TB/PLHIV was discussed along with the functioning of ICTC/FICTC centers across Kutch and strategies for linking beneficiaries with social welfare schemes; training was provided on improving weak performance and maintaining proper documentation, while the gap in HIV testing in TI Project Gandhidham due to kit shortage was addressed and assured to be fulfilled by DAPCU; additionally, during the PMPS-DAPCU meeting, GSACS M&E officer Mr. Bhupatsinh Jadeja guided that counseling and referral dates at ICTC should match, and further orientation was given on free and SM condom availability, strengthening ART linkages, and working based on PLHIV data.

HSS (HIV Sentinel Surveillance) Activity and Monitoring

Under the TI Project, Gandhidham, implemented by Jeevandeep Organization with the support of GSACS, training was provided to PE and ORW on HSS (HIV Sentinel Surveillance), focusing on roles and effective teamwork; subsequently, HSS activities were carried out including HRG counseling, consent and data documentation, and DBS blood sample collection as per protocol, with monitoring and guidance provided by Dr. Sunil Nayak to strengthen implementation.



Awareness and Event Program for MSM Community

An event was organized under the TI Project, Gandhidham, implemented by Jeevandeep Organization with the support of GSACS, for the MSM community, where PE and ORW provided in-depth guidance on HIV/AIDS, information about organizational services, and discussions on confidentiality and safe practices; participants actively engaged in the event, promoting community bonding and awareness.



Evaluation of TI Project by NACO Team

As per NACO guidelines, an evaluation of the TI Project, Gandhidham, implemented by Jeevandeep Organization, was conducted by the NACO team, which included review of documents, field visits, beneficiary interactions, and assessment of ICTC services; on the final day, discussions were held with the Project Director to strengthen project implementation and effectiveness.
