

# Annual sports for Person in special needs:



Krishnapur Unprivileged Service Society has organized Annual Sports for Person in Special Needs (for MR & CP Category Children).

KUSS organized a cultural programme at Krishnapur village. All members and volunteers of KUSS participated in the programme.

# Remedial Coaching Centre:

KUSS has been running a Programme for Remedial Coaching Classes for the Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe students since 2020. The purpose is to uplift the academic standard of

these classes. Objectives of the coaching center are:

- 1. Aim to extend knowledge, stimulate learning and promote understanding for the upliftment as well as welfare of the marginalized populations in general.
- 2. To select area of their difficulties and arrange programs to remove these difficulties.
- 3. To minimize drop out ratio.
- 4. To strive for overall development of students.
- 5. To fulfil their academic requirements.
- 6. To focus on students of the rural and hilly region who are relatively in soft skills.

The students at Krishnapur village attend the remedial coaching center. The remedial coaching center remains open from 7:30am to 9:00am expect Sunday.

# World Disabled Day Observation:

Krishnapur Unprivileged Service Society in collaboration with DMKK celebrated International Disabled day on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2023. The beneficiaries and children under Niyoti Day Care Centre & Jamuna Balika Abas celebrated the Day gorgeously in Dantan –I Block. 

Skill development not only creates employment opportunities but also empowers them.

The aim of skill development, in case of women is not just simply preparing them for jobs: but also to boost their performance by improving the quality of work in which they are involved. Krishnapur Unprivileged Service Society conducted training programme in Nayagram block. Vulnerable & disadvantaged women from various SHGs were imparted training on Sabai



Craft. Total 30 women were trained. Each participant was given certificate after completion the training programme. Most of the trainees have started micro enterprise after completion the training at household level.

# Skill Training on Animal Husbandry:-



Krishnapur Unprivileged Service Society conducted a training programme in Dantan-1 block on Animal husbandry. Total 30 women were imparted training. The training programme was continuing for 05 days. Block Livestock Development officer along with VS and other expertise are attended the training & they took session also. Trainees of the Animal Husbandry

training have started micro entrepreneurship after the training. Imcome of the trainees is now on average Rs 2000/- per month per head.





Students generally come in the evening time. There are several reference books for the students.
