1. SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL CENTRE FOR MENTALLY TREARDED

The Kongu Arivalayam Special School for Mentally Retarded was started in the year 1988. The school is providing special education to mentally retarded children in the age group of 6 to 18 years. There are currently 73 students getting trained in our school. The classification of children is done according to the chronological age and mental age. In this centre, many awareness programmes are conducted for Anganwadi workers, Nursing and Medical students, Social workers and the general public.

The mentally retarded children are trained in self-help skills like dressing, grooming, toileting, eating and personal hygiene.

- Pre-Vocational Training

2. PHYSIOTHERAPY UNIT

One Physiotherapist visits the school on regular basis to provide therapy for children.

Parents of the children are also given training for continuation of therapy at home.

3. SPEECH AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Speech and occupational therapy services are also provided for the overall development of children with intellectual disabilities.
