A Voluntary Organization named as “Jewels International” was established at Bhubaneswar in the year 1977 to perform Social Service and conduct Mass Education Programmes. The Organization was registered under the Societies Registration Act. No. XXI of 1860, by the Registrar of Societies, Cuttack, on 27th July, 1977. In the year 1985, the Organization decided to work for the education of Children with Intellectual Disability. The same resulted in the establishment of an Institution named Chetana Institute for the Mentally Handicapped (CIMH) in June, 1986.

- To run various University level Courses in collaboration with Indian and Foreign Universities.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR ADULT INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY

The special education centre of CIMH offers Vocational Training to the Mentally Retarded Persons with a futuristic view of vocational placement. The Bhubaneswar Centre gives intensive Training on Candle making, Envelope making, Paper Packet

making, Mosquito Net making, Phenyl manufacturing, Gardening, Diary, Tailoring, Grain Mill and Spices Unit, Detergent Powder & Liquid Soap Unit, Cover File and Note book Making.

The Balakati School imparts training in Coir products like Rope and Door Mat making, and Gardening.

Therapeutic and Rehabilitative Services

The Project provides Institution based and Home based Special Education, Therapeutic and Rehabilitative Services to persons with Intellectual Disability in Domapada&Banki Block with the financial support from SSEPD Department, Govt. of Odisha. The beneficiaries belong to all age groups. The major activities under the project include door to door survey, identification, early intervention, special education, Therapeutic Services, vocational training and rehabilitation services.

Residential facility to the beneficiaries is provided at Domapda Campus. The campus has facility to provide vocational training in agriculture and horticulture.

The campus also extends facility for pre-vocational and vocational training to persons with intellectual disability in the age groups of 14 to 18 years and 18 years + respectively to all persons with intellectual disability in the State including students of other special schools free of cost as per the approval of the SSEPD Department.

COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION PROGRAMMES(CBR) INCOLLABORATION WITH LEBENSHILFE, GERMANY

Chetana Institute has implemented a project entitled "Help for the persons with Mental Handicap and their families in Odisha" with effect from 1st April, 1999 to 31stDecember, 2002, in collaboration with Lebenshilfe (Germany) & Ministry of Economic Co-operation & Development, Govt. of Germany. The project was implemented in 16 Community Development Blocks spread over 12 Districts of the State. Training and Orientation programmes for the local people such as Sarpanches, Block level Officers, District level Officers, ICDS functionaries, Parents, and other NGOs were conducted as a part of project activity. Due to the patronage of the District Administration, and the Parents, 6 Special Schools have been established at Paralekhemundi, Nuapada, Nabarangapur, Koraput, Rourkela, and Jaraka.

The organization also implemented Community Based Rehabilitation Programme in Kesinga Block of Kalahandi District from 1999 to 2002 with financial assistance from CBR Forum, Bangalore, in the above noted model.

The Organisation has implemented Community Based Rehabilitation Project under title "Help for the persons with Disabilities and their families in Odisha" with effect from 1st May, 2005 to 31st December, 2008, in collaboration with Lebenshilfe (Germany) & Ministry of Economic Co-operation & Development, Govt. of Germany. The project was implemented in 08 Community Development Blocks spread over 05 Districts of the State. The CD Blocks are Oupada of Balasore District, Dhamnagar of Bhadrak District, Dharmasala and Rasulpur of Jajpur District, Banki and Athagarh of Cuttack District, Tikabali and G.Udaygiri of Kandhamal District.

The Institute has conducted a large number of training programmes on Mental Retardation and Disability beginning from 1993 till date. The abstract of the training programmes is given in the following Table.

SELF-HELP GROUP

Jewels International has formed a number of 50 Self-Help Groups for the Disabled Persons and their Parents in 16 CBR Units during the period April, 1999 to December, 2002. Each Self-Help Group was given an amount of Rs. 10,000/- as Revolving Fund. The groups are utilizing this money for different Vocational activities of the Disabled persons and their Family Members.

During the second major CBR Project implemented from 1st May 2005 to 31st December 2008 the Organization has formed 100 numbers of Self Help Group for the Disable Persons and provided an amount of Rs. 10,000/- each to 80 Self Help Groups.

BLOCK LEVEL ASSOCIATION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

The Organization has already formed 8 numbers of Associations at various Blocks. The main Objective of the Association is to help the members for availing various facilities provided by Government and Non-Government Agencies.

LIFELINE EXPRESS HEALTH CAMP

The organization conducted the Lifeline Express Health Camp at Kesinga Railway Station of Kalahandi District from November, 1994 to January, 1995. Surgical treatment was provided to 366 cataract cases, 225 polio cases, and 148 deaf cases.

The programme was conducted in collaboration with Rajiv Gandhi Foundation, New Delhi, Impact India Foundation, Mumbai, Nehru Yubak Kendra, Kalahandi, UNICEF, and Collector, Kalahandi. A number of Local Voluntary Organisations also rendered a helping hand to make the programme a success.

RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION

The Institute has been recognized as a place of Research on Mental Retardation and Psychology by the Utkal University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha. The Institute is providing place of research facility to the M.A., M.Phil, and Ph.D. students of Psychology Department, Utkal University. Every year, several students from the Department of Psychology collect data from Chetana Special School for their M.A., M.Phil and Ph.D. Research work.

The Institute was publishing a Bi-annual Scientific Journal under the caption "Indian Journal of Mental Health and Disabilities". The First issue of first volume was published in January, 1996 and the second issue was brought out in July, 1996, 3rd& 4th issues were published in July, 1998. The 5th& 6th issues were published in January, 2003. The Institute is going to publish a Bi-annual Journal with ISSN No. named "Chetana Journal of Social Science".
