

Nectar thought stream

Maheshbhai Kothari's life has blossomed with the nectar of love. The definition of love is determined by renunciation. The meaning of renunciation is the need to dedicate oneself to the protection of others. Param Pujya Shri Maheshbhai Kothari of Manav Kalyan Trust had acquired the knowledge of some formulas to make the best use of time for Divyang children. It is important to have an understanding of the priorities of the work and to have a goal in life. The work of the organization in life was divided into four levels. First, important and urgent tasks have to be completed as soon as possible without wasting time. They can be handed over to their partner. The fourth type of tasks that are not very important or urgent can be done when the time comes.

The following points have been taken into consideration while constructing the magnificent pyramid building of this organization. Planning, making and implementing chats, concentration, peak time, start with small and simple tasks, make good use of leisure time. Due to the constant listening to the discourses of the saints Mahasanto Divyang children about God in the Pavandham of the Ashram of Manav Kalyan Trust, he was the pioneer of spiritual progress and self-confidence in the vast, vast ocean form of work, perseverance, mindfulness and joy.

A brief history of the organization

The Manav Kalyan Trust was established in the year 1970 in the holy memory of the late Shri Pravinchandra Savjibhai Kothari with the auspicious intention that disabled children can live with dignity in the society as well as earn their own living. A residential school for mentally retarded children was started in the year 1992. At that time there was no such residential school between Mumbai and Vadodara. Sp. The Handicapped Training and Rehabilitation Udyog Bhavan was started in the year 1995 to train the children in various industries along with their studies. At present 200 spas of other states besides Gujarat, Maharashtra. The children are studying in the training center and taking training in various industries.

Land was acquired by Gujarat Government in collaboration with Gujarat Krishi University. With the help of Balaji Charitable Trust Navsari and charitable donors, it became possible to build the world's first pyramid building on this land. The inauguration of the realized building took place on 8th February, 2003 at Param Pu. It was done by the hand of Saint Shri Moraribapu.

In this building, the mental development of mentally retarded children is provided with nutritious pyramid therapy, color therapy, water therapy as well as respiratory therapy. Each of these therapies plays an important role in the physical development of children. Pyramid-based global waves, rainbow waves, musical beginnings, ayurvedic herbs and colorful water fountains have been instrumental in the physical and mental development of children. And started a physiotherapy center for children. A variety of physio exercises as per the need of these children by a qualified physiotherapist is performed. Adequate equipment is available at the physiotherapy center for this. In addition, this section provides guidance to parents on these perplexing questions by expert psychologists, doctors and teachers.

Param Poo. Started on a small scale by the holy steps and blessings of saints like Mahatma Shri Moraribapu, this organization has spread like a giant tree. We feel a sense of pride and gratitude for accepting all these loans.

The founder and pioneer of the organization late. Shri Maheshbhai Kothari's sentiments and experience have helped the organization to expand its international profile. Which self. This has been possible only due to the foresight of Shri Maheshbhai Kothari and his immense empathy towards these children. Today, Divyang children are studying and training in various industries in an environment full of natural beauty. Children are provided free board and lodging and education.

The Disability Training and Rehabilitation Udyog Bhavan has been started with the objective of enabling children with disabilities to get industrial training and earn a living in the society and become self reliant without dependence on others. In this Udyog Bhavan children are trained in industries like printing press, photo lamination, embroidery, candle, handloom, incense stick, paper bag, computer etc.






All services are provided free of cost to disabled children

Manav Kalyan Trust managed by Shri Mandabuddhi Multipurpose School for Children, Navsari which is dedicated to work for children / adults with intellectual and multiple disabilities. The school was started from 19 with the aim of providing quality services. The school with pyramid building was started with the blessings of Sant Shri Moraribapu.

All services are provided free of cost to disabled children. At present, 215 disabled children are classified into 12 different groups based on their age and ability. Functional curriculum is a unique method for each group according to 7 areas which is given special worksheets, teaching materials and special education to children. School activities include curriculum as well as co-curricular activities for holistic development and healthy development of the child / adult. Individual child's progress is self-assessed three times a year using a functional assessment checklist certified by NIEPID (National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disability). The individual development of each child, including rehabilitation, includes a psychologist, specialist teacher, physiotherapist and parent. Parents are regularly guided to take care of their child's holistic development. Children receive regular physiotherapy, speech therapy, play therapy, yoga, sensory therapy, music and dance therapy, ADL training and life skills training to become more independent and contributing members of the family and community. Physiotherapy for children with cerebral palsy is an important part of school work. All children attending school with cerebral palsy are given physiotherapy to improve their skills and mobility. Regular counseling is organized for parents and children







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Features

During the academic year 2020-2021, due to the Kovid 19 epidemic, the school was closed to children from 15th March 2020 as per the government order. The latter, from 22nd March 2020, was the lockdown period for all of them. This was a precautionary measure by the government due to the epidemic situation. During this period, videos and audios were shared with the parents by the principal and teachers to take care of themselves and their families. Regular parental counseling was given to keep the child active and maintain the child's routine. Parents were encouraged to share videos of children's activities for further guidance. The principal and all were in regular contact with the parents for the development of the child's teachers.

Education during lockdown



Since June 2020, the school has started for all teachers. The children were still out of school; Therefore, many virtual activities were started. During the first phase, staff training was conducted to make teachers aware of group video calling and a schedule for group video calling was prepared for the children. Parents were made aware of the schedule and were informed about the virtual training to be conducted. As part of the virtual activities, short educational videos were prepared for the children by the class teachers and physiotherapists. They were divided into groups as well as individually according to the level and need of the child. Parents were asked to do the activity as shown in the video and share the child's video after the activity. Parents took an active part in this activity and shared many videos of the children's activities. The children were motivated to do the activity because it was their teacher's instruction. Moving on to the next phase, weekly group sessions were launched on September 10 using the Google Meet and Zoom app. Parents were assisted to join the group and to carry out activities as directed by the teachers during the sessions. Proper planning was done by the teachers before the session. The various activities listed below were performed during the session. The children participated in activities with their parents..

Covid-19 epidemic honors frontline Corona Warriors



Niramaya Health Policy

During the year 2020-21, 141 policies covering students of multipurpose school for mentally retarded children were registered.

Awareness for the scheme was spread through virtual and non-virtual meetings among the maximum beneficiaries to avail the benefits of the Policy for Mentally Retarded Children, Navsari. Parents were guided to fill up the claim form and avail the maximum benefits of the policy. Under their policy, Rs. 27,850 / - (Rupees twenty seven thousand eight hundred and fifty in number) were paid by the organization. Most parents are free to fill out claim forms and receive regular follow-up from the claim company. Many parents are getting regular claims for their ongoing medications for epilepsy and other medical problems. * Grants are allocated for policies by the government. As such, the policy was provided free of cost to all the beneficiaries.

The school registered under the Fit India Movement on 15th December 2020 and got the certificate for the same. All staff members also registered individually under the movement and received certificates.

We organized a number of virtual events at school as well as district level to make children active and raise awareness among parents and society.

Guided six guardians to renew disability certificates to continue receiving benefits.

Received their renewed certificates. Ten new and five renewal bus pass forms were filled and submitted to the social protection office.

27 Monthly Rs. 1000 / - as pension after completion of legal formalities and paperwork. The children started getting pension from January 2021.

. 43 students received scholarships from the Department of Social Defense. An online form with all the required information was filled and submitted by the school.

141 Niramaya policies were registered during the year 20-21. The parents received a claim amount of about Rs. 500 to 40000 from the policy. They were motivated to get claims.

And regular follow-ups were taken for unresolved claims to help parents resolve the issue. Children in secondary and vocational groups were encouraged with stipend.

Fill out an online Guardianship form with all required documents and information. Parents were instructed to revise the document before filling out the Guardianship form.

UDID cards were made to help new and OPD beneficiaries. They were made aware of the benefits and importance of the card.

During the year, building maintenance works like cleaning of water tank, paste scol for faults, ground cleaning, gardening, floor repairing, dome sheet repairing etc. were done.

The well-wishers bought various items made by the Divyang children of the multi-purpose school for the children of Shri Mandabuddhi and cooperated to make the Divyang children self-reliant in the society.
