Tiljala seeks to empower and transform the lives of rag pickers and their families who have been neglected and socially ostracized. It also works with related vulnerable groups like child labourers and street dwellers. Their efforts are concentrated on uplifting the poorest of the poor in the slums and squatter camps in the city, who lack even the most basic necessities like safe drinking water and sanitation.
