#### PROFESSIONALS:

The Organization has deployed best of professionals to look into the various projects. It has employed six fulltime and four part-time professionals to look after various project activities. Besides, more than twenty volunteers and social workers are also working at various levels to overseas the activities of the organization at the grass-roots level.

# INSTITUTIONAL SERVICES

SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR THE PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Our organization has been managing 03 Special Schools namely Aasta Institute for the Mentally Handicapped Children, Bichitrananda School for the Deaf & Bichitrananda School for the Blind at Ogalpur, Gop, in the district of Puri.

I) AASTA INSTITUTE FOR THE MENTALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN

"Special School for the Intellectual Disability" which is running at Ogalpur by the organization in a rented building for imparting education to the Mentally Retarded children with the financial assistance from Govt. of Odisha in Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities Department, Bhubaneswar since the year 2018-19. It is established in the year 1991.

Trained & qualified teachers, Special Educator and non-teaching staff are engaged for imparting education and for taking proper care of the students. Health Check-up camps are organized





with the help of Medical Practitioners once in a week in a regular basis. We provide free fooding, free boarding, free Reading Materials, free Medicine, Pleasants accommodation with safe and cool water supply and

electricity. Grassy playgrounds, all types of sports equipment etc. are also provided to the inmates. School uniform on behalf of the organization has been supplied. Special programme Entertainment like Music, Drama & Dance played by them are arranged in different celebrations in a year. The sanction student's strength and

We have received Grant-in-Aid from Govt. of Odisha Rs 16, 26,300.00 towards maintenance, Rs. 59,000.00 towards Uniform, Rs. 13,600.00 towards sweater allowance and Rs. 10,000.00 towards Sports for the Intellectual Disability students during the year 2023-24. We have observed "World Mental Health Day" inside the campus. One child of our school Sri Tofan Behera has successfully achieved 1st position in 200 mt. races and 2nd position in Shot put event on the occasion of International Day for the Disabled 2023.

## **BICHITRANANDA SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF**

Special School for the Hearing Impaired children has been running since the year 2002 in a rented building at Ogalpur, Gop in the district of Puri. it has been functioning with the financial assistance from Govt. of Odisha in Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities Department, Bhubaneswar since the year 2018-19. Specially trained and qualified teachers have been engaged for imparting quality Education to the Hearing-Impaired students. We have also employed non-teaching staff for taking care of the children in the hostel, preparation of food, washing of clothes and solving their day-to-day life problems. Health Check-up camps are being organized with the help of Medical Practitioner.

We provide attractive arrangements i.e. free Fooding, free Boarding, free Reading Materials, free Medicine. Pleasants accommodation with safe and cool water supply and electricity. Grassy play-grounds, all types of sports equipment etc. are also provided to

> the inmates. School uniform has been supplied on behalf of the organization and also from Govt. of Odisha. We have arranged colour Television for their entertainment. We have installed a generator and inverter to maintain



electricity deficiency. Drama & Dance Govt. of Odisha Rs 14, 15,700.00 towards maintenance, Rs. 50,000.00 towards Uniform, Rs. towards sweater allowance and Rs. 10,000.00 towards Sports for the Hearing Impaired students during the

year 2023-24. We are providing Art Education to Hearing Impaired students through trained Art teachers.

Vocational training has been provided for self-employment of the disabled inmates in the faculty of Tailoring and Computer etc.

#### **BICHITRANANDA SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND:**

"Bichitrananda School for the Visually Impaired" has been established during the year 2005. It has been running in a rented building at Ogalpur with the financial assistance from Govt. of Odisha, in Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities Department, Bhubaneswar since the year 2018. We have employed Trained and Qualified teachers for imparting quality education to the students of our school. The music subject is compulsory for class 1st to 8<sup>th</sup> and as an optional subject for class 7<sup>th</sup> under which the training is given for all instruments like Guitar, Harmonium, Tabla, Drum, Piano, flute... and Congo etc. by trained music teachers. The school is having its own Orchestra.

We have also employed non-teaching staff for proper care taking of the children in the hostel, preparation of food,

washing of clothes and solving their day-to-day life problems.



Health Check-up camps are organized with the help of Medical Practitioners once in a week in a regular basis. We provide free fooding, free boarding. free Reading Materials, free Medicine, Pleasants accommodation with safe and cool water supply and electricity. Grassv play-

Dance played by them are arranged in different celebrations in a year. The craft education is compulsory from class 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. The education includes of canning of Chairs, weaving & spinning of bed sheets & towels on Handloom machines. The running student's strength of the School is 35 nos. We have received Grant-in-Aid from Govt. of Odisha Rs 7, 83,900.00 towards maintenance, Rs. 52,000.00

towards Uniform, Rs. 5950.00 towards sweater allowance and Rs. 10,000.00 towards Sports for the Visually Impaired students during the year 2023-24.For overall physical and mental development of blind students, the school provides



full facilities for games both indoor and outdoor games like playing Cards, Chess, Cricket, football, Kabaddi and other sports facilities. The students of the school participate in almost all major games & sports competitions held at District level.

The following facilities were available in three Special Schools such as The school is having latest kitchen and pantry having all modern facilities like Refrigerators, water purifier and coolers, machine for making Chapattis, machine for needing dough, generator and inverter etc. There are two separate Dining halls for boys & girls having sufficient dining tables and chairs to serve them.

## **NAVADARSHAN PROJECT**

NAVADARSHAN project is a New hope for the Intellectually Disabled Children. It is a CSR initiative of V-Guard Industries Ltd. to support Intellectually Challenged Children and executed by

Odisha Rising Foundation,

Bhubaneswar, Khordha. It is implemented from 1st January 2023. The main objective of the project is to provide quality special education. Therapeutic Treatment and vocational training to Intellectual disability children and their family so that they thrive to build a better future. Its vision is to



empower Intellectually Challenged children and the Mission is to promote Navadarshan meeting ID inclusive development by providing various services to children through treatment and skill training so that they lead a





dignified life. We have received grant of Rs. 3, 31,912/- from Odisha Rising Foundation towards remuneration of Navadarshan staff during the year 2023-24. We are very much thankful to Odisha Rising Foundation and V-Guard Industries Ltd.

## WELFARE OF AGED

## OME FOR THE AGED(JARA NILAYA)

We are running one **Old Age Home** at Ogalpur, Gop, Puri having 25 Nos. of Poor, destitute aged inmates of 3 to 4 districts of our state irrespective of caste, creed and sex. We are glad to receive some new inmates to our home. We have been running this project since 15.03.2018 from our own financial sources. We provide free Fooding & lodging and rehabilitate them through psychological, spiritual & physical treatment programmes. The inmates are provided with cots, nets, chairs, tables, shoes stand, almirahs & material keeping stool. Ramayana, Bhagavat, Mahabharata and other mythological books are reading daily in the home. The aged inmates are provided

with entertainment facilities through Color T.V. Tape Recorder and reading new papers & visiting historical and mythological places. We are also arranging cultural programme like Ramayana, Daskathia, Pala, and Bhagavat & Gita Charcha for religious development of aged inmates. The organization has established a senior citizens club at Maa Bhagabati Seva Sangha in the district of Puri. In addition to providing Tiffin, the members were provided with facilities such as free library, free outing. Yoga training, indoor games etc. They are stimulated to participate in the project to use their potential for self-development. Once the major objectives of this program is to make them economically sound and develop acceptability in their family as well as in Society The beneficiaries of the home themselves involved in

such activities that would promote co-operation and fellow feeling to enjoy their stay. Besides periodically counseling is made to understand the sentiment of the beneficiaries leading to their psychological rehabilitation.

## ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAM

We have to protect and save the environment to maintain the ecological balance. Pollution arises due to population explosion, rapid growth of deforestation and industrialization. Looking at the urgency and essentiality of the situation, Organization has been putting its best efforts to organize people to save the nature from exploitation. This year, it organized a one-day awareness program on environment at Bedapur of Gop block, with a view to promote environmental protection in the rural areas, with special emphasis on water and waste disposal management About 200 villagers participated in the program. Forest Department Officials and local Social Activists also attended the program. They made people aware about Environmental degradation and motivated them to plant trees in their localities as a Measure towards protection and ecological balance.

#### YOGA TRAINING

Indian Culture is closely associated with Yoga and Pranayama. Practicing Yoga has not only spiritual value but it has also great value in keeping one fit and healthy. Recently yoga has been found immensely popular among the people all over the world Yoga practice should be imbedded at a very young age. Thus, in order to do that organization is teaching the school children yoga in the district of Puri. At present the Organization is involved in teaching yoga to school children in the schools. In future we plan to make this programme in much bigger scale.

#### OMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

A major area of concern for the organization has been the "Women Development Since last 5 years it has taken up well planned programmes of awareness general. Group formation. Leadership development, skill training and income generation programmes for women. In fact, it is the part of broad framework of raising the status of women in the area, especially of the under-privileged categories. Secondly, the strategy the organization towards any developmental effort has been the involvement of women as catalysts.

In order to involve the village women in the process, the first and foremost approach has been women meetings and awareness camps for them. Last year the organization had organized a number of women meetings, training and awareness camps. The camps have experienced the lectures, discussions, audio-visual shows, at lets and

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posters etc. as the method of communication. The theme has covered women related subject like: Society, women and their rights, Atrocities on women, Women and law, Need for women's organization, Economic independence and self-employment of women, Women and environment, Women leadership, Anti dowry campaign. Small saving, SHG formation, Opportunities and facilities for women from Govt. and Non Govt. sources.

## COMMUNITY ORGANISATION

Strengthening of the existing C.B.Os Women SHG groups, youth groups and VDCs for their own community development form the basis of the group's intervention. This is being done through facilitating village level meetings,

support to the SHGS, facilitating community access to the government offices, etc. Through this process the 278 women groups already promoted by MAA BHAGABATI SEVA SANGHA would be rendered intensive promotional inputs by way of imparting Leadership training to their leaders. The leaders of these village levels groups would also be enabled to gain skills on Social Analysis, Micro Planning, group management; knowledge on various government schemes, Rights based law of the land protecting the interests of rural neglected poor women and that of the women of the community.

## LEGAL AID:

Going by the complexities of problems surrounding the poor harassed women at the household to community level it is envisaged that the process of empowerment needs to take care of the victims of atrocities. This advocates the cause of the Girls/women trafficking process in the area with the growing Bridegroom Market where young girls of poor families are sold to pimps and desperate Bride from outside states. In addition to this the group had helped 20 victims of household abuse, untouchability, and rights on health/education and liberty to pursue a vocation.

## LEADERSHIP CAMP:

The leadership camps form an important part of the Organization's activity to promote grassroots women leaders. The representatives of the VDCS and WSHGs were given two phase Leadership and skill improvement Training to assist them learn or the group management, government procedures/schemes/laws During this year total of 121 members of the SHGS were trained under this program

## SUPPORT SERVICES:

The organization extends regular guidance and assistance to badly need. Disabled and down trodden youth who approach the organization for getting the benefit of different governmental and non-governmental schemes offering them financial assistance, scholarships and concessions.

## MEETING & SEMINARS



Meeting and seminars are conducted for the youth to decide upon the course of action at various stages of life including career opportunities. Counseling on certain broad issues is also taken in their meetings. Many confused youths feel this is a great help to them and sometimes express the desire to attend more such sessions. Thus, our Organization has been trying to do its best to the community in general and to the economically weaker section in particular.

## HEALTH AWARENESS AND CHECK-UP CAMP:

Various strategies and effective actions were adopted to make the people fully aware and educated through cultural show, group awareness, village meetings poster exhibition, door to door campaigns motivation etc. In different clusters and places health our dedicated physicians' Volunteers, paramedical workers and social activities Organized check-up camps.

#### **COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAMME**

For improvement of health status, in 5 villages of GOP Block of Puri District. Community development programme is being running with our volunteers, animators, physician's paramedical workers and social. Exposure visits of Health teams to health checkup, distribution of medicines, trained village/slum leaders about first Aid maternity and childcare Ante-natal care given to mother etc.,

## MALARIA ERADICATION PROGRAMME:

The entire district is a malaria endemic region Hundreds of people suffer Malaria every year. Sometimes the disease becomes fatal with a little precaution, this disease can be prevented. Thus, the organization undertook 1 drive to make the people aware how to prevent malaria by keeping their environment clean and using mosquito nets Quinine tablets are given to the people as a preventive measure. The organization was organized 4 camps towards awareness about malaria in GOP Block of Puri district

#### IALACHHATRA

People of our state are facing great difficulty during summer season due to extreme heat. Considering the heat our organisation has opened 8 nos. of water distribution stall in different places of Gop, and Nimapada Block, Patelia, Nagpur & Konark. Our volunteers are working hard and serving for the society. They are taking risk of their own. People are resting with great pleasure under the shade.

## CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

There is a myth that cancer cannot be cured. But due to the progress of medical science this dreaded disease has been tamed to a great extent. But I effective cure of cancer early detection is a pre-condition. Women are more panic ratio cancer, especially breast-cancer. But the rural people are largely not aware of this disease. They do not know the methods of detecting it. MAA BHAGABATI SIVA SANGHA organized a Cancer Awareness Camp at Bichitrananda Blind School Campus. In this camp cancer specialists explained to the women how to detect suspected cast of malignancy. More than 150 women and 245 men were participated in this programme.

## WATER & SANITATION PROGRAMME:

Due to the unhygienic conditions like open defecation, unsafe drinking water, non-disposal of solid and liquid waste water-borne diseases are very common in the rural area. The main reason for this unsafe practice can be attributed largely to ignorance. In order to address the problem MBSS organized padayatras, rallies and street plays in GOP Block in Puri district. An attempt was made to spread the message of clean sanitation among the rural people. Several water sources were disinfected as part of the campaign. The people were explained regarding the harmful consequences of oper defecation and urged to use a household latrine. Awareness campaign was also Launched at the local schools as part of the school sanitation programme

#### WELFARE OF GHILD LABOUR

Maa Bhagabati Seva Sangha has identified and takes up to rehabilitate and welfare of the child labour of GOP Block of Puri District. The main cause of child labour is very obvious. It is due to the immoral acts of the grownup, poverty, death of parents,. Collapse of the family, ill treatment, intolerable domestic environment, Crime etc. Due to the severe economic and starvation condition of family children is compelled to do labour for maintenance of family. Objective of welfare services for destitute children should be to rehabilitate them as normal citizens in the community they belong to. The programme should include ameliorative services of food, shelter, clothing, medical attention and curative services of education, pre-vocational training, vocational guidance, recreation and cultural development and citizenship education. The effort has to be made to make the children when they grow up, job worthy. Besides providing services for the destitute children, efforts are required to be made to prevent further spread of destitution among the future Erations

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## HIV/AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAM:

We have conducted HIV/AIDS Awareness program on 15<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2022 at Konark regarding most dreaded disease HIV/AIDS, Oriented youths on the issues of HIV/AIDS for development of conceptual clarity and creation of positive attitude among the community to realize HIV/AIDS as an health hazard adversely affecting the indicates of human development (income poverty and earnings capabilities) and a backdrop against individual liberties and rights. The youths were motivated to mobilize support of their communities for an enlarged community initiative for prevention and alleviation. The AIDS problem and their Gentlemen of the locality and the animators have attended and addressed the meetings.

## CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

The Organization has organized so many awareness meetings at different Gram panchayats of Puri district. It was very successful meeting aimed to lighten the people on different aspects of Consumer awareness. The resource person also highlighted their experience and ideas and enable them to develop and understanding of their problems and ways to tackle them. As discussed earlier, during the year much attention was given towards organizing people and bringing development for their ide about awareness of consumer. During this year organization will awarding about 225 nos of public get & benefited.

## VOCATIONAL TRAINING

The youth of today are at crossroads. After finishing education, they cannot find many jobs as there are not many jobs for them nor they can go back to the villages to undertake farming and related activities Again their present level of skill does not permit them to get a job for themselves in the highly competitive job market. In order to equip the youth with skill Training, MBSS organized several vocational training programmes for the youth, especially for the women.

## Tailoring Programme:

Tailoring and embroidery comes naturally to women. But most of the time ins natural talent is not sophisticated enough to earn them a livelihood. Keeping this reality in mind MBSS continued its training programme on tailoring and dress designing exclusively for women at Bantapada. In this training programme 502 young women from rural areas participated. They were given training in the whole gamut of dress designing, embroidery, appliqué work, patchwork and fabric printing. After the training programme many of the women have established their own units and some have fount suitable employment.

## Bamboo Craft Training:

We conduct the training program on Bamboo Craft for the rural youth of GOP block of Puri district. The main issue of this training programme was to make the house hold Bamboo craft. We would like to prove a point that through our training program we would make them to self-reliable.

# Training on Agarbati Making, white phenyl, chalk:

Keeping in mind the growing popularity of soft-toys in the urban area MBSS started at Agarbati training programme. This received overwhelming response from the women. As many as 250 women showed keen interest to learn the trade. But due to paucity of funds accommodate only 40 trainees.

## Appliqué Works:

The organisation continued its training programme for the women in Readymade garments. This year 12 women trainees mostly belonging to the SCS, STs and OBCs benefited. MBSS took special care to find employment for some of these women after their successful completion of the training programmes.

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## INCOME GENERATION ACTIVITIES:

To encourage the youth for self-employment the organisation is implementing several income generation programmes as model units. These activities are intended to be models for the target group so that they can emulate the activities and can be employed. During the year of reporting MBSS undertook activities like Bamboo & Cane Leaf cup & plate making, poultry, goatary. Agarbati training, pisci-culture, Brass metal etc. in which more than 100 people, mostly youth benefited. Reporting MBSS with the active involvement of the local beneficiaries directly implemented all these programmes After doing the activities on an experimental basis many of these people have taken up their own Income Generation Activities. We are trying to arrange funds for them through local financial institutions.

## LIBRARY

The Organisation has organized a village library in the office premises in district of Puri. The organizers of the Organization collected some valuable books from local people and students to strengthen the library The library has become popular in the village and 25 people including students at an average are attending the library daily.

There is one big library hall in the school containing more than 600 Braille books of all types: including text books of course material, competitive exams books, fiction/novels, story books, holy books like Ramayana, Geeta, Mahabharata, Quran and Bible etc and other various



reference – books for classes 1<sup>st</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>&e higher education also. School subscribes various fortnightly / monthly/ quarterly magazines and Journals useful for blind students and teachers for their updation of current affairs & general knowledge.

## YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

Youth are a source of unbound energy, which can play an important role il tapped properly. In the period of reporting the MBSS organized a week-long youth leadership at GOP block in Puri district. More than 120 youths from the entire two district Participated. The participants were trained on various aspects of youth leadership Including nation building.

#### RURAL SPORTS PROGRAMME

In order to inculcate the spirit of competition among the rural youth the MBSS organized rural sports in the operational area.
