Aadhar Institute of Special Education has been providing Rehabilitation Services & Clinical Services which are high quality as well as comprehensive. There are large numbers of clients from across the State and our country people come for visit in our institute to seeking treatment.






SPECIAL DAYS CELEBRATION






WORKSHOPS/SEMINARS/CONFRENCES
