The Trust was started in 2003 to cater the needs of intellectual disabled children in the rural areas. Towards this goal free pediatric clinic was started in 2003 and it is ongoing.

Special school was started in Elakurru 2004 after conducting mega identification camp with the help of NIMH, secunderabad and Govt., head quarters hospital, Machilipatnam and in 2007 the trust extended its services in two more centers were in Avanigadda and Machilipatnam. In all the 3 centers comprehensive system was evolved i.e, training by special teachers, physiotherapy, speech therapy and medical intervention. The Trust received prestigious Awards 1. National award from the ministry of woman and child welfare of Government of India on 14-11-2012, 2. Nina sibal memorial award 2020 from All India Women Education fund Association on 2/08/2020.
