1. About Us

Prabhata Sindhuri Rehabilitation Centre is a registered NGO and a recognized organization under the **National Trust Act**. We are dedicated to the welfare, education, and empowerment of **children with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDDs)** including Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual Disability, and Multiple Disabilities.

Our mission is to ensure that every child with special needs is given equal opportunities to grow, learn, and lead a dignified life with active participation in society.

2. Vision & Mission

Vision:

To create an inclusive society where children with intellectual and developmental disabilities are empowered to realize their fullest potential.

Mission:

- To provide specialized education, therapy, and rehabilitation services.
 - To empower families with knowledge, training, and emotional support.
 - To promote community participation and awareness about disability inclusion.
 - To advocate for the rights and dignity of persons with disabilities in line with the **National Trust Act**.
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3. Key Programs & Services

During the year 2024–25, the centre has successfully implemented the following programs:

a. Special Education

- Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) for each child.
- Teaching using play-based, activity-oriented methods.
- Integration of digital learning tools for better engagement.

b. Therapeutic Services

- **Physiotherapy:** To improve mobility and gross motor skills.
- **Occupational Therapy:** For enhancing fine motor, daily living, and self-help skills.
- **Speech Therapy:** To improve communication and language abilities.

c. Family Support & Counselling

- Regular parent counselling sessions.
- Home-based training guidance for continued learning.
- Parent support groups to share experiences.

d. Pre-Vocational Training

- Skill-building programs for older children to prepare them for independent living.
- Activities such as crafts, gardening, and functional academics.

e. Awareness & Community Engagement

- Celebrated **World Down syndrome Day, Autism Awareness Month, and World Disability Day.**
 - Conducted community sensitization programs in schools and local communities.
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4. Highlights of the Year

- Admission of **5 new children**, raising total beneficiaries to **45 students**.
- Launch of a **parent resource centre** with learning materials, guides, and counselling support.
- Received **CSR support** from corporate partners and individual donors for infrastructure and therapy equipment.
- Organized an **art exhibition of children's creative works** showcasing talent and creativity.

- Successfully collaborated with local healthcare professionals for early intervention programs.
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5. Achievements

- **Two children** successfully transitioned to mainstream schools with support.
 - **Five young adults** enrolled in pre vocational training programs for skill development.
 - Enhanced accessibility with the addition of ramps and sensory-friendly classrooms.
 - Positive recognition from **local authorities** and **community stakeholders** for inclusive education efforts.
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6. Governance & Compliance

- The centre operates as a **registered NGO** and adheres to the guidelines of the **National Trust Act**.
 - Regular monitoring and audits are conducted to ensure transparency.

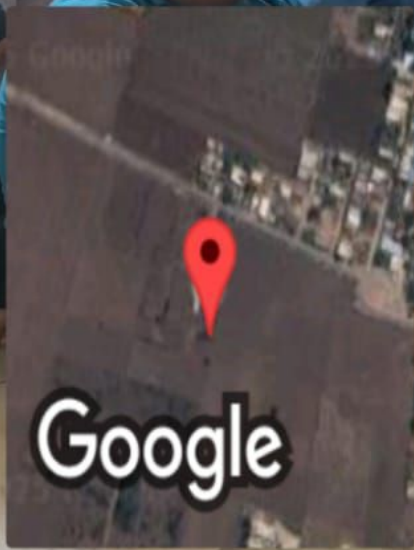


GPS Map Camera

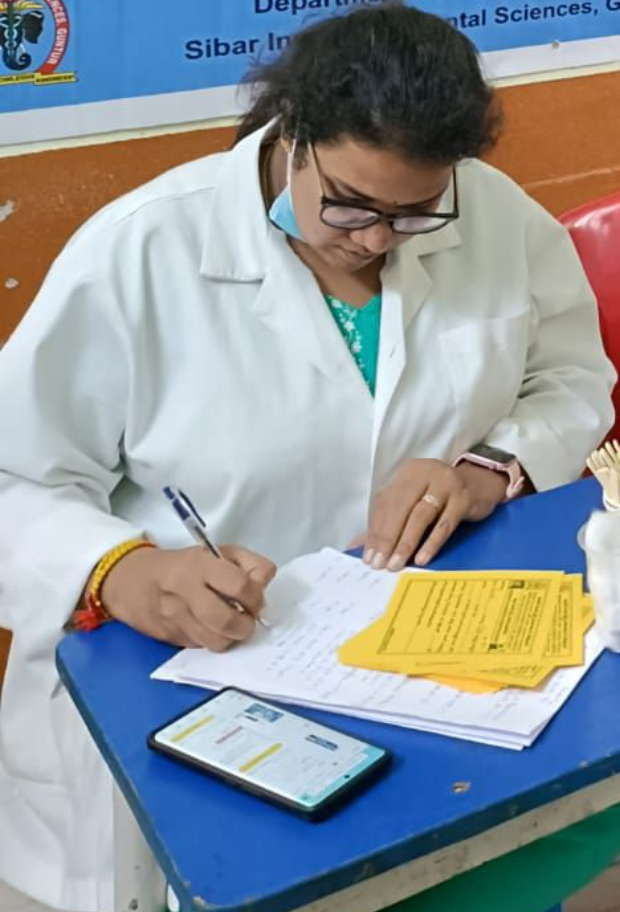
