To have solution to this situation, as per direct Guidance from Ms. Nehalben Gadhvi attempt was made to train children at their home so that they can work from home and contribute the production. This strategy has earned very good result for vocational center. Amongst the tuff competition in the open market, we could achieve remarkable sales through online selling. Along with the sale of products, we have created brand image of Ankur. It has also resulted in the addition to the numbers of our customers, well-wishers and Donors and has started an era of strong relationship with them.

With the memory of rough and full of bushes road of past, present position of glory & proud felling and goal of being roal model school in the country for Mentally challenged children, we are marching towards unknown future.

In the empty campus of Ankur, we are witnessing silent Echoes of children's sweet voices seeing dreams full of feelings in their dry eyes.

Though our Mentally challenged children lives in most ignored position, we are committed to our nation and democracy. For this very purpose, and to motivate them, issuance of Electoral I.D. Card was arranged so that they can utilize their voter rights.

Under the Corona care, we adopted strategy of door step service. Under this strategy, we visited our children's home and educated them for health awareness. We distributed Educational Kit along with Mobile phone, Ration Kit for the Family, and on the occasion of Dipavali, Crakers and sweet to all the children.

As per Government Guideline, various Programs for sanitization, Medical Camp, Vaccination counseling were arranged.

Even though country's economy was suffering due to recession, Ankur was lucky to get continuous flow of donations thanks to the efforts of our Mentor shri Bababhai, Honourable shri Prakashbhai Deasi, other committee members and Brand Ambassador of Ankur Ms. Nehalben Gadhvi.

We are aware that we could not perform in so many matters as we intended. We also know that so many things are yet to be performed. With this awareness, a good team work is going on here. Ankur has passed on many milestones and with the cooperation of you all the Journey will be going on and on.......

1. Academic Highlights



- In Ankur School, Government approved curriculum and Special curriculum for mental retardation students, both are taken care by mixing up them as per level of the children and thus as per the physical fitness and mental position of the children, they are bifurcated to Standard 1 to 6 and are given training and education very systematically.
- This mental retardation children should also participate and be part of current global scenario. with the noble intention to mix up these children with normal children of the society easily, they are exposed to latest electronic Gadgets and concepts like computer, Tablet, Smart Boards, E-Learning and virtual Training.
- Due to Covid-19, as per guidelines of Government, Regular school and classes plus training could not be conducted during the whole year. However on line education was arranged by School. During last year all teachers were given I.C.T. training which became very useful in this year. Due to prior preparation of On line Education by teachers, very useful and interesting material was prepared by teachers. This material and on line education based on this, was imparted to children on WhatsApp by creating various Groups of children on WhatsApp.
- For On Line Education, Starting was done by providing Utube Link to the children for their activities. In the second phase, teachers made some modifications in these videos, dubbed their own voice in the audio and these modified videos were sent to the parents of the children. In the last phase further modifications were carried out and professional video contents were created and such videos, each of 5 minutes were uploaded for on line education.
- To make parents active and participating, videos presenting questions were prepared and sent to parents. To make education interesting for children and improve their involvement, education was imparted through voice messages and screenshots to make it easy and better understanding.

- It is eminent to note here that in the present situation of Covid 19, when ordinary schools are closed and on line Education is imparted where in I.C.T. is used. Even though Ankur is a special school, Maximum use of I.C.T. is done from the year 2016 onwards for the training of the special children. This is a matter of pride for the Ankur for which dedicated efforts of our Hon. Secretary (EDU) Shri D. J. Dhandhukiya sir is praise worthy.
- For the training of Staff for I.C.T. and make them techno savvy, training is arranged regularly. Training is given by I.C.T. Expert Retd.Prof. Shri Navnitbhai Rathod and his Team. This training is given Regularly to all staff members under the able Guidance of our Hon. Secretary (EDU) Shri D. J. Dhandhukiya and our Principal shri Meghjikhan Saybani. Very encouraging results are achieved through this training.
- To enrich our school education, staff meetings are arranged at regular intervals. During academic year 2020-2021 approx. 28 hours brain storming discussions were carried out. Our Hon. Secretary (EDU) Shri D. J. Dhandhukiya and our Principal Shri Meghjikhan Saybani actively participate in these meetings. As per requirement, experts and parents are also included in these meetings.
- With the sincere efforts of our Hon. Secretary (EDU) Shri D. J. Dhandhukiya, entire campus of Ankur is having WI FI facility now.
- ⇒ For the better treatment of speech therapy for the children having speech problem, a new software viz."AAWAZ" has been installed to have digitalized medium of treatment.
- All class teachers presented success story of their student whose progress was worth to mention and deserves to be appreciated.
- A survey was conducted of all parents bifurcating them to active or inactive parents. Inactive parents were given proper guidance about their role in the progress of their children and how they can be a part of the progress of their child. This effort earned very good results.
- In our school, Music Therapy, Speech Therapy and Occupational Therapy departments are also functioning. These departments were made more equipped, meaningful and useful with the efforts of Hon. Secretary (EDU) Shri D. J. Dhandhukiya, our Principal Shri Meghjikhan Saybani and Ms. Nehalben Gadhvi.

2. Medical Camp



On behalf of Bhavnagar Municipal corporation on 19th March 2021 school health checking and fitness camp was arranged. 4 Doctors of Government Hospital viz. Sir T. Hospital, offered their services. Total 76 children were examined medically and 12 children were found affected adversely. These 12 children were issued reference cards.

To make this camp successful, under the able guidance of our Principal Shri Meghjibhai, teacher Shri Parasbhai Parmar and his team worked enthusiastically.

One of our students stydying in std. 4 Mr. Dhruv Satishbhai Chavda was suffering from spinal cord related disease & he needed to get surgery on emergency basis. The cost was around 1.50 to 1.75 lacks which was too much for his family to bear. We have asked for help & there were few volunteer trusts who have shown their interest. These were Vallabh Youth Organization & Nisbat Foundation & also helped was done by PNR trust's trustees, members & employees & thanks to their help that major surgery was successfully done at health care foundation-Ahmedabad on 9/6/2021

V.Y.O. trust has helped of Rs. 73,500/- and thank to managing trustee Mr. Anantray K. Shah (Bababhai) who requested Dr. Bhagat Sahaeb who perform surgery, has waived his changes of surgery due to this team spirit & extra efforts that child has successfully recovered from his major spinal disorder making his like smooth.



7. Various Projects



For the overall development of students, following projects are running in the institute:

Project for Auto Rickshaw (Transportation) help:

In our Institute, Mentally challenged children are trained/educated free of charge. Most of these children comes from poor and slum areas of the city which are far away from the institute. As these children are from poor families, they can't afford transportation expense for attending school. To help such students we are running this project as a part of door step service in the name of "RIKSHAW SAHAY" so that their transportation also made free of charge.

Project for Adoption of student (DATTAK FUND PROJECT):

All Mentally challenged children are trained/educated in our institute without any fees. However, other needs of child for his development in all aspects are to be fulfilled such as Medical assistant, Educational instruments, Uniform, Transportation to and fro school, special instruments for other coexisting disability, sports instruments, cultural program etc various matter need financial help. To help the child for his undisturbed progress in all vox of life we have developed this project. Donor can adopt a child by donating Rs.100000/- (one Lakh). One child's needs will be fulfilled from the interest income of this corpus. At the end of educational year, progress report of adopted child will be sent to the donor.

NAISHA V. SHAH STAFF WELFARE CORPUS FUND:

This Project is maintained from the interest income from the Donated amount by Donor Shri Pradipbhai A. Shah Interest Income is utilized for the Medical aid up to 3000/- and educational aid up to 2000/- for the trust set up staff. Under the project, for the year 2020-2021; total 19 employees were paid for Medical aid of Rs. 54982/- and Educational aid of 20765/- as per rules of the fund.

Over and above this, looking to the pandemic situation of Corona, 18 Employees of Trust set up were covered by Corona Kavach Policy at the cost of Rs. 18379/- we sincerely thank and express our feeling of Gratitude for the donation of Rs. 200000/- (Two Lakhs) during the year from the Donor of this corpus fund.

NATIONAL TRUST IS SPONSERING VARIOUS PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF MENTALLY CHALLANGED CHILDREN. FOLLOWING ARE PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED BY OUR INSTITUTE

AASHAY DAY CARE CENTER

This project is sponsored by National Trust New Delhi. Under this project, during the year 30 children were trained and educated; especially for the vocational skill. During the year this children were trained by on line as well as by their home visit by the teachers. National Trust is giving Educational Kit for the students of the Project. All parents were trained to use various instrument and other belongings of the kit so that they can guide their children for the smooth use of the Kit on day to day basis.

The entire coordination of this project is done by Shri Ridhhiben Mehta and Shri Mayurbhai Rathod under the guidance of Shri Meghjikhan Saybani.

NIRAMAYA (Health Insurance Policy)

This Health insurance is like Mediclaim policy. Disabled person is covered for Rs. 100000 (one Lakh) for the operation, Therapy, Hospitalization and Outdoor Treatment too and that too ignoring past illness and age of the assured. This scheme is a blessings for parents. Premium amount for this policy is paid by state Government. So practically it is free of cost and all parents should cover their disabled children under this policy. For policies booked by our institute, social Defense Department of Gujarat Government has Reimbursed Rs. 55650/- premium amount. During the year 2020-2021 we have booked 6 new policies and 293 policies were renewed through us. Thus total 299 policies were booked, which includes our students as well as other beneficiaries also. Entire administrative and online work for this purpose is managed by our computer operator Shri Mayurbhai Rathod.

Under this policy, during the year 2020-2021 claims of Rs. 163352/- were submitted and an amount of Rs. 113852/- was admitted and paid to the beneficiaries. Process of submitting claim and related matters are very well managed by our teacher shri Parasbhai Parmar.

For the District level local committee of National Trust, our Trusty Shri Vinodrai N. Hakani is member and for the District Level Implementation Committee our Hon. Secretaries Shri Alpeshbhai K. Sheth and shri D. J. Dhandhukiya are active and contributing at their best.

KIT DISTRIBUTION BY N.I.M.H.

Kit No. 3 & Kit No. 4 was received from "Vikas Day Care" NGO working under National Trust. These kits were distributed on Dt. 24/6/2021 which was attended by managing trustee Shri Anantray K. In the morning session, online lectures on various study subject of their syllabus are arranged and in the afternoon session they are exposed to practical lesson, I.P. and training to deal with special children. All the training are imparted online.
- We congratulate entire team Headed by Dr. Bhavikaben for exceptional achievement by securing 96% result for the batch of year 2019-20.
- New 25 students for the batch of year 2020-2022, have visited P.N.R. Society and affiliated institutes like K.L. school for deaf and dumb, Natraj C.P. Center, Blind School. They have also visited Daxina murti adhypan mandir (college for teachers of Normal children) and Bal Mandir (Pre primary education)


