ASHIRVAD DAY CARE CENTRE

160 children from cross disabilities get different services at this centre. Children also participate in cultural programmes and excursions. Some children with disability are admitted to regular schools and study with non disabled children. Children get services of assessment, medical checkup, enabled to get an Individual Education Plan, medicines, physiotherapy and training in communication using touch, sign language. This year due to the Covid pandemic, children were given training and other services through the virtual medium and through video calling. 131 children got ration kits and kitchen kits through different donors.

All these services are provided totally free.



UPASANA REHABILITATION CENTRE, SURENDRANAGAR

89 children from cross disabilities get intervention and training here. Children get services of assessment, medical checkup, enabled to get an Individual Education Plan, medicines, physiotherapy and training in communication using touch, sign language.

This year due to the Covid pandemic, children were given training and other services through the virtual medium and through video calling. Children got ration kits and kitchen kits through different donors.

Children also participate in cultural programmes through online platform.



KSHMATA CENTRE FOR CHILDREN WITH MULTIPLE DISABILITIES, LIMBDI

85 children with multiple disabilities get intervention services, health and physiotherapy through qualified personnel and 20 adults learn vocational training.

This year due to the Covid pandemic, children were given training and other services through the virtual medium and through video calling. Children got ration kits and kitchen kits through different donors.



SENSE INDIA PROJECT FOR PERSONS WITH DEAFBLINDNESS

A Community Based Rehabilitation Project (CBR) Project is being implemented in Surendranagar and Porbandar districts with the assistance of Sense India and Blind People's Association. 52 persons with deafblindness are provided needed training in daily living skills, communication and livelihood. This year due to the Covid pandemic, children were given training and other services through the virtual medium and through video calling. Children got ration kits and kitchen kits through different donors. Like Sense India, Perkins India, Shri Raj SaubhagSatsangMandal and Blind People's Association distributed dry ration kits to all the deafblind persons.



PHYSIOTHERAPY SERVICES

345 persons with cerebral palsy, multiple disabilities other Persons get physiotherapeutic services in the centres at Ashirwad, Sayla; Upasana, Surendranagar and Kshmata, Limbdi. The therapy consists of electric, electronic and manual methods.

During Covid parents were taught to do follow up at home through video calling.



SELF-RELIANCE OF WOMEN

The Self-Help Group of 17 women of Ovengadh village was given a machine to make sanitary napkins by Utkarsh Foundation, Ahmedabad. This group will make 25000 sanitary pads every year and will become self-reliant in this manner. This is the first such experiment with disabled women in rural settings.



INCLUSIVE COMMUNITY BASED LIVELIHOOD PROJECT

The Trust also implements community based rehabilitation under the Heart Foundation & Research Institute and Blind People's Association funded Inclusive Community Based livelihood Programme coordinated by the Blind People's Association under which Surendranagar and Morbi district have been covered. 101 villages have been surveyed and a total of 2170 have been identified. They have been given training in Income Generation Activities and 210 persons have been economically rehabilitated. 14 PwDs have been helped to become economically self-sufficient. There are 14 self-help groups of women. 160 members are doing saving. Disabled farmers have been given training in organic farming to reduce the use of harmful pesticides and increase crop quality.



CBR PROJECT

ATD works for the Community Based Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities in all Talukas of Surendranagar District. 1101 PwDs have been given livelihood related training and also government entitlements. There are 20 Self-Help Groups in the districts with 237 disabled members and who have savings of total Rs. 7,03,500.



THE NATIONAL TRUST SUPPORTED “DISHA”-CUM-“VIKAAS” DAY CARE CENTRE, SURENDRANAGAR

The National Trust for Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has started the “Disha Cum Vikaas Center ” Scheme for enhancing Daylyliving and interpersonal and vocational skills of these persons. Upasna Viklang Center Training Centre for Disabled (AVT) has been sanctioned the “Disha Cum Vikaas” Scheme under which 5C.P Children and 30 Mental Retardation Children Total 35 persons are taking day care training. Due to the pandemic, the children could not visit the centre physically but were given virtual training and guidance. 220 audio calls, 181 video calls, 35 home visits,116 visits to centre, ration kits to children, school bags and lunch box to 35 children. 20 children were given free smart phones for their studies.

NATIONAL TRUST “NIRAMAYA”

455 children belonging to the disabilities of the National Trust for Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment have been enrolled in the Niramaya Health Insurance under which a child can get upto Rs. 1 lakh for health services from the National Trust.



MENTAL HEALTH PROJECT

A CBR Project is being implemented in Vadhwani and Chotila Talukas with the assistance of Mental Health Cell, Government of Gujarat and Blind People's Association in which 2031 persons with mental illness have been surveyed. 533 patients have been met at home during the Covid pandemic, 360 persons have been communicated with regularly by video calls and 1110 have been given regular medicines. 110 awareness programmes on mental health were conducted.

Mentally ill persons on regular medication are able to pursue their vocations.

Women are enrolled into Self Help Groups and 22 Persons are able to earn a living.



NATIONAL MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMME

The District N.C.D.Cell, Shri Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Hospital, Surendranagar collaborated with ATD for organizing 10 awareness programmes on mental health in different schools, government departments and industrial units. Stress management and suicide prevention training was held at 91 locations for Anganwadi workers and PHC and CHC staff. A total 108 diagnostic camps were held for persons with mental illness during the year.


