(1) Special Teaching and Training for Children and Parents

Children with Intellectual disability, Cerebral palsy, Autism and Multiple disabilities were given online training and home based training as per the Guidelines of National Trust for Special



Education, Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy, Pre-vocational and vocational training, parent counseling and welfare schemes of the government were given and benefits of schemes were provided when needed such as UDID, ST bus free travel, INDPS pension scheme, Niramaya health insurance scheme etc.

(2) Cash and Rashan Kit Distribution
