ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20

BRIEF HISTORY AND OBJECTIVES

Devashrayam Charitable Society was started on 17th of July 1996 by a group of young people who resolved to help the helpless in a small way.

Annadanam

From its humble beginning of providing food packets to a limited number of needy patients at the Palakkad District Hospital, we now (from 1996 onwards) provide freshly cooked food for about 250 inmates every day of the year. This is done by donations of Rs.1750/- per day by donors on birthdays, wedding anniversaries, death anniversaries etc.

Free medicines

Devashrayam's second project inaugurated on 1st May 1997, envisages in supplying free medicines to poor patients. On presentation of doctor's prescriptions medicines will be purchased to the poor patients from a medical shop. More than 55 poor patients are benefited by this scheme every month. Devashrayam has tie up and the bill will be settled every month. We donate about Rupees 20,000/- worth of medicines every month.

Ayurbandhu

On August 2009, the Ayur Bandhu project was inaugurated by Shri A.K.Balan, Minister for Electricity Under this project we provide free dialysis to poor renal of palakkad, in Shanthi Medical Information center at Thankam Hospital of Palakkad. Now we provide 60 dialyses free of cost to the about 15 poor renal patients.

Ashrayam

Devashrayam Rehabilitation centre for the mentally handicapped On 2nd October 1998 Devashrayam started a day care and rehabilitation centre for the mentally challenged children mostly from poor families of Palakkad. In the beginning there were only 5 students. At present we have 55 students. We have also been conducting programs to eradicate the social stigma attached to mental illness and to organize associations of affected family's area wise to help each other.

Training In our rehabilitation centre we give training in Academic, personal, Functional academics, ADL, Self help, social, Community orientation, prevocational and vocational. Centre also provide to students Physiotherapy, occupational therapy, Music and dance therapy. There are separate classes for computer, music, drawing and craft on regular basis. General medical, Phychiatric and physiological camps are also conducted on regular basis for our students

Vocational and Shelter workshops

We have vocational and shelter workshops in Khadi Spinning Unit and we give training in Agarbathi, Phenyl, Liquid Soap, Detergent, Dish Wash, paper Bag, candle manufacturing and a mushroom unit. We have also a wire processing job work unit for BPL Ltd. Palakkad.. At present we have engaged 12 employees on monthly salary basis.

The timing of the centre is from 10 Am to 4 PM. We also own two buses, which we use for the conveyance of the students from their home to school and back.

Under this activity the students who under go training in our vocational units and sheltered workshops are gradually placed in out side job along with normal workers to make them personally and financially independent

.Prevocational skills along with real work experience is provided to the students in the selected job site and also at school This will help the students to get the experience at the real work environment. Then they are gradually transferred to the job to be normal employees of the outside units.

We now have many employers who have agreed to take in our students. Already 4 students have been placed in outside work and this project is running successfully.

Awareness program

We are regularly conduct sensitization Programmes to eradicate the common people on how to care for the mentally retarded and the ill. Work shops to parents to deal with children problems and classes to handle the children are also conducted regularly.

We mourn their loss and pay our respects to Mr C Ramachandran and MrsSaramma George who were dearly loved for their involvement and participation in all the activities of the organisation. Their contributions towards this organization are valuable beyond words.We also lost MrsPankajam wife of our member Mr Mohandas. Though not a member she would take care to ensure children's well beingwhile also keeping an eye on the centre activities. She succumbed to illness and we lost a motherly figure among our midst.

Ongoing projects of Devashrayam.

The projects undertaken by Devashrayam were the same as last year and can be classified under 4 sections:

- **Annadhanam** - Providing free midday meal to the poor patients at Govt. District Hospital, Palakkad
- **Ashrayam** - Vocational rehabilitation of special needs Students
- **Ayurbandhu** - Financial Aid for dialysis to poor patients with renal failure
- **Free Medical Aid** - Medicine and financial assistance to poor patients.

ANNADHANAM

Devashrayam was established with the intent of providing a free mid-day meal to the poor patients at Govt. District Hospital, Palakkad. This was the 1st project of our Society and very soon support from individuals started reaching us. What started as a small beginning (ie meals to 100 patients a day in the 1st year) has assumed fairly large proportions and now more than **300 patients** receive their mid-day meal through us. This service continues uninterruptedly on all the 365 days for the past 22 years and approximately **100,000 patients** benefit every year. This number is increasing every year. In spite of the soaring prices of essential commodities, the residents in and around Palakkad town as well as the Round Table of India - 81, contribute the major chunk of rice needed for this project. We thank all the donors & well wishers who have donated in cash and kind to make this project run without interruption. The total cost incurred towards this project was Rs 1527731/- More than 500 kgs per month of rice valued approximately Rs. 200000/p.a. and food materials were donated by well wishers.

ASHRAYAM

Devashrayam provides a safe refuge and a healthy learning environment to the mentally challenged who otherwise have nowhere to turn to. The vocational rehabilitation Centre was started under the guidance of Dr. T. Murali "The Rehabilitation Man of India", a person who has dedicated his life for the upliftment of the Mentally ill and the retarded.

In 2019, 55 developmentally challenged students attended the rehabilitation center. They participate in regular morning exercises, classroom sessions, art, craft and music lessons designed as per their capabilities. Apart from that, a few of them are involved in our ongoing projects of making phenyl, liquid soap, agarbathi, candles and paper bags. The Mushroom production unit set up with the assistance of Free Masons of Lodge Palghat - 159 generates a small income every year.

Our Khadi Unit set up by the Khadi Village Industries Board in 2002 functions very efficiently under the supervision of our trained staff Mrs. Sheena.

The sale of phenyl, liquid soap, Agarbathi and other items produced by students fetched a good income, just as in the previous years.

Total rehabilitation expenses for the year were Rs 3425071/-

AYURBHANDHU

Our tie up with Shanthi Medical and Information centre at Balaji Hospital, Palakkad completed another successful year. Poor patients with kidney malfunction/failure are able to carry on with their lives with the free dialyses support from this project. This year brought the total number of free dialyses to more than 400 from inception. In addition we have been sponsoring medicines upto 1000/- per month for around 40 patients with kidney malfunction for the last few years. We also support patients for peritoneal dialysis at the District Hospital. Our expenses towards dialysis and medicines were to the tune of Rs 684817/- this year.

AROgya NIDHI

This is another significant project of Devashrayam. This project operates through an authorized medical shop in Palakkad. Around 90 poor patients are given medicines free of cost on a monthly basis on producing prescription from doctors. This year the quantum of medical aid was Rs. 401605/- We are humbled to be of service to the ill and suffering multitudes. Much more needs to be done, however, as the number of people who need financial help are many and we are not able to meet the entire requirement. Medical insurance to the tune of upto Rupees One & half lakh was provided to all the staff, by paying an insurance premium of Rs 77743/-.
