The activities involve economic independence of women through awareness and linkage with livelihood schemes, capacity building through skill development and awareness of their rights, developing consciousness towards health and hygiene, facilitating group formations, and their participation in social activities and decision making.

The Covid-19 pandemic caused unexpected concern and distress. The hands that regularly sent remittances back home had to then depend on the meager food basket of the house. Back home there are also no work opportunities for the migrant workers. It is in this circumstance. Roshni continued to function from the field offices using masks, hand washing and maintaining social distancing, and maintaining utmost safety by providing 4, 800 Dry ration kits, 3000 face masks and needed things to vulnerable families, namely, migrant workers, disable families, senior citizens, auto and taxi drivers, and our beneficiaries.

The year was full of excitement, enthusiasm, and togetherness yet challenging and definitely with shared understanding...I take this opportunity to thank each of my colleagues for their dedication and commitment in building "Just and humane society with sustainable development". I look forward to the same passion to continue in coming days in achieving our mission.



## ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021

## \* Covid-19 Relief works by Roshni:

Dry ration kits were distributed to 2,543 families of migrants, nomads, disabled, widows and very poor. One thousand masks were distributed to the education department in order to help the children of SSLC to write their exams with safety measures. Two thousand masks were distributed to the MGNREGA workers and other individuals of HangalTaluk. Corona warriors



namely hospital staff, police officers and Tahsildar office staff were honored by donating a meal. Twenty each sanitizerwas distributed to the hospital and police station.





**\*** Construction labors facility training is given to 36 Lokmanch leaders.



\* 173 Labour cards for construction works are distributed.





 Health Campaign programme is organized at Shyadaguppi, 38 members participated



- \* Awareness programme is held for the disabled children's parents,
  51 parents have gained knowledge from it.
- Women's day celebration was organized at Roshni Campus,24 women participated in it.

\* 75 members have participated in Water Conservation Awareness programme



- \* Open house programme: 135 have participated
- \* Lake festival programme held in different places 254 people have participated in it.
- \* Deaf and dumb children and parents training programme was conducted 65 parents and 53 children have participated and gained knowledge and trained themselves.
- **\* Childline Dosti Week Programme:**

Month of November is known for Children's day celebration. Given importance to the feelings, needs and relationships to build the better society by the children. Special Children and their parents given awareness programme. Some of the activities and games are conducted. 219 Children have participated in it.





- \* 364 children have attended in the ChildLine awareness programme
- \* Holiday Camp: Holiday camp for the children conducted in few of the villages and response was good from the children. There were 235 children who participated in the holiday camp and gained knowledge.





\* Birth of Savithri Bi Pule was organized in Aladakatte village, SHG women, unorganized youth, VDC members and children all together 40 participated in the programme, women empowerment, importance of girls education, her stepping stone to success, which motivated her to become a first teacher these where the topics which inspired them in the life of Pule.



\* Formation of Human Rights commission meeting was held in Roshni premises, lawyers, ex CDPO, college lecturers, Ex BEO and other like minded NGO's members were part of the meeting, it was discussed on human rights related issues, with all the guidelines from the officials we have planned to write a application to DC to form Talukeleve human rights commission.

Training on leadership was organized for unorganized youth in Kondoji, Aladakatte, Dolleshwara, KanchinegaluruGotagodi, and Gunduru. 35 young girls and 214 young boys participated in the training and got the skills to be the leader.





\* Collaboration with Rotary Charitable hospital, SirsiEye camp was organized inRoshni, 698 people were treatedand 252 were successfully operated and they have regained the eyesight.



\* Lokmanch leaders had a day's outing to Murdeshwar and Edgunji there we had arranged a training on LokManch sustainability, 43 LM leaders were part of the outing, Leaders were very happy.





\* Free health camp on Nuero, Kidney, and Heart problem was organized for all the villagers 268 of the patients benefitted from this camp and 25 people were referred for surgery and it was successful.



\* Rangoli competition was arranged for unorganized youth 80 girls were part of the competition; winners were awarded with the prizes.





\* Jyothi tailoring unit was inaugurated in Aregoppa village, 25 girls are regular for the classes





\* Janavedic leaders, Village Development committee members, unorganized youth and staff participated in the district level farmers protest.

- \* Childline awareness was created in market places, bus stands and pairs ( Jathras). Pamphets were distributed; Incase of any child Mariiage or any abuses on children they are asked to call 1098 Helpline number. 822 people became aware of Child Line.





- \* AshaKiran children's federation meeting was held in Roshni, 18 children were present and discussed about children's gramasabha, children protection committee, school dropout survey, use of mobile and and its effects.
- \* Open house programme was held in Havangischool ,Panchayat members of school teachers and children were present for the programme, children put forth their problems and needs of the school, Panchayat members promised that they will provide the facilities to the school.

- \* Child Marriage Prohibition Act training was organized in Upunsivillage, 140 were participated in the training, they have become aware of the act, they have understood the importance of protecting the children from Child Marriage.
- \* World Deaf day was celebrated in InamYallapura village, speech and hearing disable children and their parents were present, parents became aware of the importance of education, different opportunities that are available to disable children.







\* Vacation camp was organized for disable children in AkkiAlur and Lakkikoppa, 58 children and their parents participated in the camp, they were given some imputes on corona virus, sign language, action songs, drawing competitions and sports was arranged, children were actively involved in exhibiting their talents and positive attitude was seen in their parents.



- \* Disable children's parents training was held in Roshni. 65 parents were part of the training, reasons for disable children's birth, physical exercises and different methods of therapy were explained to them.
- \* World Disabled Day and Birthday of Ms. Riya Lobo one of the donor was celebrated in the presence of disable children, on the occasion of b'day, they distributed gift to all the disable children, all were happy and understood the importance of the day.





\* Distribution of study material for sponsorship children, 20 children were given the material, single parents, poor children and orphan children are the 4 days holiday camp was organized in Ajagundikoppa Learning centre students 58 children participated and learnt on brain jim, cleanliness, clay model, mathematics, personality development, and different activities were conducted, all the children were happy and competitive spirit was seen in the children.





\* Community Meetings were held in Ajagundikoppa and Gundur, people of the village became aware of corona virus and precautions, discussed about giving quality education to the children in the learning centres, parents and people were very supportive in sending their children to learning centres.
