## Annual Report-2020-2021

### Activities during the year

Due to Corona-Pendamic lockdown was declared throughout the country from 22<sup>nd</sup> of March 2020. Though our school & vocational training centre started on 15<sup>th</sup> June, there were no children in the classes. Only staff members were present.

As per government guidelines our teachers discussed in detail regarding the online education of our students. They prepare a education programme and discussed the same with the parents and handover this programme to them in groupwise parents meetings.

School foundation day

On 16<sup>th</sup> June, Chetana Vikas Mandir, our special school for the intellectually disabled children completed its 34 years and entered into 35<sup>th</sup> year. On the occasion of foundation day Dr. Sharadchandra Diwan & Mandar Joshi visited the school and donated some grocery and medicines for needy children. Similarly Mrs. Nandini Patodia gave grocery kits for 30 students while Megha Limaye and Madhuri Khebudkar donated necessary medicines.

Helen Keller day

On 26<sup>th</sup> June Ra. Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj birth anniversary and Helen Keller birth anniversary were celebrated in the school in the presence of staff members and president Mr. Naresh Bagare and with other board members.

Disability week celebrations. Every year from 3<sup>rd</sup> Dec. (Global handicapped day) to 8<sup>th</sup> Dec. (Global Intellectual Disability day) we celebrate this special week by organizing different activities.

3 rd Dec.

- On the occasion of World Disabled Day our teachers paid visits to the students home and gave them bouquet.

8 th Dec.

- On the occasion of World Intellectually Disabled Day we organize online fancy dress competition for the students of our special school and Best from Waste competition for our vocational training centre. Mrs. Arati Bhedigiri, Mr. Prakash Patil, Mr. Prasad Sutar and Mr. Shailendra Kamble were present as examiners.

On 15<sup>th</sup> December Mr. Sameer Bhoj, Dep. Commissioner of Pune Municiple Corporation visited school and vocational training centre.

Republic day

On 26<sup>th</sup> Jan. 72<sup>nd</sup> Republic Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm. M.L.A. Chandrakant Dada Patil was present as chief guest. He hoisted the flag and prizes were distributed at his hands to the winners from the fancy dress competition and best from waste competition.

On 9<sup>th</sup> March a sanitizer machine was donated by Rotary Club of Midtown, Kolhapur. Mrs. Utkarsha Patil, Mrs. Ankita Shah and Mr. Amar Deshpande were present on the occasion.

In the month of March a 20 seater school bus, 20 dining tables and 100 chairs were donated by MCKS Trust, Bangalore. While a bakery oven with mixer and a solar dryer were donated by Yoga Vidya Pranik Healing Foundation. We are very thankful to the board members of both the trusts for this geneous donation.

#### CHETANA VOCATIONAL TRAINING AND PRODUCTION CENTRE

In the year 1991 we started a vocational training centre for the children above 18. At present there are 100 children in vocational training centre. Training is provided in following different trades.

- 1. <u>File making and book binding</u>- Here all types of files such as office files, lace files, port folios, spring files, box files are manufactured. Also children are receiving training in making registers, making book binding etc. There are 13 boys and 1 girls working in this unit.
- 2. <u>Carpentry unit</u>- Here we manufacture different educational aids for primary schools and montessories. Children also prepare different presentation articles such as pen stand, wall hangings, trophies, bird nests etc. At present 13 boys are working in this unit.
- 3. <u>Screen Printing and painting</u>- The files that we manufacture are get printed in this unit. Similarly we receive orders for making visiting cards, invitations, letter heads etc. The products that are prepared in carpentry unit are get painted in this department. There are 12 boys working in this unit at present.
- 4. <u>Paper mache unit</u>- For last 5 years we are running this unit where we prepare different presentation articles from paper mache. We also prepare ganesh idols from paper mache. We are receiving a huge response from the people for these idols during Ganesh festival, as these are eco friendly. At present there are 13 boys working in this unit.
- 5. <u>Chetana bazar and home science</u>- We are running this workshop mainly for the girls. Here we purchase grocery and provision material in wholesale rates. Girls clean it, weigh it and make packing also. Parents are the permanent customers of this Bazar. The girls also receive training in sewing, making purses, masks, dye and tie, embroidery etc. There are 24 girls working in this unit.

6. <u>Wooden oil making Machine</u>- Last year Mahindra & Mahindra donated a wooden oil making ghana in the month April 2019 while another ghana for making coconut and sesame oil was donated by D. Y. Patil Group. At present there are 14 childern working in this unit and regularly we manufacture groundnut and coconut oil. Both the products receiving a nice response from the society a large.

In the month of April our teachers prepared annual progress reports of the students on the basis of their individual performances during the year. The progress reports of these students were submitted online to the parents.
