INSTITUTE FOR RURAL DEVELOPEMNT AND SOCIAL SERVICES, JALGAON ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24



Our Institute for Rural Development and Social Services Jalgaon is entering its 37th year and we are presenting the annual report of the institute for the year 2023-24. Institute for Rural Development and Social Services Jalgaon run Utkarsh Mentally Retarded Vidyalaya Jalgaon, Vikas Tannariketan Jalgaon, Protected Workshop for Adult Mentally Retarded Children Jalgaon, Gurukulam Global School Jalgaon are running.

In this special school Utkarsh Intellectual Disability Vidyalaya Jalgaon, 40 subsidized + 35 permanent non-subsidized + 9 additional students have been admitted in the reporting year. While admitting the students, according to the category of the student, the admission is given after examination through the government medical college / general hospital and after obtaining the disability certificate. Those who do not have a certificate will be guided through the Principal / Special Teacher in that regard and get the certificate, then according to their IQ, they will be admitted to the age group (self-reliance, primary, school, pre-vocational). Disha curriculum is being implemented under the association of them. According to it, in the year 2022-23, Disha has been honored as a school implementing the direction. According to the policy of the government, the institution is providing the facilities of education, uniforms, educational tools, sports and entertainment materials etc. free of cost with the help of government grants and donors. The purpose and effort of the organization is to make the students who are frustrated, helpless and dependent due to natural disabilities self-reliant and independent.

Necessary educational material for the school, furniture, abundant and clean water supply, water cooler, filter water tank, electricity supply, solar system. sports equipment, color television set, fridge, computer, laptop, tablechair, projector, CCTV, inverter, physiotherapy, Speech therapy, exercise, etc. The materials have been made available with the help of donors.

In the year 2023-24, in class 10, 5 students have filled the 17 number form and given the exam and achieved success as follows.

First Rank -Mohit Hemraj Badgujar Pratik Subhash Patil 83.40 percent

Second rank - Niramay Sanjay Runwal 82.40 percent Third rank - Ayush Randhir Mhaskar 80.20 percent Fourth rank - Jayesh Pravin Patil 78.40 percent

Protected Workshop for Adults Intellectual Disability Children Jalgaon In this special workshop, sewing, weaving, panati dyeing, Police inspector office postal file preparation, as well as various types of file preparation, Rakhya-Ganpati necklace making, Uttan-Masala packing, etc. were started in this special workshop for the rehabilitation of adults. And still intend to start some handicrafts.

In the previous year, the organization has constructed a spacious twostoried building for a sheltered workshop for adults with mental retardation, and the organization intends to provide handloom training through Khadi industry. 1500000/- has been spent and the construction is still incomplete. 3-4 lakhs is required for the rest of the construction.

In the last year, the organization has registered as a Khadi organization and for that, the organization has purchased 1 loom and 10 spinning wheels. Accordingly, the employees of the organization have received yarn spinning training at Gandhi Research Foundation, Jalgaon, and training is being given to the trainees in the workshop., Handloom has been started to keep busy. Baskar and Satranji are made in it.

During the reporting year, dignitaries such as Dr. Vishakha Ganveer, Mr. Chandan Ranglani, Mr. Shantaram Patil etc. visited their relatives and friends on the occasion of their birthdays and commemorations. Paresh Sawant, a student of the school, Chamgaon, comes from Dharangaon, his family members organized a trip for the school student to his village Sweet food was served to the students. Thank you all for that.

During the reporting year, festivals and celebrations such as Divyang Day, Rakshabandhan, Independence Day, Ganeshotsav, Republic Day and birth anniversary-punyatithi of various great men were celebrated in schools and workshops. Also, prizes are given to the students by holding district level sports

competitions on the occasion of World Disabled Day. Prizes are given to the students selected from the district level competitions by participating in the state level competition. Parents, citizens of the school premises, members of the organization respond enthusiastically to the cultural program.

During the reporting year Regional Deputy Social Welfare Department Nashik Division Nashik Mr. Madhav Wagh, Mr. Vijay Raising Saheb District Social Welfare Officer Zilla Parishad Jalgaon, Mr. Bharat Chaudhary Vaisaka Social Welfare Department Jalgaon District, Mr. Shri. Dr. Vijay Gholap Medical Officer Jalgaon City Mahanagara Palika Jalgaon, Swarangan Sangeet Group Mumbai etc. dignitaries visited the institute and school and expressed their satisfaction.

During the reporting year Mrs. Dipali Sesha Rao Pawar 11000/-, Dr. Ajinkya Maheshwari 11000/-, Mr. Pradeep Baviskar 10000/-, Mr. Shivaji Bhaulal Patil 15000/-, Mr. Suhas Ramchandra Rokade 20000/-, Mr. Lalit Hari Patil 100000/-, also donations have been received from the Chairman, Board of Directors of the organization.

Also, sweaters were distributed by parents Mr. Niyajoddin Tadvi, Mr. Indranil More along with Director Government ITI. On behalf of the organization, I thank everyone for that.

During the reporting year, the institution is registered under the National Trust Act 1999 and 45 students have been covered by health insurance during this year. Also, the employee of the institution Mr. Sanjay Borse is a member of the district level committee under the National Trust Act 1999 and 39 disabled, multi-disabled, celebratory palsy, self-absorbed beneficiaries. Home visits are made for providing parentage certificate.

During the reporting year, Kaviyitri Bahinabai Choudhary Uttar Maharashtra University, Jalgaon Department of Social Work and Dhanaji Nana Chaudhary Vidya Prabodhini-run College of Social Work, BSW, MSW students and professors visited the school. The trainees and professors of the Nursing Training Center at the hospital visited and studied about the work of the organization.

During the reporting year various gun darshan cultural programs were celebrated with the board of directors and parents as in Salabad by hoisting the flag by Shri.Dodhu Tukaram Sawant, ex-serviceman on the occasion of Republic Day.

Vikas Tantra Niketan, Jalgaon

Since the academic year 1993, higher secondary business courses have been started in the institute and it includes three business courses. The said business courses are affiliated to the Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Examinations.

1) Construction Technology:-

The course deals with the skilled manpower requirements in the construction sector. This course covers all the subjects related to construction sector. Subjects are taught through Marathi. After studying in the said course and passing class 11th and 12th, employment and self-employment opportunities are available to the students through government and private channels.

Students who have passed this course are helped to earn money through self-skills especially in the fields of government contractor, site supervisor, plumber, painter, mason, centering craftsman etc.

In the academic year 2023-24, 10 students of class 11 and 16 students of class 12 are admitted. 5 out of 8 students passed the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted in March 2024. Out of these 1 student is serving in private management, 2 students are self employed and 2 students are pursuing higher education.

2) Marketing and Retail Management:-

The course deals with the skilled manpower requirements in the commerce and trade business sector. This course covers all subjects related to commerce and trade sector. Subjects are taught through Marathi. After studying in the said course and passing class 11th and 12th, employment and self-employment opportunities are available to the students through government and private channels.

The students who pass this course have employment opportunities especially in the field of Bank Representative, Marketing Representative, Sales Representative, Insurance Representative (Salesman) etc. due to self-skilling.

In the academic year 2023-24, 10th year of class 11 and 13th year of class 12th are admitted. 8 out of 12 students passed the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted in March 2024. Out of these 3 students are serving in private business management, 2 students are self-employed and 3 students are pursuing higher education.

3) Child, Old Age and Health Care:-

The course deals with skilled manpower needs in childcare, aging, and health sectors. Mainly the enrollment of girls in this course is high. This course includes all subjects related to child care, old age and health sector. Subjects are taught through Marathi. After passing 11th and 12th standard after studying in the said course, the students get employment and self-employment opportunities in the government and private health sector.

Students who have passed this course have employment opportunities in childcare centers, nursing homes, nursing homes, private hospitals, anganwadis and nutrition etc. due to their self-skills.

In the academic year 2023-24, 5 students were enrolled in class 11 and 11 students in class 12. 05 out of 08 students passed the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination conducted in March 2024. Out of these 1 student is serving in private health management, 2 students are self employed and 2 students are pursuing higher education.

As all the above three business courses are practical based, the students benefited from various visits related to the course, on-the-job training from time to time.

Gurukulam Global School, Jalgaon has classes up to 5th standard and 392 students are studying in this school.

Educational materials, furniture, abundant and clean water supply, water cooler, filter water tank, electricity supply, sports equipment, color television set, computer room, laptop, table-chair, projector, CCTV, inverter etc. Materials have been made available.

During the reporting year, the school celebrated Rakshabandhan, Independence Day, Ganeshotsav, Republic Day and various great people's birthdays - Punyatithi, Ashadhi Ekadashi, Diwali, Christmas, Janmashtami, Guru Poornima, etc. Also, sports competition, painting competition, story-telling competition, poetry competition, Hindi Day, Show and Tell, Ad Mad

competition, handwriting, science exhibition etc. competitions were conducted. Good Touch - Bad Touch, Vegetable Day, Foot Day, Shape Parade, Annual Reunion, Non-Fire Cooking etc. Various activities were implemented. Mrs. Nalini Patil for science exhibition and Mrs. for Good Touch - Bad Touch activity. Neha Agarwal was present.

During the year under report, an industrial field visit was conducted at Parle G Factory, Jalgaon to enhance the medical attitude of the students. Also the children of the playgroup were taken to the kids zone.

<u>Participation in Survey Work For Annual Status Of Education Report</u> (ASER). -

Our Institute had conducted this activity in Jalgaon District with Pratham Foundation a well known national level organization to aseess status of primary education in country.

Our trained volunteer teachers Mr.Rahul Patil were coordinate and master trainers of the training course. We trained 31 Surveyors (MSW Student For Kaviyitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University Social Work Dept.Jalgoan) for conducting the educational survey. Institute successfully conducted the survey for 120 villages 15 Talukas in Jalgaon District.

Also, the all department teaching and non-teaching staff have planted and conserved various trees in the school premises during the reporting year. For this, the officers and members of the executive board always get guidance and support.

During the reporting year, the office bearers, directors, members, parents and persons, organizations, who helped from time to time, got support and guidance for the institution and the school from time to time.

I thank all the people who visited, guided and donated generously to the organization and supported in different areas of training to the staff and students also the organization who has given us opportunity to get an offer on job training in their organizations it was impossible without help of such a generous society and I assure you that we can deliver better in the coming year.
