Background:

The District Disability Rehabilitation Center (DDRC) scheme is implemented at the district level through the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Central Government, Government of India, New Delhi. The work of coordinating this scheme is done by the state government. There are 325 DDRCs operational across the country and 17 DDRCs in Maharashtra. For this, a registered organization working in the field of disability is an eligible organization to implement the scheme. A separate registration certificate is issued for the District Disabled Rehabilitation Center through the Office of the Disabled Welfare. Commissioner, A District Management Committee (DMT) is formed at the government level to implement the scheme successfully. In DMT Hon, The Collector is the chairman, the district level heads of all departments, DDRC scheme implementers, registered organizations working in the field of disability and District Disability Rehabilitation Officer (DDRO) act as members.

Introductory:

Since last 20 years Kagal Taluks Art Sports Educational and Cultural Board Kagal District - Kagal Dist.

Kolhapur operated Self Ganpatrao Gatade Intellectually Disabled Residential Non-Residential School, Kagal
is implementing various activities in the field of disability.

(1) Special Education; (2) Medical Examination Camp and Treatment,
(3) Surgical Examination Camp and Surgery, (4) Physiotherapy, (5)
Occupational Therapy, (6) Reading Therapy and Hearing Therapy. (Speech and Audiology), (7) Parental Counseling, (8) IQ testing, (9) Getting free health insurance, helping with claims, (10) Getting Legal Guardianship (11) Training of parents, special teachers and village servants, (12) Vocational training and skill development of disabled persons, (14) Running of day-care centers,

Kagal Taluka Art Sports Educational and Cultural Board Kagal was appointed as the implementation agent for District Divyang Rehabilitation Center Kolhapur in 2023 considering the role of providing service and justice to disabled people. Our organization accepted the responsibility of working with the government system and giving direction in the field of disability. A local management committee has been formed under our organization to ensure that the disabled get services smoothly and all government, semi-government and private schemes can be implemented in a proper manner as well as the direct beneficiaries benefit from it. This committee is composed of Chairman, Executive and Members. Project Hon. The President acts as the chairman of this committee. Weekly and steering committee meetings review detailed service work and plan for further planning.

Objectives of District Disability Rehabilitation Centre:

The central government has prepared the plan of the District Disability Rehabilitation Center for the following purposes:- Early Intervention and Treatment, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech and Audiology., Counseling & IQ Testing, Orthosis & Prosthesis, Medical, Surgical Examination and organizing camps, organizing camps for getting assistive devices and those disabled Achieving Individuals (ALIMCO), promoting the creation of a barrier-free environment by implementing Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan,

Routine Activities: Getting healthy health insurance, assistance and follow-up in claiming.

Legal Guardianship, Universal (UDID) Card, Awareness Programme,

Contacting and informing them about various schemes and making efforts to avail them, survey

The objectives are to conduct survey, skill development and vocational training, employment generation, implementation of seed capital scheme, help in natural calamities etc.

Routine and Occasional Activities is briefly presented as follows:

1. therapy

Physical therapy (Physiotherapy), Occupational therapy (Speech and Audiology), Testing of hearing ability through audiometer, Counseling & IQ Testing, Orthosis & Prosthesis These services are provided regularly. Specialist therapists in the above disciplines serve at the center.

If the disabled person belongs to economically weaker section then the transport and service charges are free. The rationale behind this is that care is taken at the center that no disabled person is left behind as there is no charge.

2. UDID card:

Unique Disability Identity Card (UDID) for Persons with Disabilities is a universal card project to create a national database for PWDs and issue a unique disability identity card to each person with disabilities, approach is being implemented. The project will not only promote transparency, efficiency and ease of delivery of government benefits to persons with disabilities, but also uniformity. This card will help in tracking the physical and financial progress of the beneficiaries at all levels. Dist. d. Pu. For the successful implementation of the UDID card in the center, the disabled are contacted and made aware, the documents required for the card are taken, scanned and uploaded on the provided website and the receipt is given to the disabled. The receipt is given to the disabled by uploading it on the website https://www.swavlambancard.gov.in. The application is trucked on the website and its status is informed to the beneficiaries, also the difficulties encountered in implementing the scheme are raised in the meeting of DMT-and-remedial measures are planned. This form is filled in DDRC free of charge and for filling this form in private place usually Rs. A fee of Rs. 200-300/-is charged.

3.. Niramay Arogya Yojana:

National Trust, Department of Empowerment of Disabled Persons, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi runs Niramaya health insurance scheme for mentally challenged persons. The nature of this scheme is that claims can be made for medical, surgical, therapy, dental, outpatient check-up, blood test, medicine, transport. Sensade Project being a registered organization of National Trust is expanding the implementation of this scheme through District Disability Rehabilitation Centre. In order to get the maximum benefit of this scheme to the disabled people, the project uses the reserved 5% government fund for the premium disabled people. It is followed up by DDRC. Sensdha is the leading organization implementing Niramay Yojana in Maharashtra. Out of 2,700 Niramay cards, 700 Niramay cards have been drawn by Senstha Project. Free service of Niramaya card application, payment of premium, card arrival check, notification of arrival card to beneficiary, removal of copy and softcopy of same to mobile and assistance to beneficiary to make claim and follow up till settlement, clearing errors District Divyang Rehabilitation It is given through the center. Training on Niramay Card is provided to the organizations registered under National Trust through Sensita Project SNAC (State Nodal Agency Center) and DDRC.

4. Legal guardianship:

National Trust, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi has a legal guardians hip scheme for persons with intellectual disabilities. Under that scheme, District Disability Rehabilitation Centre, Kolhapur, from the interested parents, copies of original documents and application forms are filled in the prescribed format. Institution representatives, police officers, representatives of social welfare department visit the home of the applicant who has been given preliminary approval. In this, the information of the applicant and the disabled is taken. After submission of home visit report approval is done through institution login on online portal. After that application Hon. Goes to the login of Collector. A certificate is generated from their login. Certificate with Report Hon. It is uploaded with the signature of Collector, Institutional Representative and District Social Welfare Officer. Legal guardianship services of Kolhapur districts are provided through the project.

5. Parent Training Workshop:

Training workshops are organized 2 times a year for parents of disabled children from economically weaker sections of rural areas. Training mainly physical, occupational therapy therapy

They are also given medical examination and treatment, parents are counselled. Disabled children. Q is drawn, information about government schemes is given. Efforts are made to take advantage of it. Niramay and UDID card is removed. All these services, therapy and training are free to them.

6. Competitive Examination Guidance:

Students from economically weaker sections of rural and urban areas, mainly cerebral palsy, deaf, blind, physically challenged students have reservation for various government posts, but due to economic weakness, they cannot get admission in teaching classes. Therefore, as they do not get proper guidance, disabled students are deprived of government jobs. Considering this, d. Pu. Free competitive exam guidance is provided by expert trainers and various government officials through the centre. In the future, the project intends to start's competitive examination guidance center and study center for the differently abled.

- 7. Contact parents to follow up on therapy and plans.
- 8. Registering disabled persons and preparing their updated list.
- Independent ration card should be given to the disabled and follow up to get the benefit admissible on the ration card accordingly.
- 10. 5% of the fund reserved for the disabled to try to spend this fund for various welfare schemes of the disabled.
- Pursuing provision of 5% Gharkul under Gharkul Yojana to the disabled belonging to Scheduled Castes and Yribes category.
- 12. Nogotoring unemployed pursons with disabilities, providing information to persons with disabilities objecting employment and soil employment apportunities.
- 13. Efforts are being made to provide loans from banks to the disabled under various schemes.
- 14. Helping to create self-help groups of the disabled.
- 15. Pursue to organize medical camp for disabled at least twice a year.

- 16. People with intellectual disabilities have a higher incidence of epilepsy and their monthly cost of medication is usually Rs. 2000-2500/- becomes. Hence follow up to get medicines from district surgery and other donors.
- 17. To create awareness about cochlear implant, to take measures for it.
- 18. Planning for corneal blindness surgery.
- Pursuing that every school, college, government building, public premises should be barrier
 free for disabled persons.
- 20. Pursue to organize awareness camp for district officers, employees, gram sevaks, anganwadi supervisors, ASHA workers etc.
- 21. To create awareness about the disabled in the society by creating awareness towards them, raising their problems, calling for solutions, making efforts to accommodate the disabled according to the inclusive principle and providing them with the benefits of various schemes, providing them with employment, so that they can live a self-reliant life.
