- To undertake different human resource development programs so that the trained and efficient human resources will judiciously and scientifically control, use, manage, own and utilize the existing natural resources in long run.

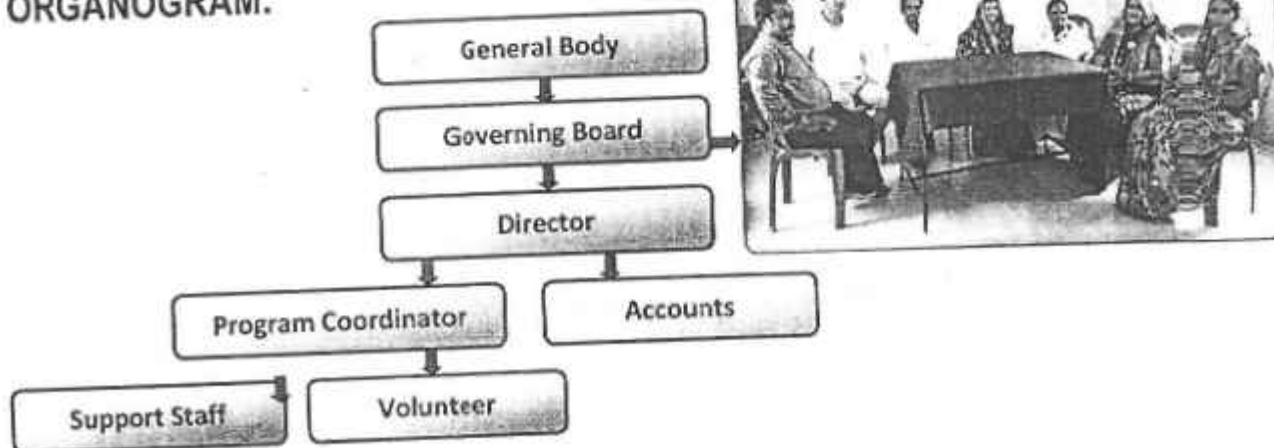
INFRASTRUCTURE

DETAILS OF PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTED

EDUCATION PROGRAMME

1. SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR CHILD LABOUR:

PRIA is running Special School on Child Labour at Nehengera under Bega G.P in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal Dist. We enrolled child labour and provide New Dress, Education, Nutrition food, Vocational Training, Counselling, Awareness to stop Child Labour.

2. SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR DEAF & DUMB:

PRIA has run Special School on Deaf & Dumb at Laulai in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal Dist. We enrolled 30 deaf & dumb child and provide Special Education, Nutrition food, Counselling to parents and Practice of Behavioural change.

3. SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY:

PRIA has run Special School for Intellectual Disable 30 Child in between Age group 6 yr to 18 yrs and another one is Pre-school for 50 CP and Intellectual Disable Child between age group 3 yr to 6yrs child at Laulai in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal District for providing Special Education, Dress, Nutrition food Counselling to parents and Practice of Behavioural change freely under Deen Dayal Rehabilitation Service Scheme and SSEPD Dept, Govt of Odisha.

4. RURAL LIBRARY PROGRAMME:

PRIA has run & disseminate Rural Library for disable person section and general public section for new readers at Laulai office for learning facilities and building behavior, Language promotion & Character. Another is at Laulai a Yoga Library is run There are approximately 315 nos. of books available with support of PSSCIVE, Bhopal. Infrastructure Developed for Disable. PRIA has run public General Library at Laulai PRIA office with reading room facility. We receive 1860 Books from Odisha Sahitya Academy with support of RRRLF. Till date 692 readers take library books and periodicals for learning We open a Book Bank and learning material for poor student.

HEALTH PROGRAMME

1. CLEAN INDIA & GREEN INDIA PROGRAMME :

During last 15 years, PRIA is associated with various Govt. programs of RWSS under District Collector and it has made the program successful motivating the village rural mass on use practice of household Toilet and Swachha Bharat Yojana. Work Camp at Laulai Village by 30 Youth Girls on Clean India and Green India and Fit India Programme sponsored by NYKS, Dhenkanal.



2.HEALTH CARE SERVICE FOR SENIOR CITIZEN:

PRIA has conducted a Free Health Check up Camp at Laulai Senior Citizen Home, Laulai in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal District on occasion of Observation of World Older's Day on 1.10.2022. 230 elders treated and distributed free medicine, check-up Sugar & Blood pressure by Dr. Krushna Chandra Roy. Dr. Nibedita Nayak Physiotherapist, Bijayalaxmi Roul, Sarapanch Laulai GP, Rubi Priyadarshini ANM cooperate in this programme.

3.WORKSHOP ON DISASTER MANAGEMENT:

PRIA has organized a Workshop on DISASTER MANAGEMENT at Pingua Degree College Campus especially for College students Dr. Krushna Ballabha Satpathy, Dhenkanal and Lecture Diptiranjana Mahalik discussed on the topic DISASTER MANAGEMENT why it spreads how it is prevented naturally 84 participants motivated by this program to Preparedness.

4.CAMPAIGN ON PC & PNDT ACT :

PRIA has organized a Mass Rally on Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Abhijan in Nehengera Village and also a campaign meeting AWC premises among SHG leaders, AWW, Asha, Adolescent Girls and social activist. Unicef Programme Coordinator Angoor Mishra and Urmila Deuri CDPO Gondia Block attended this programme as Guest.

5.CAMPAIGN ON COVID-19:

PRIA has distributed Handwash, Sanitizer, Mask, Towel and Dry Food to 75 CP and MR child in Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Service Centre, Laulai in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal District with mobilize and practice for Social distancing and use mask and clean hands. As per direction of District Administration and Dist Legal Service Authority, Dhenkanal distribute Bega, Laulai, Khankira, Lethaka, Ratanpur and Nihalprasad GP of Gondia Block for monitoring Quarantine centre and mass bathing in village pond and social counseling to General Public.

AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

1.LEGAL AWARENESS CAMP ON WOMEN LABOUR:

PRIA has organized Awareness Program on Rights and Duties and Equal Wage of Women labour sponsored by Rastriya Shramik Sikhya Bikash Board, Bhubaneswar 42 Nos. of Camp Was at Laulai, Bega, Nehengera, Gothatala, Ramei, Ghoraghor, Lethaka, Ria, Basudebpur, Kotagara, Saptasajya, Gajamara, Nuagaon, Mahulpal, Digamberpur, Panchakendu, Badapokharia, Karadabani in Dhenkanal District and Kolha, Tasunimalia, Purnachandrapur, Champapur, Samia, Dehurigarh, Rajihar, Sambarpalu, Kantigadia, Turang, Ameyajhari, Kanteijhar, Salapadaa villages in Jajpur District organised. 1680 Women labour were attend in the Camp on their rights, and duties and workplace facilities. 2. CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAMME:

An Awareness Camp on Consumer Rights through wall painting and write Slogans at 20 important places for publicity was arranged by PRIA in Gondia Block in Dhenkanal and Badachana Block of Jajpur dist. We distributed 2500 leaflets for generating awareness to General Public. A Mass rally has arranged in GP High School, Bega on National Consumer Right's Day on 24th December 2022

3. CAMPAIGN ON BIO-DIVERSITY CONSERVATION:

PRIA has organized awareness camp at Champapur, Kolha, Dehurygarh, Abhayapur villages on Climate Change and Bio-diversity conservation, Preservation of existing forest, Developing new village forests, better rural sanitation and healthy social atmosphere through Padayatra, Rally, Student meet, Seed Bank and public meeting on indigenous forest species.

4. WILDLIFE CONSERVATION CAMPAIGN:

PRIA has conducted Awareness Campaign wildlife conservation at in Sarangi and Kapilash Sanctuary belt in Postering, wall painting and Rally on Monkey conservation, feeding, planting eating food tree for Elephants.

LIVELIHOODS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

1. MILLET MISSION: Millet is an essential grain in people's daily life with its highly nutritious than age old cereals. It is difficult for us to get high quality millet just by hand. Here comes the requirement for developing right automatic and mechanical millet processing unit at Buhalipal Banambari SHG promoted by PRIA in Hindol Block. for all the millets that are processed and consumed to meet different millets processing such as proso millet, foxtail millet, little millet, barnyard millet, kodo millet, pearl millet, finger millet, brown top millet and jowar. PRIA has adopted millet processing technology covers the full range of millet pre-cleaning, hulling, polishing, optical sorting to bagging

2. SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME:

- PRIA has conducted 6 Month Skill Development Training Programme on Garment Making at Laulai with support of JSS, Dhenkanal and one appliqué Making Training at PRIA Training Hall Laulai for 30 Adolescent girls from Laulai, Bega, Khankira and Baidyakateni villages supported by Nehru Yuva Kendra, Dhenkanal.

3. FOOD PROCESSING TRAINING CENTRE:

PRIA has established a Food Processing Training – Cum – Production Centre on Jam, Jelly, Pickle, Sauce for Development of rural entrepreneurship and transfer of technology for processing of Food products by utilizing locally grown raw-materials and self-employment of 30 Adolescent Girls. We adopt a new technology Cherry making from green papaya and marketing in Factory. We empower to rural women



to take socio-economic programme on mushroom cultivation programme use raw materials with our training and guide.

4. BAMBOO CRAFT TRAINING:

PRIA has conducted Bamboo Artisan Craft Training for 2 SHG women in 15 nos at Khankira and 15 nos at Gundurapasi under Gondia Block in Dhenkanal District for 30 days. Sudhansusekhar Mohanty Ex-Range Officer Odisha Bamboo Development Agency attended this function for better skill development and marketing advice. Pratima Senapati and Bhagirathi Das Master Trainer give new design training for marketable product like pen stand, flower hanging, light stand, Tray, Brush stand, tool in bamboo. We promote 3 SHG in self employment. OBDA supported Agarbati Stick making machines for Agarbati Making at CSC Laulai for 3 SHG will self-employed.

5. BAMBOO PLANT CULTIVATION:

PRIA has conducted 3 Farmers Training at Khankira, Batoo, Champapur village on Bamboo Plantation. And promotion. PRIA has promoted 25 Bamboo cultivators Planted Bamboo plants 40 hectares in their own waste land with support of DFO, Dhenkanal.

SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAMME

1. REHABILITATION & THERAPEUTICAL SERVICE TO INTELLECTUAL DISABLE

PRIA has run Rehabilitation & Physiotherapy services at Laulai, Dhenkanal with support of SSEPD Dept, Govt of Odisha is provided to the indoor, outdoor patients and to disabled Child attending outreach service camps. The teaching, training, feeding, clothing and Rehabilitation programme research were also carried out along with the services to the patients. Intensive care training was imparted for 75 parents of the disables. We give therapeutical service to 43 CP and 32 MR children in centre based and door step service. We have 2 Physiotherapy Centre for Senior citizen one is at Laulai, Dhenkanal District for 75 and another is at Darpana garh under Jajpur. PRIA has take Health insurance under NIRAMAYA scheme under National Trust for 220 CP, MR and Autism disable child. PRIA Director Tankadhar Barik is Local Level Committee Member of National Trust and given 5 Legal Guardianship to MR person.

2. RUNNING MENTALLY ILL WOMEN SELTER HOME:

PRIA has run one Mentally illness Women shelter Home at Laulai under Gondia Block of Dhenkanal District for Providing free Nutrition, health, Lodging and recreation facilities

3. BEGAR REHABILITATION HOME:

PRIA has run to mainstreaming the destitute women / beggars in Dhenkanal district of Odisha. There will be 50 destitute women and beggars mainstreamed in the project. The organization has already identified and selected the potential beneficiaries at



community level in different regions of Dhenkanal, The basic objective behind introducing the project in Dhenkanal Odisha is to provide community based rehabilitation and sustenance of the identified women and beggars so that they will lead normal life and dignity like those of others.

5. MALHARA REHABILITATION CENTRE: Since 2019-20, out of the community support and local contribution PRIA took the initiative for mainstreaming the Malhara ST Community in Dhenkanal district. The movement for rehabilitation the Malhara ST Community started Rehabilitation Centre at Totapada, Bania and Jammunalia Villages in Gondia Block of Dhenkanal District, where District Legal Service Authorities and District Administration, Dhenkanal and PRIA incepted.

6. DISTRIBUTION OF AIDS AND APPLIANCES TO PWD PERSONS: PRIA has distributed Aids and Appliances 55 PWD persons on World Disable Day like Wheel chair, Electric battery Tricycle, Tricycle, Brelly, Support Sticks, KFO Shoes, Roteller by Support of Gail India, Alimco and District Administration. DSSO Dhenkanal Suvendu Khuntia, Adl Tahasildar Gita Behera Distributed these on Support of Naba Bharat Ventures Ltd support on CSR fund 30 CP bed distributed CP child by S. J. Saroj Kumar Sethy Collector, Dhenkanal and DSSO, Dhenkanal Suvendu Khuntia.

GOOD GOVERNANCE

Since December 2007, the Organization PRIA has involved in MGNREGS and RTI programme on Social Audit, activate Palli Sabha & Gram Sabha for Enhancing Accountability & Good Governance in Gondia Block and Dhenkanal Sadar Block of Dhenkanal District. PRIA is a member in Public Hearing committee and master Trainer of OLM, Mo Upakari Bagicha give training to CRPs. and MGNREGS Dhenkanal Sadar Block and also Badachana Block of Jajpur District. PRIA has activate Special Palli Sabha on Gramasabha Sasaktikaran Yojan of State Govt. and GPDP Plan. PRIA has supported Block level RTI Convention with partners and Suchana Adhikar Mancha. We provide legal Aid service to rural poor women, child, disable, SC/ST and minority with support of Dist Legal Service Authority, Dhenkanal

Jogendra Behera and District President Er Babuchand Mahalik attended the function Ghodanacha and Distributed Prizes to winners and awarded to Sarapanch, PS Members and ZP member to belongs to Kaibarta Caste.

We envolved 450 farmer's family in Biju Krushak Kalyan Yojana. PRIA has take up and motivated 228 beneficiaries of 200 Hectors Paddy cultivated on line transpanting. We have organized seed Treatment Campaign and Farmers Training, Food processing on Mandia Product at Baidyakateni, Karadabani, Gothatala and Buhalipal in Hindol Block of Dhenkanal District. We constructed Tanka Bandha over kuanrianala for supply of water to cultivated 200 hectors of land.
