Mainly it has concentrated on different action oriented programmes and spends lots of time in generating awareness among the people. The major areas of its activities are.....

### "PRAYAS"

#### A Special School for Mentally Retarded & Cerebral palsy Children



Sadbhabana is running an institutional based rehabilitation center for children with mentally retarded named PRAYAS at Naranapur, Keonjhar since 2008. The main purpose is to make them independent and a self reliant citizen of the country and it also takes the key role in their lives to make them stand on their own feet. This is the only institution of its kind in the district. 65 mentally retarded children are residing in its campus. 6nos of special teachers and 8 nos of caregivers always engaged for the overall development of these children. Regular health checks up and different therapies like Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy and occupational Therapy provided to the childrens. Marshal Art, yoga and song teacher engaged for the recreational activities of the children. Besides education we provide the children different activities of daily living skills, life skills, co-curricular. To create sporting sprits in their minds, every year annual sport is conducted by the school. During summer vacation our special teachers visit the homes of the children and counsel the parents and train them how to take special care of the children and how to practice activities of daily living skills under home based disability management programme. A parents counseling center runs inside the school campus regularly for better result. Vocational products like phenyl, candles and agarbatti made by our children are exhibited every year at Palishree Mela at Bali yatra Cuttack and also at Kendhujhar Mahochhaba, Kali padia, Keonjhar. This year on the occasion of International day for the disabled our students participating in the district level competitions became the champion and received Shield in the hands of the Hon'ble Collector, Asish Thakre The children and staffs too observe different national and international days and also enjoy social festivals.

## **THERAPEUTIC & REHABILITATION CENTRE**

With the support of SSEPD Govt. of Odisha we are running a Therapeutic and Rehabilitation unit



at Naranpur, Keonjhar 50 nos of Intellectual

Disable reside in this centre. We are providing them different therapy and vocational training to our inmates for the rehabilitation and mainstreaming them. Through this project beneficiaries those who are not doing their ADL activities properly coordination problem, weakness, spasticity or deformity, speech problem. After getting different Physical exercise, massage, heat and cold treatment, gait training and MST, Speech therapy etc in their unit now a days they are able to perform

their day to day activity. Apart from this, they develop their personal, academic and social skill area, occupational and recreational activity. After getting vocational training the beneficiaries are able to prepare phenyl, Agarbati and candles. It helps them to prove as earning members of the family. Over all, mental, physical, social, vocational and economic usefulness is the impact of the

whole programme.

## **CARE AND PROTECTION FOR SPASTIC CHILDREN**



We are running a centre Named Care and Protection of Spastic children with the support of SSEPD Department, Govt. of Odisha. There are 15 Nos of Spasticity children reside in this centre. In this centre we provide Physical exercise, massage, heat and cold treatment, gait training and MST,



Speech therapy etc in our unit now a days they are able to perform their day to day activity. Apart from this we also Creating Awareness Programme for disable Parents, Disable Parents Training to Mainstreaming of a child/ persons with Disability for their social inclusion, gainful Opportunity in a marginalized community and to become a contributor of society.

### **GHARAUNDA (A shelter home for PWDs and CWSNs)**

We running Gharaunda centre (A shelter home for PWDs and CWSNs) at Raisuan, Keonjhar since 2017 with the support of NATIONAL TRUST, New Delhi. In this centre we provide physiotherapy, educational, Speech therapy, vocational Training. Apart from this also we are working their livelihood and how they turned in a earned person in their family.



### **World Cerebral Palsy Day**



In 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 the World Cerebral Palsy day was observed by all the staffs & inmates of Sadbhabana with different dignitaries of Keonjhar District.

In the morning the inmates of Sadbhabana & staffs are visited to the doorsteps of different dignitaries offices like office of the District Collector, PD DRDA, DSSO, DPC, DEO & BEO office etc.. for creating awareness through ribbon campaigning. On that day ribbons are tied by our inmates do District Collector, PD DRDA, DSSO, DPC, DEO & BEO office etc.. Then our staffs explain the

importance of that day to the eminent dignitaries. In the afternoon all the inmates & staffs of

sadbhabana are celebrated that day by cutting cake at Prayas campus. Then the importance of that day was narrated by our staffs in front of our inmates. Lastly in the evening cultural activities are performed by our inmates. The World Cerebral Palsy Day was observed by us with great pleasure & fun. Children feel the importance of that day & enjoyed a lot.

### **Physiotherapy Seva Kendra for Senior Citizens**

A free Physiotherapy Seva Kendra was opened by Sadbhabana on 15 August 2019 at Naranpur, Keonjhar for the Senior Citizens having Back pain, Knee pin, Shoulder pain, Ankle pain, Foot pain, Spondilises, Wrist pain, Osteoarthritis etc. In that day we organized a physiotherapy camp at our centre to diagnosis, counselling & treatment of the most valuable group of the society, where more than 70 nos of senior citizens were presented. From that day we had continuing that seva Kendra for the benefits of those elderly people. Now there are 28 nos Senior Citizens are continuing their physiotherapy treatment in our seva Kendra.



### **NRM & Community Forest Rights Programme**



We are organized two awareness programmes on dated 29/01/2020 at Jhumpura Block consists of 55 participants & the another programme which was held on 30/01/2020 consists of 50 participants from different community stakeholders. In this programme the Resource person Mr. B.B. Mahanty said what is FRA Act, 2006 & amendment of FRA Act, 2012. This workshop was focussed on the Rights of Banavasis & Adivasis on Forest.

### **WATER ACTION MONTH (Claim your Rights)**





With the joint effort of Sadbhabana, Fansa Odisha and End Water poverty we organised a District level workshop on “Wash Rights Of Adivasis” at Naranapur , Prayas Campus, Keonjhar on dated 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020. 55 nos of Different community Members different streams i.e from Nss Volunteers, village youth club members, SHG leaders, NYK volunteers, NYP Volunteers, Social Activists, Journalists/Media persons, Govt. Officials are present in this programme.

Sanitation related Customs and practices, Sanitation and rights to habits, Management of sources of water for sanitation; rules of menstrual hygiene are the topics which are discussed in the workshop,

A Sensitization workshop on disable management, CBR context for PRI members, Anganwadi workers, Parents of PWDS, Community Volunteers, etc. was organized by Sadbhabana on dated 16<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at Khendra Panchayat campus, Jhumpura block of Keonjhar district. This programme was inaugurated by the Sarapanch of Khendra block Mr. Darshan Munda

and Panchayat Executive officer Mr. Subhadarshini Kar. The Physiotherapist of our organisation Dr. Sradhanjali Paikaray, our special educator Mr. Mahendra Kumar Sahoo, HR Mr. Dipti Prakash Maharana and CBR co-ordinator Mr. Prasanta Kumar Khuntia were present there. Both the Divyanga Sathi Mrs. Seema Mahanta and Mrs. Rebati Sethy, Anganwadi workers, Ward member were also present there. What is disability, Types and causes of disabilities? What is Physiotherapy? Why Physiotherapy is needed and How Physiotherapy will helpful for PWDS and for all types of Pains and Paralysis patients was discussed by our Physiotherapist. Our HR Mr. Dipti Prakash Maharana was discussed about the rights of PWDS and Govt. Schemes for PWDS. In this meeting total 65nos of people are present. The programme was ended after the vote of thanks by the chair.

### **CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL NATUROPATHY WEEK**



To create the awareness among general public, community and student mass we organized different activities on the occasion of International Naturopathy week a 7days programme which was organized with the joint effort of **SADBHABANA, INO & Surya Foundation** in different schools and community of Keonjhar district of Odisha from 12<sup>th</sup> November 2019 to 18<sup>th</sup> November 2019. We

conducted programmes like Awareness Rally, Rang Bharo, Debate, KBSR Competitions,

Signature Campaign, Door to door Campaign and Community Awareness Programme on Naturopathy etc. In 14 Numbers of school of Keonjhar district. Total numbers of participants in Rang bharo Pratiyogita are 348, in KBSR 32 and in Debate 150.

During school based activities we directly sensitize 530 children & indirectly we reached more than 4500 students through our 530 Naturopathy Ambassadors. And we planned through these kids we achieve more than 1 lakhs community people during our course of intervention. During community based programme like rally & door to door awareness campaign around 5000 community people of different villages in our working areas were aware about yoga & Naturopathy. How yoga plays an important role for the human life for maintain a healthy life and Naturopathy kills the side effects. Naturopathy is Drugless Therapy without medicine treatment, Mental **and physical wellness. It also Eco** friendly therapy which has no side effects.

### **PHYSIOTHERAPY AWARENESS & TREATMENT CAMP**



A Physiotherapy awareness and treatment camp organised by Sadbhabana, Naranpur, Keonjhar with the joint collaboration of “Urbi Ladies Club” on the occasion of world Physiotherapy day on dated 8<sup>th</sup> September 2019. This programme was inaugurated by Mrs. Leelabati Panda, Secretary Urbi Ladies Club. The main aim of this camp is to create awareness and

treatment of the affected persons. Total 50nos of persons (including ladies, gents, one girl child and senior citizens) are present there in the awareness programme. The secretary of our organisation Mr. Chandi Prasad Pattanaik delivered welcome speech. Our Physiotherapist Dr. Sradhanjali Paikaray discussed about what is physiotherapy? Why physiotherapy is needed and to whom physiotherapy is given. She also focuses on the major problems of women and also men. How physiotherapy is important in our day to day life? Without taking pain killers, injections and surgery how we keep ourselves fit to physiotherapy, was also discussed. Group exercise was taught by our physiotherapist madam for cervical spondylitis, frozen shoulder and many more. After this session we have organised a free physiotherapy treatment camp for the senior citizens those are suffering from neck pain, shoulder pain, tennis elbow, wrist pain, osteoarthritis,



rheumatoid arthritis, low back pain, knee pain and ankle pain etc. In this camp the king of Keonjhar district named Dhanurjaya Narayan Singhdeo and Queen Sunandini Sen Singhdeo were also present there.

### **PHYSIOTHERAPY ASSESSMENT AND COUNSELLING PROGRAMME**



Assessment and counseling Programme on Physiotherapy for PWDS was organized by our organisation Sadbhabana on dated 02 November 2019 at Khendra Panchayat campus, Jhumpura block of Keonjhar district. The Programme was inaugurated by the Sarapanch of Khendra Panchayat Mr. Darshan Munda. The Physiotherapist of our organisation Dr. Sradhanjali Paikaray, our special educators Mr. Mahendra Kumar Sahoo and Mrs. Sushri Sangita

Deo and CBR Co-ordinator Mr. Prasanta Kumar Khuntia were present there. Our community volunteers Mrs. Seema Mahanta and Mrs. Rebati Patra are also present there. Total 85nos of persons were come to this Assessment, and counseling programme, among them 64nos of persons were Assessed and Identified by our professionals of different conditions like Low Back Pain, CP, Cleft Palate, ID, Hearing and Speech problem, Knee Pain, Hemi Plegic (Paralysis Patient), Transgender, etc. Most of the cases are Low Back Pain, Hearing and Speech problem. Therapeutic treatment was given to the Patients of different categories as per their requirements and conditions.

### **T.O.T ON CFR UNDER FRA ACT-2006**



An one day workshop on training of Trainers on CFR under FRA 2006 was held on 09/06/2019 & 02/12/2019 at Rajiv Gandhi Seva Kendra, Jhumpura, Keonjhar & Sadbhabana meeting hall with the 35 no of participants of each programme.
