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
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Message from Chairman

Geographical presence:

Currently Vikash is working in the State of Odisha, Uttar Pradesh and Jharkhand and aspires to spread its interventions beyond these boundaries.

3.1. Inclusive development of Persons with Disabilities and equal opportunities

3.1.1. Community based Rehabilitation Programme (CBR):

Vikash has been implementing Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR) Programme for Children with Disabilities in Khordha, Puri, Koraput and Malkangiri Districts for the last 3 decades. The programme aims at empowering Persons with Disabilities within their own community and enhancing their capacities for equitable and inclusive development.



In this programme Vikash is rendering services like Early Intervention, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech & Language Therapy, Counseling, Special Education, Linkages with Govt. Schemes & Programmes, Supply of assistive devices Skill development, and support for livelihood activities. During the year 235 Children with Disabilities were extended intensive support. Besides 500 adults were provided extensive support. Apart from these Vikash is promoting Self Help Groups of Persons with Disabilities, Parent Association and Disabled People Organization (DPO) to organize them, build their Agency & capacities and raise their voices for their equal participation in inclusive development process in the community.

3.1.2. Center Based Rehabilitation Programme

Vikash has set up 3 residential Care Centers in Puri, Koraput and Malkangiri district to provide rehabilitation services to Children with Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities. The centres take up early identification; provide therapeutic services for their physical and social rehabilitation. Skilling Parent (Primary Caregiver) for rehabilitation activities of their children is taken up sincerely. The families are helped to access Government schemes for their social and economic security. The aim is to facilitate independent living of the disable children.

At the centers Vikash provides Special & Inclusive education, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech & language therapy, Counseling, Parents training, free lodging and free food. 65 Children with Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities are staying in these Centers. Special occasions like Children's day, International Day of Persons with Disabilities, Raksha Bandhan, Diwali, Ganesh Puja, Saraswati Puja, Independence day, Republic day, Women Day, Nutrition Week, Breastfeeding Week etc. were observed to encourage full participation of Children with Disabilities.

3.1.3. Rehabilitation of Beggars with Intellectual Disabilities

Although Article 21 of the Indian Constitution provides right to life but beggars are living without dignity and quality of life. Poverty or abandonment amongst persons with disabilities, senior citizens, and persons affected with leprosy, children without parental care, single women, persons with mental illness are forced to adhere begging. Beggars can become valuable human resources with proper care and nurturing. To cater to this urgent need Vikash campaigned for inclusion of beggars in the developmental processes. Vikash is managing a residential care cum rehabilitation Center called “Niladri Nilay” at Gop in Puri district for 50 Persons.

3.1.4. Inclusive education development

For last 10 years, Vikash is running an Inclusive Education Development Center at Ganeswarpur, Gop, Puri. During the year Vikash reached to 60 CwDs. The objective of the Center is to provide educational support to children with learning disabilities in an inclusive environment to prepare them to attend general school education system.



Vikash is providing services such as educational support, skill development, participation in educational process, learning by playing, inclusion with educational entitlements, joint session involving Parents and CwDs.

Outcome:

- 60 CwDs are attending regularly
- All the CwDs are included in Govt. benefits relating to education
- 30% CwDs are able to read
- 46% CwDs are able write Odia and English alphabets
- 53% are able to speak different words

3.1.5. Inclusion of Persons affected with Leprosy



Vikash initiated a campaign across the State of Odisha to organise Persons affected with Leprosy and formed their association, build built of their capacities to access Govt. schemes.

Outcome:

- 14 Agency of persons affected with leprosy formed
- Leadership skill developed of 60 Persons
- Aid & Appliances distributed among 347 Persons
- 20 Persons linked with Livelihood activities



3.1.6. Convergence with Govt. programmes

Vikash networked with various Government organisations like Health & Family Welfare Department, Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (SSEPD) Department, School & Mass Education Department, Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department, ST & SC Development Department, and Women & Child Development Department to facilitate convergence of various schemes for the benefit of the target group. As a result of the convergence, the followings were achieved;

- 250 Persons with mental illness got Psychiatric medicine under District Mental Health Programme
- 371 got assistive devices
- 60 Students with Disabilities benefitted under Banishree Scholarships Schemes
- 147 Persons with Disabilities benefitted under Pension schemes



3.1.7. Referral Services

Many Persons with Disabilities are there who need referral services for access to Psychiatric treatment & counseling, prosthetic & orthotic devices, corrective surgery etc.

3.1.8. Campaign

Vikash launched a campaign called “Ring the Bell Campaign” in 3 Blocks namely Delang & Pipili of Puri District and Jatani of Khordha district involving Children with & without disabilities and other key stakeholders. The objective of the campaign was to develop awareness in the community about the rights of access to education, educational institutions and curriculum by students with Disabilities.



Another campaign called “Grassroots Comic” was launched to raise the voices of Children with Disabilities to be heard by the Govt. One day training on grassroots comic was organized involving 25 children with disabilities.



3.1.9. Support to NGOs for inclusion of disability program

Vikash extended handholding support to SANSAD a NGO working in the State of Uttar Pradesh. This programme aims at building capacities of the concerned NGO, Persons with Disabilities, their Parents & Caregivers to facilitate equal participation and inclusive development. It helped formation of disable persons association for raising their voice 1000 Persons with Disabilities were reached directly during the year.

3.1.10. Building Disabled People Agency

Vikash has formed **Disabled People Organization (DPO), Parent Organization of People with Disabilities and Self Help Group (SHG) of Persons with Disabilities** in Puri, Khordha, Koraput and Malkangiri Districts. Vikash has conducted their capacity building training on group management, records keeping, financial management and leadership development to address their issues at their own as **Self Advocate**. The main objectives of building the Agency of PwDs is to make them independent and manage their own life,



which will enable them to get opportunity in the society and participate in the development process

3.2. Dignity

3.2.1. Shelter for Urban Homeless:



Vikash is managing 10 Shelters for Urban Homeless (SUH) in 6 districts of Odisha. 500 Homeless Persons are staying in these Shelters. Vikash is providing shelter, food, safe drinking water, sanitation facility safety kit from infectious disease like Nobel Corona Virus. Vikash helps them to access various Govt. schemes such as pension, Aid & appliances, opening of Bank Account, livelihood activities, inclusion with Aadhaar Card etc. Efforts are made to re-integrate targeted people with their families. Beneficiaries are well informed and trained to prevent them from COVID-19, Physical distancing and Govt. Livelihood activities like Thunga and paper bag making are promoted to help them in earning their livelihood. Leisure and recreational activities like watching Television, reading News Paper, gardening, water curing is done by the beneficiaries. Counseling and Psycho-social support provided by Vikash to all the Residents of SUHs to maintain and keep their sound mind & health. Yoga and physical exercises are done on a regular basis in the SUHs.

3.2.2. Senior Citizens Care and welfare

Vikash works for the cause of senior citizens to improve their quality of life in 5 districts of Odisha. Vikash advocates for universal coverage of pension, health care, social security, prevention of abuse, livelihood activities and right to live with family. Vikash has formed 10 groups of senior citizens in Malkangiri and Koraput districts of Odisha. One phone helpline has opened by Vikash to provide required support to the Senior Citizens.

3.3. Good habitat

3.3.1. Urban Sanitation Campaign

Vikash implemented a programme in Bhubaneswar City to create awareness among the School & Community People on sanitation, health and hygiene. It organised meetings, Audio Visual Show, chariot campaign street play etc. with school children it organised drawing, painting, Quiz, essay & debate competitions. It organised interactive events with Rickshwa Puller Association, Auto Rickshaw Association, Doctors Group. Advocate Association, Mahila Arogya Samiti, ASHA workers, Women from SHGs, Sahi Committee, Shanti Committee etc. Under this programme Vikash has reached 25 Schools and Communities in Bhubaneswar City .25 Sanitation Clubs were formed.



3.3.2. Rural Sanitation

Vikash has constructed 485 low cost toilets in the tribal district of Malkangiri with support of District Administration. This latrine has helped tribal people to reduce their expenses on family health budget which was earlier more due open defecation.

3.5. Good Governance

3.5.1. Training of Panchayat Functionaries

Vikash is a lead Organization in the State of Odisha for strengthening of rural & urban governance system for enabling the functionaries to discharge their duty more efficiently. Vikash conducted training programme on Gender and Grampanchayat Development Plan for 1050 elected representatives of Grampanchayats (Sarpanch, Panchayat Samiti members, Ward Members), Gram Rozgar Sevak, Gram Panchayat Officer, Anganwadi Worker (Pre-School Teacher), ASHA in Gop, Kakatpur and Astaranga block of Puri district with support from State Institute of Rural Development (SIRD).



3.6. Disaster Management

3.6.1. Preparation of Village Disaster Management Plan

Vikash has partnered with District Chapters of Odisha State Disaster Management Authority (OSDMA) for preparation of 406 Village Disaster Management Plans in 7 districts in a participatory way by involving community. The plan will help villagers to reduce vulnerability & casualty at the time of disaster. The table below gives information about the village covered

3.6.2. Rehabilitation and Restoration of livelihood of Cyclone FANI affected people

Vikash being a humanitarian Organisation immediately responded to cyclone FANI and reached at the door steps of affected people in Puri district. Vikash immediately provided dry food, shifted them to nearest shelter home, helped in re-construction of their damaged houses and extended support for restoring their livelihood.

3.6.3. Hurricane waste management

Vikash is a pioneer in waste management. It took a very special step for management of hurricane waste generated by the cyclonic storm FANI. The deposited waste in the out skirt of the state capital Bhubaneswar, were de-composted without causing any harm to environment. It saved water bodies from being polluted due to organic waste de-composition in fallow lands.
