BALAJI OLD-AGE HOME

Introduction

In the present time, the entire scenario of Joint Family Culture has changed into single nuclear family. Government as well as charitable institutions had considered about the old parents of such nuclear families who had been left without any support by their sons.

Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan who had been rendering welfare services for a very long time had set up a Home known as Balaji Old Age Home. The objective is to meet the specific needs and general care of the elderly. It is situated at Pratap Vihar on the land and the building leased by Nagar Nigam Ghaziabad for 30 years. The living environment of the elderly are their special nutritional needs, physical problems, psychological problems/disorders, care of the bed ridden and in specific serious conditions are being met very well. Community based voluntary social health services are also rendered. Yoga & Naturopathy have been introduced to check old age-degeneration.

Activities in 2019-20

The services rendered to elderly people residing in Old-Age Home have been very satisfactory. Their suggestions were given due importance and necessary remedial action was taken well in time.

A Health Camp in association with Lokpriya Hospital was organized in Balaji Old Age Home Campus. Every Elderly persons residing in Old-Age Home was medically examined thoroughly. In few cases mild medication was advice.

The vegetables are grown there with organic manure enriched with vitamins and minerals.

International Vridh Divas was organized on 1st Oct.2019. Sh.Shardanand Sharma, Dr.Ganesh Dutt Sharma, Dr. Bhudev Sharma, Sh.Sukhveer Singh & Sh.Harpal Tyagi gave their esteemed talks on this occasion. Shri Kusumakar Sukul Chairman of Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan felicitated five elderly persons.

BHAGIRATH SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED

Introduction

It is a known fact that Parents having differently abled children have to face greatest problems in bringing them up and also in their Schooling. Therefore a Special School was set up in year 1999 with the objective to augmenting the physical and mental abilities of children with disabilities. Presently 140 Challenged children from minority class and BPL families with different disability like mental retardation, multiple disability, Orthopedic Handicap (OH) and Hearing impaired (HI) are taking education in this special school.

We provide them free academic and vocational education, books, stationery, dress, Mid-day-Meal, transport, medical care including medicines, physiotherapy and Hearing and Speech therapy, aid and appliances.

The Special School is providing the vocational training to the disabled children in trades like chair weaving, Soft Toys, Rakhi and Candles making and decorating items.

Activities in 2019-20

The Special school has been operating in a rented building at Meerut Road, Ghaziabad wherein recently construction of a Hall and a Room has been accomplished, resulting in better utilization of around 1500 sq.ft.of land

An awareness program for parents and the society at large pertaining to Autism was conducted on April 2, 2019 on the occasion of World Autism Day. The theme of the program was Early Identification of Autistic Symptoms in Infants and young kids. Dr. Rajeev Garg MD, a renowned Pediatrician was invited to deliver the key note address.

Presently the centre is providing education to 140differently abled and mentally challenged children.

3rd December 2019 “World Disability Day” was organised where disabled students of our Special School along with students from other schools participated in miscellaneous games like rassakassi, nimbu race, 50 mtr race dance etc..

An inspection of our Special School was carried out on 4th Oct.2019 by Sh. Rajnish Kumar Pandey District Disability Officer, another round of visit was made on 16th October by Shri Anil Kumar Tyagi, Deputy Director, Viklang JanshaktikaranVibhag, Meerut.

On 28th Nov.2019 a program was organized in collaboration with YMCA Delhi in which Special school students are participated in various games like long jump, high jump, Soft ball through, shot pit, gochchi etc. On 3rd March 2020 students are participated in athlete festival organized by Special Olympics Bharat.

UDAAN DAY CARE CENTRE UNDER (VIKAS SCHEME OF NATIONAL TRUST FOR MENTALLY CHALLENGED CHILDREN)

Introduction

Udaan Day Care Centre has been established on 11th July 2016 under the VIKAS Scheme of National Trust. Presently it is being run & managed by site i.e. R-8/63 Ghaziabad. This Centre is meant for looking after the Disabled children (suffering from Mental Retardness & Multiple Disabilities), during day time. 17 PWD children are taking services in this centre.

The building of the Centre comprises of 4 class rooms, 1 physiotherapy room and 2 other rooms. In staff side there are 1 special educator, 1 physiotherapist, 1 Councilor, 1 Care Giver and Aaya. The Centre has been fully furnished with office furniture, furniture for the children, educational material and physiotherapy equipment and other gadgets etc.

Activities in 2019-20

- On Independence Day 15th August 2019 a program was organized. Sh.Kusumakar Sukul Honorary Chairman of the Sansthan hoisted the National Flag and sweets were distributed to the children.
- On 28th Nov.2019 students are participated in YMCA Athletics Games in Delhi.
- On Republic Day 26th January 2020 a cultural cum drawing competition program was arranged. A few different cultural items like Fancy Dress, Musical Dance were conducted by PWD's. All PWD's participated in drawing competition and First, Second, Third & consolation prizes were given to the winners.

NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF OPEN SCHOOLING FOR SENIOR AND SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

Introduction

We have been given accreditation by National Institute of Open Schooling under Ministry of Human Resource Development (HRD) Govt. of India for running Secondary and Senior Secondary study centre. It has now status of Nodal Centre as well as Study Centre.

BHAGIRATH PUBLIC SCHOOL

Introduction

Bhagirath Public School is recognized by Central Board of Secondary Education(C.B.S.E) up to senior secondary level. It got affiliation from C.B.S.E in year 2009 up to secondary level and gradually has been upgraded up to senior secondary level in year 2011.

School has full functional science laboratory with latest apparatus and equipment for the young one to explore their skill, the fully operated computer laboratory with 30 computers and net connection, to meet latest challenges. School is transferring education through DIGI class room teaching. School also has a well stored spacious library with 5000 books in it School not only takes care of academic but also help in developing the co-scholastic skill of the student by providing music, art and sports facilities.

To ensure discipline in punctuality and regularity of students, a smart card has been issued to every student of class Play to XII. Their attendance is monitored in school as well as in their homes by this card. The presence and time of arrival and departure of each student is automatically registered on reaching or leaving the study centre by the student.

ALMA KIDS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

Introduction

It caters preliminary education to students of class Pre Nursery, Nursery, KG Junior & KG Senior . The age groups to whom the education is imparted, are 1.8 to 2.5 years, 2.5 to 3.5 years, 3.5 to 4.5 years & 4.5 to 5.5 years respectively.

Alma International Play and Pre-School's Activities Zone has been prepared in such a way that it could develop much more physical activities among kids with full of entertainment.

Various Indoor games and Physical Activities are included for kids to enjoy the whole session with vibrant ambience. Individual and group activities such as dancing, drawing, Toy-playing, chess are conducted under the supervision of the teaching staff.

KAMKUS COLLEGE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION

Introduction

Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan is also running a special college, Kamkus College Of Special Education and Research

(KCSER). KCSER got the affiliation in 2018 from Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India. At KCSER, our objective is to develop special educators and trainers for children with Special Needs (CWSN). For this, we are currently running two courses viz. Diploma in Special Education in Intellectual Disorder (previously known as Mental Retardation) and Diploma in Special Education in Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Another diploma course in Hearing Impairment will soon be introduced. These are two year diploma courses with Intermediate (10+2) as minimum educational requirement. Anyone meeting this criterion can secure a job as special educator / trainer after completion of any of these diploma courses.

In our country current requirement of special educators in government schools alone, is about 15 lakhs, but we have only approx. 15000 special educators, which is just 1% of actual requirement. Hence, there is an ocean of opportunity which can be harnessed through our college. The students are also eligible for applying C.TET in second year of this course. At last we can say that, BSS is not only giving a track to be a doctor, an engineers, an officers but also a platform to serve the society to be a special educator and to empower Divyaangjan (children with special needs).

KAMKUS COLLEGE OF LAW

Introduction

The fast pace at which our nation is progressing has churned up a huge demand for professionals in various fields. And notably the demand has been exceptionally high in the field of law. There is a huge lacuna in the field of law especially in sunrise sectors of environmental law, legal aspect of global business management and partnership & business organization. The profession practiced by majority of our illustrious freedom fighters is back in vogue and its practitioners are sure of a promising future.

Keeping in mind the growing demand for legal professionals in the country Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan has set up Kamkus College of Law with the basic objective of imparting training to prepare qualified, and competent professional for the corporate world as well as for the Bar Council of India. The college is affiliated to Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut and recognized by the Bar Council of India. It has staff of 40 eminent faculty members along with distinguished law professionals and associates as visiting faculty. It offers 300 + 200 seats in an academic year. Bachelor of law (LL.B) is of Three years degree course and B.A. LL.B is 5 years (LL.B) integrated Course.

In year 2017-18 two years LLM Course was introduced with a capacity of 20 seats.

Activities in 2019-20

- College has achieved exemplary academic result as enumerated below :

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- The college conducted several aid clinics to counsel members of the community in the neighbourhood villages of district Ghaziabad

- College organized Legal Aid Camp in Village Manipur & Khurmapur which was attended by about 400 villagers and 250 students. They were educated about their legal rights and duties. Also they were made aware about different social welfare activities sponsored by the State and Central Govt. with ways and means to avail such facilities.

- A Legal Literacy Camp was held in Auditorium of Bhagirath Campus.

KAMKUS DRUG DE-ADDICTION & REHABILITATION CENTRE, GHAZIABAD

Introduction

The aim of our Drug De-addiction and Rehabilitation Centre is to provide whole person recovery. It is an unique 30 bedded Centre in the district. It has Ultra Modern infrastructure with qualified, trained and experienced staff. Centre provides Counseling and treatment free of cost to the patients with the support of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. Weekly sessions of counseling for the parents & members of the family of patients, are also provided. Ministry has sanctioned only 30 bedded center but in view of demand of the public, Society is running this centre with 30 bedded facilities to provide maximum benefit to the beneficiaries.

Activities in 2019-20

- On 31 May, 2019 an awareness program on account of World Anti Tobacco Day pertaining to ill effects of consumption of tobacco was organized by the centre. The program comprised of Poster Making Competition at Bhavishya International School Ghaziabad. A small talk for school children was also organized by the centre in which around 500 school going students participated.
- On 26th June 2019 on account of International Day against Illicit Trafficking and Drug Abuse, the centre actively participated in a State Level Awareness Program which was organized by the Rajya Madya Nished Vibhag at IMA Auditorium Ghaziabad. The Hon'ble Minister of Excise and Liquor Prohibition inaugurated the program.
- The inspection for 2018-2019 of the centre was conducted on December 11, 2019 by Ms. Saumya Pandey, IAS SDM Modi Nagar & Shri R L Rajwanshi, Regional Liquor Prohibition & Social Upliftment Officer. Emphasis was given on making the inmates of the centre self reliant after their release, The idea making of bags etc was mooted by the learned SDM.
- In pursuance of the same, the centre is in the process of initiating such rehabilitary practices in the centre in order to make the inmates self reliant after their release.
- The inspection for 2019-2020 was conducted on 17th March 2020 by Shri DP Singh, PCS, ACM Ghaziabad.
- Centre had organized 12 camps at 12 different places during the year aimed at raising awareness about the bad effects of the alcoholism and drinking and how to get out of it.

GREEN BRIGADE RURAL CLUB

Introduction

Our Villages are losing its ethnic values and culture. The modern practice of agriculture and need for money had led to disastrous downfall in orchards and Ground Water level. With that we are losing our natural fauna of Green Cover and sustainable environment.

BhagirathSewaSansthan had been deeply observing this changing pattern and started this club for Rural Community known as Green Brigade Eco Club. The objective is to meet the specific needs and revolutionaries the habit of sustainable agriculture and rebuild the eco system by Bamboo Agroforestry so the waste water in the villages can be utilized for practicing Bamboo on the Marginal Lands as well as on locations adjoining river or watersheds. The activity is carried from the locations situated in selected villages e.g. MORTA-Ghaziabad, Surana-Ghaziabad. Beside Bamboo few more varieties those are fast growing and yields in short durations are being promoted and that includes Bassil (Tulsi), Awanla, Karonda etc. These are also being trained for processing into food items.

Tubewell channels are strengthen with bamboo plantation on the marginal edges and near tubewell following a France based company research on Phytoremediation so water table depletion will be reversed using Bamboo roots natural system and the clumps will fetch good financial income from market.

Activities in 2019-20

The services were concentrated in Ghaziabad districts where over 60 people were trained on sowing and cultivating 10,000 Bamboo species near Hindon River.

Over 50,000 pamphlets have been distributed amongst the villagers for spreading knowledge's and benefits from Bamboo Framing.

A lecture on Bamboo for environment was conducted , Dr. Omprakash G. Kulkarni, A president awarded scientist on renewable energy and Dr. Anil Kr. Singh, IIT-Delhi alumni, and Patent on Smokeless Charcoal from Biomass had presented his views . Further, a proposal to Municipal Corporation for 25 village's participation for 'NIRMAL HINDON' project as PPP where BhagirathSewaSansthan shall work with villagers to utilize Municipal lands and Gram Panchayat Lands for Bamboo for Fuel for micro level units of smokeless charcoals

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Information, Education and Communication (IEC) – Consumer Protection

On 24th Dec.2019 Consumer Protection Day, a Workshop was organized in Bhagirath Campus. District Labour Officer from Ghaziabad was the special invitee. The students, teachers, staff and people from the community participated.

District Labour Officer explained that the consumer protection is specified in The Consumer Protection Act, 1986. Under this law, Separate Consumer Dispute Redress Forums have been set up throughout India in each and every district in which a consumer can file his complaint on a simple paper with nominal court fees and his complaint will be decided by the Presiding Officer of the District Level. The complaint can be filed by both the consumer of a goods as well as of the services. An appeal could be filed to the State Consumer Disputes Redress Commissions and after that to the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (NCDRC).

He also mentioned the rights of consumer and how to safe guards these. They are mentioned below:-

- The right to consumer education.
- The right to be protected against marketing of goods and services which are hazardous to life and property.
- The right to be informed about the quality, quantity, potency, purity, standard and price of goods or services, as the case may be to protect the consumer against unfair trade practices.
- The right to be assumed wherever possible to access 40 variety of goods and services at competitive prices.
- The right to be heard and to be assumed that consumers interests will receive due consideration at appropriate fora.
- The right to seek readdressal against unfair trade practices or restrictive trade practices or unscrupulous exploitation of consumers.
- Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan is endeavoring to sort out the problems of the community related to
Their consumer rights.

Environment

- On 5th Feb.2020 a Seminar on **SAVE ENVIRONMENT** was organized by Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan in IMT Hall. Chief Guest was Mauritius Ambassador in India Jagdishwar Goverdhan. Other distinguished guests were Asha Sharma Mayor Ghaziabad, Vijay Pal Baghel environmentalist and Amitabh Sukul Director Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan. On this Occasion Chief Guest emphasized the need of the hour is to grow more plants and keep distance from using insecticides and pesticides.

Clean Water

Clean water is anectar of life. Without water life cannot exist. Now-a-days water is getting polluted because of many reasons. We are responsible for it.

Nearly 1,000 children under age 5 die every day from diarrhea caused by contaminated water, poor sanitation, and improper hygiene. That's why Bhagirath Sewa Sansthan focused on providing clean water and sanitation to every man, woman, and child in every community we work in with the help of local authorities.

ROAD SAFETY CAMP


