Background:

Institute of Rehabilitation is a registered society, founded in 1999 is a non-governmental voluntary organization catering needs of the intellectually disabled, hearing impaired, autistic, learning disabled and other children with communication disorder in the areas of diagnostic, therapeutic, educational, vocational, and social rehabilitation. It operates a special school, clinical services and early intervention centre including special education, speech therapy, physiotherapy, occupation therapy, psychotherapy, and yoga therapy.

Objectives of the Organization:

1. To provide special education to children with special needs
2. To conduct courses in the areas of disability for man power development.
3. To provide skills development training programme to the children with disabilities.
4. To provide clinical services and early intervention program.
5. To empower through pre-vocational education to the children with disabilities.
6. To provide training and assistance to disabled persons
7. To educate the public towards understanding and acceptance of the disabled in the community
8. To organize identification and prevention camp from time to time for early intervention.
9. To promote and undertake research activities which will enhance the well being of the disabled.
10. To encourage the formation of parents' and siblings' groups so as to provide a means to mutual cooperation and assistance.

UNIT: Intellectual Disabilities:

The special school provides education to children with mild to moderate intellectual disabilities (IQ below 70) between the ages of 6 months to 18 years. Pupils follow a curriculum tailored to their special needs. They are taught basic literacy, numeric, social and self-help skills. For pupils with moderate intellectual disabilities, the program aims to train them in simple repetitive work in open employment. Pupils with emotional disorders or autistic tendencies are taught in special classes. These classes are small,

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usually with four or five pupils in each class, and the curriculum consists of training in basic self-help skills, language and speech development.

UNIT: Hearing Impairment:

In this unit the children are taught spoken language and then integrated into normal schools. These children are able to speak and learn normal teaching syllabus. The unit consists of

1. Early intervention centre: It helps hearing-impaired child to learn speak more clearly and rapidly and acquire language like any other normal child due to intervention in the critical period of hearing and language. Emphasis is given on speech and language stimulation with participation of mothers. Homebound program is prepared and given to parents for family members to work at home.

2. Pre-school programme: The children above the age of 3 years, special education planning in a classroom set up is given by the special educators. They are prepared in a way that they can be admitted in a normal school.

3. Integration into mainstream: The children after getting admission in normal schools are on follow up regularly. In case they face any difficulty, supplementary special classes are arranged to compete with normal children. They also turn up for regular follow up programme.

4. Special school programme: The children above the age of 6 years study in special classroom set up.

Special classes for children with ADHD, Specific Learning Disability, Autistic, Cerebral Palsy and Slow Learner:

As per the need based on evaluation and assessment of individual child, special class is arranged. In such cases, each child is intervened individually.

❖ At present it is working extensively on education of children with intellectual disability, hearing impairment, Autism Spectrum Disorder and other children with communication disorders. It has established a special school and early intervention centre.

HIGHLIGHTS

1. Smt Manju Gupta is appointed as Member of Divyangjan Advisory Board, Government of Uttar Pradesh and attended with two meetings held at Lucknow.
2. Pan India Hearing Screening programme has been started in collaboration Dr Lal Path Lab Ltd. New Delhi. A MOU has been signed with them for the same. Work has been started and as on date a total of 28 persons have undergone hearing assessments by qualified audiologists.
3. Reaching to unreached for special education and rehabilitation to special needs children viz autism, SLD, etc has been started in collaboration with a multi national company i.e. Mom's Belief. A MOU has been signed with them.
4. Rural project at Attor village has been started and survey is going on to find out the no of children.
5. NIOS examination center started from this year.
6. Public Awareness programme about disability has been started in support with the Mom's Belief. Staff and teachers of three general schools have been undergone short term training programme during last three months. Speech therapist, Special Educator and Psychologists of this institute delivered lectures in the school.
7. The faculty have been deputed for conducting examinations, to attend in workshop and CRE programmes.
8. Three CRE programmes have been conducted successfully during the year.
