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Name of the child - Vishal Latwal

Disability - Mental retardation (ID)

**History** - Vishal is a Mental retarded child. Parents were satisfied with child nature and behaviors, he went to normal school also But after 4 years of the study teacher compared him with other child and found that his intellectual questionnaire is not improving with class by class, not responding some time, memory level not such as age groups, poor social communication, not following commands some time, having behavior problem.

**Observation** - Right hand dominance, good hand functioning, memory, vision and hearing is good, he is slow learning child, poor body awareness, poor social interaction, his understanding is as a normal child, physical he is able to do all activity of daily living, good copying and manipulation skill

**Sensory processing response** - Slow eye hand-coordination movements, slow coordinating activity. Slow responsive to adaptive response and environment challenges.

**Occupational therapy session** - Vishal's have been receiving occupational therapy session to improving sensory integrative skills and slow learners in mangal deep vidya mandir since last 1 year, he is formally evaluated by sensory caregiver questionnaire profile by occupational therapist.

**Other Activity** - Academic Reading, Writing skill, Colour concept

#### DIAGNOSTIC IMPRESSION:

Vishal demonstrates as under-responsive response in sensory processing systems. Occupational therapist demonstrates these challenges in a wide variety of activities and these challenges have consequently compromised his functional independence in a variety of activities.

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**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that Vishal occupational therapy services order to remediate areas of deficit for three times in a week for 30 minute session.  
Special educator services regularly to remediate areas of deficit.

#### **Session observation and assessments**

Group Session were conducted by special educator and one care taker with help of occupational therapist, in these session one teacher with one child as the ratios of 1:1, Occupational Therapist to initially meet and spend some time with Vishal and then complete group achievements with the help of special educator and staff members.

Group assessments and improvements will be provided to each parent as a progress report of every six month in December and June.
