Society organized this program 3rd December in KCRC College, Shukul Bazar Amethi, district minority welfare officer Sr. Narendra Kumar Pandey as a chief guest in this program and different stakeholders like IT teachers and Doctors were participated in this program counseling and rehabilitation guidance provided to children and their guardian. In this program 15 Autism, 7 Cerebral Policy, 6 Mental retarded and 9 multiple disability affected children and their guardians also participated, IT teachers and Experts provide him suggestion and guidance so they can rehabilitate in society, for Divyangjan certificates Doctor panel examine children and provide assessment for certificate. Natak and Sangeet program was presented by Divyangjan Children's.

2. WORLD AUTISM DAY PROGRAM

Society organized this program in Sent John Inter college, Shukul Bazar. Amethi because so many child/peoples are affected from autism and no medical/social service provided



to them. So awareness and sensitization about autism is very necessary so we can identify them and provide healthy and similar atmosphere to them, 15 autism children and 12 CP, 10 multiple disabled and 8 MR children and their guardians participate in this program society provide him UDID registration form and Stick and Vaisakhi for physically person

3. Assessment, Rehabilitation cum training program for CP, MR, Autism and MD Persons-

This program was held on A.H. inter college Musafirkhana Amethi on 15th of August 2021 Autism - 12, CP- 15, Multiple disabled-12 children and their guardians participated, different experts like Doctor, IT Teachers and Physiatrist provide guidance and assessment for rehabilitation and good practices.

1. AWARENESS & TRAINING PROGRAM ON YOGA & NATUROPATHY

2. RURAL & AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Under the rural development program of the Society the farmers of two villages of Block of District were informed about the method of the scientific agriculture. On this occasion improved the methods of the scientific agriculture. On this occasion improved seeds were distributed free of cost among the villagers. Apart from this they were demonstrated the methods of preparing vermicompost.

Further the farmers were demonstrated the bio-dynamic manure and were encouraged to adapt the methods of non-organic farming.

The participants of this program were benefited largely and agreed to encourage others to join these methods of non-organic farming.

3. PROGRAM ON WOMEN RIGHT

The Society has organized a program on women right at District. Most of Women participants attend this program. The NGO's and the member of Society told about the fundamental rights of the women and also ask to educate all the women in rural & urban areas e consideration were in form of successful implementation and handling of the program as below :

4. CULTURAL PROGRAMME

Cultural programme was organized by the members at different places of district. The aim of these programme was to aware the public and the fund which was collected by the volunteers by these cultural programme, to help the people who are under the poverty line

5. DRUG DE ADDICTION AWARENESS PROGRAM

The Society has been conducting camps aimed at raising awareness about the effects of the alcoholism and drinking. The volunteers of the Society went into the villages to raise consciousness about the effects of the smoking and use of tobacco. Help of posters and banners was taken to make the presentation. Apart from this the persons who have given up the habits of drinking encouraged people to follow their path and the restraint that



one needs to take to give us this habit. It was demonstrated that thousands of people die every year because of the use of tobacco and other like things.

6. VOCATIONAL & HANDICRAFT TRAINING PROGRAM

Keeping in the mind the objectives of removal of poverty by reducing the problems of employment the society has started a Vocational Training Program . In this training Women & Youths are provided training in different field like knitting & tailoring , Chikan Embroidery, Type and Shorthand , Food Processing , Fashion Designing Etc. by experienced trainers. In this center trainees are provided training in field of Manual Art known as Handicraft. The main aim of this program is to make the trainees so skilled that they may become self dependent and stand on their own feet.

7. GIRL FETICIDE AWARENESS PROGRAM

Under the rural development program Society organized an awareness program on girl feticide in villages of Block of District. The main aim of this program was to tell the villagers about the importance to girls and their Education in our Society

8. AIDS & CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM

No disease has ever ended the life, the way AIDS does. HIV has become the biggest challenge before the mankind . As because it is an infectious disease the danger that it poses is immense. The only way to escape AIDS is to be aware of all the ways in which AIDS can take place. A camp was organized by the Society at Block of District to educate people about the causes of AIDS and the precautions that one should take at the time of taking injections blood etc., besides this the experts also described in details the reasons for cancer and the precautions needed to be taken generally to remain safe from cancer. The awareness campaign against it included road shows and small meetings in the villages.

9. AWARENESS & TRAINING PROGRAM FOR MR, CP, AUTISM AND MULTIPLE DISABLED PERSONS AND THEIR GUARDIANS

Society organized this program in Schools and Colleges & also in village so that people can identify disabled person and they can help to providing necessary equipment, Medical aid and Government sponsor scheme benefits.

10. S.C, S.T., & OBC's WELFARE PROGRAM



Despite of passing of so many years after the independence Scheduled Caste, Scheduled tribes & minorities have yet been associated in the main stream of the Society. They still need a lot of support a not only from the Government but also from the Society & NGO's . Understanding its responsibility the Society has organized a number of programs targeted at the welfare of the SC/ST/OBC's. Providing them technical & financial help in setting up their own business and pursuing higher studies

11. SHORTSTAY HOME & FAMILY COUNCELLING CENTRE

To help the women society established a Shortstay Home & Family Counseling Centre . In this Centre member tries to solve the problem of people about their family and also told them about the shelter homes for the needy women that they became able to settled them.

12. WOMEN & CHILD HEALTHCARE CAMP

Women & Child Healthcare Program was organized to making women aware from about their health needs and nutrition was organized by the Society. This Program was organized by the rural women in large number and it was felt by the attendant that this kind of programs are very useful in our villages where women were aware about their various informed about their health needs a very low. Further they were informed about various kinds of schemes formed and executed by the different Government department for welfare of the women either it is in education, employment or technical guidance. Etc. The women participating in the program were informed about need for education in the self reliance of the women. They realized the need for education and agreed to send their children particularly the girl child to school. Further it was resolved that the society will further organize similar program in the near future.

13. CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM

Consumer Awareness Camps were organized to make public aware of the rights available under the Consumer Protection Act, 1986. The program were highly appreciated by the attendants

14. WATER CONSERVATION, SANITATION & HYGIENE AWARENESS PROGRAM

Drinking Water, Sanitation & Hygiene Awareness Program was organized by the Society.



The main aim of the Society is to provide pure & clear water so the wells, tube wells & ponds were cleared by the help of the Members of the Society. The members of the Society aware the public about water which they use and society also has been very active in the field of raising awareness about good sanitation facilities in the slum areas. Lack of good sanitation facilities is curse for the majority of the urban population. Disproportionately increasing. Population has made the situation more worse. All the efforts made by the civic authorities have failed to achieve the targets. There is need for voluntary organization to come forward and help the 'civic authorities in providing sanitation facilities to more and more people.

Our society has created various sanitation infrastructures during previous financial year and further it organized various cleanliness drives in various localities.

15. SEMINAR ON URDU LANGUAGE PROMOTION

For promotion of urdu language at district a Seminar On Quami Yakjati Mein Urdu jaban Ki Ahmiyat was organized by the help of volunteers of the society at district

16. WELFARE & EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME FOR STREET CHILDREN

Welfare program for street persons was organized by members of society on Human Right Day, Medicine, Fruits, Clothes and many other things were distributed among the street children. Primary Educational Program was also started by the volunteers. Books and other Educational material was also distributed free of cost among the Children

17. CHILD & WOMEN LABOUR AWARENESS PROGRAM

A program on Women & child labour was organized by the Society on Labour day at District. In this program the volunteers aware the public about women/child labour and told them about labour act to the participants.

18. ADULT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Considering very high level of illiteracy the society has started with the help of the volunteers organizing boys & girls education programs on regular basis and educational seminar was also organized by the society. Considering the huge success in organizing these program the society has continuously been distributing necessary books free of cost to the participants of this program. The participants of this program were benefited



largely and the parents of the participating children were agreed to encourage others to join these program aimed at welfare of the masses.

19. FARMERS WELFARE & TRAINING PROGRAMME

The economic prosperity of India lies in the prosperity of the farmers. Prosper farmer means prosper country and a healthy economy. But there is big challenge ahead before the farmers of the country that is because of the implementation of the W. T. O. agreement. After the implementation of the W. T. O. agreement there is going to be a big change in the way the agriculture have been done till date. Because of this imports will be allowed of all the grains. There is need to adopt to situation by changing the strategy and by producing more cash crops. They were taught the pros and cons of the implementation of the W. T. O. agreement.

20. ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS PROGRAM

The Society organized a camp at district on World Environment Day to discuss the impact of growing pollution on the human health and environment .The eminent speakers discussed the factors lending to increase in all types of pollution including water, air, and sound pollution .It was felt that there is need to speeded the process of removing old vehicle, reduce the use of plastics, Compulsory use of effluent treatment plants by the industries and all other methods which can be helpful in reducing and controlling the pollution .

On the same day the society organized program comprising of a painting contest and a debate on the issues concerning pollution. A number of students were participating participants of different schools. At the end of the program prizes were distributed among the winners of this contest.

21. OLDAGE PERSONS AWARENESS PROGRAM

The society has donate to old age Persons Care Centre and like to Aware the people about these center and says to always tries to help to these persons by the several ways. The Society organized a welfare program for Senior Citizen .The Members of Society told



about Old age Homes and its benefits which helps our senior citizens and solve their problems. The program was appreciated by the public very much.

22. COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAM

Considering the growing importance of the computer education and the employment opportunities available in the field of information technology the society has started a computer training centre aimed at providing good computer education to needy and poor youths.
