Annual Report (2019-2020) by the Board of Governors, Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust

Respected President, Members & Guests,

We, on behalf of Board of Governors of Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust welcome all members, guests, well-wishers and donors to this august 13th Annual General Meeting of Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust on 16th August 2020 at 12.30 P.M at Bholanath Apartment, 2C, Second Road, Eastern Park, Santoshpur, Kolkata-700075 in this critical and hard time of spreading of covid19

On behalf of Board of Governors, I would like to present the brief report on the activities undertaken by the trust during the last one year (01/04/2019 to 31/03/2020)

Condolence

Arnab Mukherjee one of our loving challenged children breathed his last in the last year at a private hospital after suffering from fever for ten days. His death is very much socking to everyone. He was a genius, his acting and singing had made him popular among all. We convey our deepest condolence to his parents and others.

Anil kumar Jana, one of our settler trustees, past president, had been suffering from lung cancer for more than two years. He had been undergoing chemotherapy simultaneously and continuously. He was bed ridden for a long time. He left this world for ever on 31st August 2019. We arranged condolence meeting on 15th September 2019 at Mangolik and on 31st January 2020.

His contribution for this trust will be remembered for ever. Though thought process of establishing such an organization was initiated at Guwahati, but without janda's support and involvement it could have not been materialized.

Fund from ONGC is a milestone achievement for establishment of this trust . Initially while Janada prepared the application, I used to supply all the requisite papers .Due to his dedicated efforts, communications, ONGC sanctioned rupees forty five lakhs. Preparation of an application appropriately for the CSR of any PSU is a herculean task, professionals in this regard charge hefty amount for preparation, submission and follow up of such application. ONGC funded rupees forty five lakhs for construction of home. This was the first big grant for Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust .As we resolved in our general body meeting that any donor /collector who will donate/collect more than fifty lakhs fund for the organization, we are to install his/her statue. Accordingly we installed half bust statue of Late Anil Kumar Jana on 31st January 2020 in the premises of Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust .





Background of this organization & update

General Secretary of Arogya Sandhan Santoshpur (ASS) had been transferred to Guwahatin on his officical assignment on 29th June 2005. His two colleagues were also simultaneously transferred with their challenged children to Guwahati. These challenged children were termed as "bad omen & curse of God" by their landlords —this inhumane act induced Mr Niranjan Biswas to distribute leaflets for awareness on disability and organized seminar on 4th December 2005 at Sudmerson Hall of Guwahati Cotton college. Finally these accomplishments led to establish Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust (ASCT)-promoted by Arogya Sandhan Santoshpur(ASS)

- Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust (ASCT) was created and registered on 6th November 2007
- Second Seminar & walk for awareness were organized on 29th June 2008 and then onwards almost every year we have been organizing seminars (RCI accredited)- national/international in association with RBU/JU-
- "Ashar Alo-RAY OF HOPE" -A documentary film on the problems and solutions of differently able persons produced by Arogya Sandhan Charitable Trust, directed by Saswata Sarkar – our core trustee. This film was telecast by Doordarshan twice.
- Land at Arapanch Sonarpur was purchaged on 2nd day of march 2009 subsequently fencing & construction of security room had been done.
- Disability Detection and counselling centre started at Arogya Sandhan Clinical Lab at 67B, New Santoshpur Main Road, Kolkata-16th August 2009
- As a precursor to our Residential Care Home at Arapanch, We have been running a vocational Training centre at 2C,2nd Road, Eastern Park,Santoshpur,Kolkata-700075 since April 2010 as a pilot project.
- "Special Children- Problems & Management" This book is the first of this kind published by Arogya Sandhan charitable Trust after concerted efforts for 5 years. This book is a comprehensive book useful for all -parents, care givers, teachers, special educators, research scholars and others. No such book is available in the knowledge world covering all aspects of disability- Edited by Dr Bishnupada Nanda.

Challenging Job indeed

Most challenging job in the disability sector is the lifelong care of differently able persons in absence of their parents.

Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disability(as per National Trust Act 1999.) only are admitted for life long care in our Home Each differently able person is unique Majority of them cannot express themselves and their behavior is unpredictable- hence they need 24X7 active care.





Publication of Partispardhhi- (THE CHALLENGER) This magazine is the brainchild of Dr Bishnupada Nanda. Dr Nanda is the Prof and Head of the department of Education, Jadavpur University. In addition to this, he is very much busy with various education related jobs including writing, editing books, magazines, journals, articles on various interests and disability. In spite of his busy schedule, he has volunteered to take the responsibility of writing, collecting write ups and editing this magazine single handedly. Magazine was first released on 20th January 2013.Now Pratisparddhi is very popular among teachers, educators, special educators, parents, students, and common men. At present there are 45 subscribers of this magazine. We have been publishing special issue Pratisporddhi on the occasion of seminar every year. We have published special issue on the occasion of Durgotsav and this issue has been popular among readers.kudos to Dr Bishnupada Nanda.

Vocational Training Centre

We added another feather in the cap of ASCT on 23rd June 2019 by establishing Vocational Training Centre. Mr Goutam Chakraborty funded rupees two lakhs for establishing this centre. Mrs and Mr Goutam Chakraborty inaugurated this centre on 23rd june 2019. Here we have installed cake oven, mixture, machine for turmeric grinding, Xerox, Silk screen Printing, Phenyl Making etc.

Cakes made by our boarders have been very much popular during the last winter season. White phenyl and Termaric made at our VTC are very much in demand.

We have uploaded phenyl making video – in youtube there are 13000 viewers and due to lockdown many people have become jobless – thus they want to make phenyl and other such items to become selfdependent.

Physical Exercise Unit

Physical exercise is very much needed for our boarders .

We have purchased various instrument for physical exercise of our boarders so that they remain physically fit.

Music therapy for our boarders

Sourish Chowdhury, Kallol and Anupam have been arranging music therapy for our boarders at regular intervgals regularly came to Arogya Sandhan Home for differently abled with busket of music therapies to heal their untold agony of mind. They are in search of peace through MUSIC.

Musical instruments

Music is very use for cooling down challenged children. Moreover they love very to play music .Considering aspect We have purchased various instruments such, percussion, Khartal.Manjira, Behari Dhol, Bangla Dhol, Tambura, Drum, Banga, Dhamsha, Madal etc. We have also appointed one music teacher for them to practicing .

Dental Checkup

Free Dental check up camp was arranged by Teethwell on 2nd October, 2019. 48 patients including Boarders, Staff members and outsiders were treated.

Eye Check up camp for boarders

Arogya Sandhan Santoshpur arranged eye check up of our boarders on 6th April, 2019 and gave free spectacles to those who needed. Another Eye camp was arranged on 23rd February, 2020 collaborated with Toronto-Calcutta Foundation

Diet Management

Boarders require proper balance diet. Accordingly the management committee has engaged dietician who is sitting with parents together with management committee and proper diet chart is prepared in consultation and consent of all present. This year we conducted two such meeting for making diet chart. Foods and snacks are being provided to the boarders according to the diet chart so fixed.





Regular Counseling

Somali Mahalanobis, counselor has been engaged by Management Committee regular couselling. Almost all boarders need counseling. Somali Mahalanobis visits at fixed intervals regularly for counseling our boarders.

ASCT has been conducting sports meet for differently able children Arogya Sandhan organized SPORTS MEET on 12th January 2020 at Pattnaik's Garden. There were Five (5) events namely –50 Meter Run, Ball throw, Slow walk, Ball in basket and Break the Pot. Our boarders and differently able children/persons participated in the sports.


