## ABOUT US

#### WHAT :-

It is a state level reputed N.G.O working for the development of the society as well as it is a welfare concern for social security of suffering humanity and community development. Chiranabin means "evergreen". The organization founded by Late Mr. Sukumar Sau on 1968 and has got the registered on 1972 under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act. 1961.

The Organization is also registered with the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act. 1976 in March 1985.

#### WHY :-

Due to pressure of constant poverty the people of poor classes family has lost their mental spirit, physical strength and at the same time their all hopes and morality have been shattered. As a social being we are obligated to empower the people by mobilizing local resource and help the poor economically, so as to they may get Food, cloth, and medicine which are the basic needs of every citizen to live on.

#### Where does it work? & Who are the beneficiaries:-

We provided our service covering 8 Blocks of Howrah districts and the neighboring districts by De-addiction to the addicts, Re-conciliation to mal-adjust couple, Distribute ration and materials to the grannies, temporary and permanent relief to the aged person, care & protection to the M.R. Girls and education to the Hostel boy and inmates of destitute home, awareness camping on Road Safety Awareness Programme, Drug Demand Reduction Programme for taking up HIV/ AIDS and Legal Literacy Camp to aware the public and school Children from unwanted accident, medical service etc.

#### **HISTORY OF THE ORGANIZATION:**

Chiranabin means 'EVERFRESH'. It is a welfare concern for social security of suffering humanity and community development. During the political instability and social doldrums a group of youth motivated for the uplift of social, economic and cultural education grural development sphere in remote village Parbakshi situated at the bank of Rupnarayana in the western part of Howrah district established this Organisation on 1968 founded by Sri Sukumar Sau. The Organisation have been working at the grass-root level by gearing up social economic condition of the vulnerable people and this advantage people since 1972. Chiranabin's inception the comprising people oriented based activities by organising people movement as well as empowerment for the people by mobilizing local resource. Through welfare activities Chiranabin slowly gathered strength and is working in collaboration with many National Institutions, State 5 Central Govt.

#### AUROBINDO HOSTEL FOR S.C. BOYS :-

Boys-children from schedule caste poor families often drop outs from schools. It's because they don't have family support, their families are financially not able to bear the expenditure of education, they are supposed to pass a long distance to reach the schools, the home they live in do not have adequate lighting and ventilations, they don't get coaching to pursue their studies. Hence Chiranabin has built-up a residential unit named "AUROBINDA HOSTEL" for schedule caste boys which takes care of them and facilitate them to continue their studies at nearby primary or secondary School. We are trying our best to bring the SC students in the main stream of life through proper and education, love, care and protection.

We are running the Destitute Home for boys under Cotta ge Scheme since last 1985. At present the strength of Destitute Home for boys are 25. All inmates are belongs to the poor classes' family. At present they have inclination towards education but due to constant poverty and bad pecuniary condition all hopes of becoming a learned man are nipped in the bud. Govt. sent the such classes of inmates for admits to destitute home for boys to provide better education so that such kind of poor inmates may prosper in feature life under the guidance of teacher. As such we have made an arrangement for physical development which is badly need in student life i.e. arrangement of sports and games, yoga, seat and draw, cultural programme and exercise for physical strength. The Inmates of destitute Home reads at local school. Every year some students of our destitute home appear in the Madhyamick or higher Secondary education and succeed. We have a doctor for check up the health of inmates in every fortnight. We are always aware about protection and care of every inmates about education, health service, food and cloths.

#### **OBSERVATION HOME FOR CCL BOYS**

We have started Observation home in the year 2012. January. The ail J.C.L. Boys of observation home under J.J. act of I.C.P.S are involved with various kind of antisocial activities. The main object of the Govt. is to correct the life of criminal boy by care protection and love white view tobring them in themain stream of life so that the J.C.L. Boys may stand attheir won fit and prosper in future life. We have already admitted two J.C.L boys in the school. Beside this we have also engaged arts and craft teacher for unschooled J.C.L boys.



There is an all arrangement of playing football, volley ball, creacket.14 staff has been engaged to look after the J.C.L Boys. Food clothes are regular supply to the J.C.L Boys and medical treatment are properly done by regd. medical practitioner.

# CHILDREN AND AFTER CARE HOME FOR WOMEN & GIRLS OF ICPS UNDER J.J. ACT:-

Chiranabin started Shelter Home now children home under J.J. Act with only 25 inmates. Now at present the strength of inmates 202 (M.R./M.I./D.D)& multiple disable women. The inmates are homeless, parentless, and they have no identity. They are most wretched and despise by the people of the civil society. When the inmates come to our home they were sick, deaf and dumb, ill health, unable to walk. They cannot eat and cannot wear garments and cannot talk distinctly. Their nature and behavior has changed for proper guidance, care, protection & love of the staffs and house mother. We have made and arrangement of watching T. V., sound system, to keep them relax and marry making and at the same time they think they are living in a homely atmosphere. House mother look after them as like their own children. Smilarly M.R. girls love the staffs as like their own brothers and sisters M. R girls also their the 55 staffs like their own brothers and sisters. The inmates have become vivacious by the of house mother. They caress stupidity at present.

We have made an arrangement of music teacher who give training on song, dance and acting. In such way they have become acclimate. Now the inmates are very joyful they think that a staff house mother is their brother and sister. We have water arrangement, bathroom, toilet, electricity. But it is not sufficient according to the need of 147 inmates. Beside this there is an arrangement of vocational training for making bags, Jewellery by which the inmates may earn pocket money and self supported. It is our great pleasure and credit that we have able to restore the 4 inmates to their mother's lap. Now they are enjoining sequestesd life and discharge domestic duties with family members.

## INTEGRATED REHABILITATION CENTRE FOR ADDICT (IRCA)

Due to constant poverty and unemployment problem the young generation is suffering from frustration and despondency. They cannot express their sorrows and sufferings to anybody else. Due to constant poverty unemployment alternative reaction played always to their mind. Result which drug addicts involved with larceny for lively hood and other bare necessities of life. The young do not know that the drug is a venomous position and injuries to health and also creates frenzy. It is a kind of silent killer yet the young take drugs to forget the miseries, suffering etc. The result which as the days is going on the drug addicts become furious, adamant, harden criminal and harem sacrum. If the drug addicts get no drugs they began to torture over the family members and also people of the society. Drug addicts always quarrel with family member's as well as in the society.



To control detoxification drug we lunched drug de addiction centre to bring the drug addicts in the main stream of life by way of proper counselling, detoxification, care, protection, love, healthy food, yoga, meditation, and proper medical treatment. When the drug addicts is completely cure we return back to the family. In such way we have able to give up the practice of drug and established and harmony in the family of drug addicts. #### SENIOR CITIZENS' HOME FOR 25 OLDER PERSONS :-

At present time we have observed that senior members of the family are neglected. They had refused to live in with his/her family. Their sons and daughter do not want to support (financially, food, shelter, clothing and the most necessary is medical care) them, because they are old enough and they are not benefited for Them.

Aged persons have regularly tortured and oppressed by their son and others family members. In such critical stage, older persons have needed to support, care and protection from evil elements.



CHIRANABIN has been running the Senior Citizen Home for 25 older Persons from the financial year 2018-2019 in the Hooghly district, West Bengal. Address is vill- Marokhana, Block- Khanakul, Dist- Hooghly, Statewest Bengal.

We create a home ambience for the old age needy persons. CHIRANABIN provide the shelter, food, cloths, medicine, and other health support, recreation, training for the handcrafts, also the mental support which is most important in this age.

This scheme is not only helping the needy old age persons but also gives us a mental satisfaction to help and provide a home feelings to the needy old age persons who are became burden to their families. We wish for many more success and a long way walk in this journey with these persons.

#### FAMILY COUNSELLING CENTRE :-

For causing dowry-Demand, unemployment problem, poverty, Live-together, Drug addiction, Eve teasing, is being increased Day by day in our civil society. The torturing over women, Brideburning. Bride beating and killing, rape is a regular incident of our society. To make the society peaceful and Pleasant our achievement from the corner of F.C.C. is most praise worthy. While the society is corrupted by the theme of "Nuclear Family" instead of Joint Family Conception" and the family become smaller to smallest at that time our F.C.C. centre plays a role of match-maker and re-united the family by several counseling procedure. Women tortured by eve teaser, wife beaten and expelled by husband and in-law members can get relief by their re-conciliation with their husband and in-law members by our center. Not only wife but also deprived old father and mother also get relief as their son and daughter-in-law can not but love, respect and rare up them properly after their counselling with our counsellor in the center. Our staffs are serving excellence opportunity of counseling and advice to client who seeks social security, psychological protection and support services etc. The awareness level of people increasing due to regular intervention like group meeting, training programme awareness camp at different club so that the women exploitation, violence reduce to some extent and people are becoming conscious about their rights. #### -: COMMUNITY BASED PEER LED INTERVENTION :-

The epidemic of substance abuse in children, adolescents, youth is increasing at an alarming rate in India . India is one of largest populated country in the world . In this large number of population a major part is between 10-18 years old. The effect of substance abuse is highest on the psychological health of adolescents with the possibility of developing substance use disorder, leading to major behavioural changes observed including mood change, depression, anxiety etc. It puts Millions of adolescents at a variety of risk for traffic accident, high risk sexual practices, juvenile delinquency, Family problems.

In the 2019, the National survey on Extent and pattern of substance use, conducted by National Drugs Dependence Treatment centre, AIIMS, reported that in India, is the most common substance used is alcohol which is followed by cannabis and opioids. As per the report, 16cr persons consume alcohol, 3.1cr use cannabis and 2,3cr use opioids. More than 5.7 cr individuals are affected by harmful or dependent on alcohol and need help for their alcohol use problem, about 25 lakh suffer from cannabis dependence and approximately 77 lakh individuals estimated to need help for their opioid use problems.





Children, who are homeless, vagabond or live in slums, street become particularly vulnerable to substance abuse at high risk. To intervene before initiate the substance use government of India has introduced such scheme like CPI (Community Based Peer Led Intervention) under MSJE (Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment).

This project has been running successfully in our organization since January, 2020. Our aim is to reach children and adolescents who are vulnerable and seeking help and provide our services to them. The Community Based Peer Led Intervention programme for target Intervention for substance use among vulnerable children in Howrah district. This project is running by financial assistance National Institute of Social Defence, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi. Each of the 20 trained Peer Educators works with at least 10 to 15 peers in each quarter targeting to a total of at least 40 beneficiaries at the end of the project year and the hotspot area are selected to mitigate substance use.

# Our other Activities

## -: CULTURAL PROGRAMME :-

On the occasion of various festival dates, the Organization organizes cultural program. During this 6 (six) such program were conducted where students 5 non-students groups participated the large programs. The cultural issues have identified some extra ordinary talents in music, dance and acting. The program included sit 5 draw competition, debate, extempore, vocal music, recitation, drama-yoga competition etc. In 6 cultural programs total number of participants were 200 and Audience were 4000 only.

## -: GAMES AND SPORTS :-

During this year we are organizing annual sports and prize giving ceremony at ourorganization premises Chiranabin play ground for Primary School boys & our ownbeneficiaries. 120 Participants attend the sports competition. Many dignitaries came and extend their co-operation in organizing this event. There are many events in the programs viz. Long Jump, High Jump, Run, Musical Chair and others but the most important event was tag of war in between male & female beneficiaries of Senior Citizens' Home and also Volley Ball competition was played in between Committee Staffs. After several representations award giving ceremony was organized the day. All became happy.

## -: CHIRANABIN SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR MR & HI :-

They can also learn. They can also communicate. Their communications and articulation abilities may not be strong as the normal persons, but if the education and training is imparted to them with skills and in proper methodology, they also can be valuable assets for the human society. Yes we are talking of the mentally retarded girls with problems like D.D autism, multiple disabilities. It is with the view to make them useful social element.

Chiranabin has started mentally challenged academy in its premises at Parbakshi. Special educator of the organization impart them training on cognitive and connective learning, personal care taking, self help, socialization etc through didactic apparatus, they learn by correction and error methods. To improve their communication skills, they are taught to speak in clear volume. Music and rhymes training are imparted to them for improving their spoken ability, tonal quality.







# -: DAY CARE CENTRE FOR BEGGAR:-

Our organization chiranabin has been running a Day Care centre for Beggar to give them Counselling support to stop begging and show them the way of earning through small work such as making thonga, chata, sewing etc. Beneficiaries are regular come to our center and assembled at prayer house for praying. After the end of prayer we provide tiffins for them like bread, egg, fruits, cake, sweets etc. They spend their time by religious discussion besides this The Ramayana, The Mahabharata and The Gita are read over to them. Not only they took part of Harinam Sankirtan, the beneficiaries Gossip with each other with a view to light the burden of sorrows by exchange of talking with each other. At the end of the day they are served tea & biscuits. At every Durga puja occasion beneficiaries are given new dresses. We arranged a picnic called 'Narayan Seva' for the beneficiaries once in every two months. All the beneficiaries are very happy & with our services.





# - : CHIRANABIN LIBRARY :-

Chiranabin have an own Library at Parbakshi, Joypur, Howrand 224 students both male & female are the member of the library. There are more than 12470 books in our library, which is very helpful to the students. Newspaper is taken regularly in the library for reading purpose of beneficiaries. Our librarian is supervised the library. Library has an important role in every spare of life. Local People of all classes and students are coming to the these place. On the point of view there is badly need of Library for expansion of knowledge and experience.
